



Students Seeking Private Music Lessons Have Options

A community YMCA or a similar organization also may have after-school music programs.. * Advertising: Tutors frequently

advertise their services in the Merchandiser. Look to see if anyone is offering music lessons. Many papers now offer their classifieds both online and in print, so utilize both options to ensure your search is as thorough as possible.

Music education is important, but those seeking instruction may have to look outside of school. Private instructors are available to help foster a love of the arts and mold creative, wellrounded children.


