



SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

We continue with week twenty-two of our study of the United States Constitution. As I mentioned last week, we have concluded Article I regarding the Congress, Article II regarding the Executive Branch and Article III regarding the Supreme Court.

We now continue the study of our Constitution with Article IV which addresses the powers and limitations of the individual states and how they relate to the federal government. Article IV — Section 1 — Clause 1 reads "Full Faith and Credit shall be given in each State to the public Acts, Records, and judicial Proceedings of every other State. And the Congress may by general Laws prescribe the Manner in which such Acts, Records and Proceedings shall be proved, and the Effect thereof."

This is called the "Full Faith and Credit Clause" and addresses the duties which states within the United States have in respect to "public acts, records, and judicial proceedings of every other state". According to the Supreme Court there is a difference between the credit owed to laws (i.e. legislative measures and common law) as compared to the credit owed to judgments. Judgments are generally entitled to greater respect than laws in other states. At present, it is widely agreed that this clause of the Constitution has a minimal impact on a court's choice of law decision provided that no state's sovereignty is infringed, although this Clause of the Constitution was once interpreted to have greater impact.

Article IV — Section 2 — Clause 1 reads "The Citizens of each State shall be entitled to all Privileges and Immunities of Citizens in the several States." Our founding fathers wanted all the citizens of all the states of the United States of America to be treated equally. We, in our prejudicial ways, are still working on this concept as citizens of different states often view the rights of their citizens differently. This view of a citizen's right eventually led to our Civil War and is still prevalent today.

Article IV – Section 2 – Clause 2 reads "A Person charged in any State with Treason, Felony, or other Crime, who shall flee from Justice, and be found in another State, shall on Demand of the executive Authority of the State from which he fled, be delivered up, to be removed to the State having Jurisdiction of the Crime." This is called the "Extradition Law" which allows the Executive Branch of one state to request a person charged in their state with treason, felony or other crimes be extradited from another state back to the state in which the supposed crime occurred.

Article IV – Section 2 – Clause 3 reads "No Person held to Service or Labour in one State, under the Laws thereof, escaping into another, shall, in Consequence of any Law or Regulation therein, be discharged from such Service or Labour, but shall be delivered up on Claim of the Party to whom such Service or Labour may be due."

This clause pertained to the rights of slave owners regarding slaves who escaped to another state. The representative to the Second Continental Congress from South Carolina refused to sign the Constitution if the topic of abolishing slavery was included. We accepted slavery as a way of life in those days until the ratification of the 13th Amendment to the Constitution on Wednesday, December 6, 1865, which abolished slavery and involuntary servitude such as being indentured.

Next week, Lord willing, we will continue the study of our wonderful Constitution. I would very much enjoy any and all comments.
