

I love cruises and have tried to do one a year in recent years. Cruises are a typically a really good deal when figuring the cost of a vacation. The price of the cruise includes your lodging, travel between multiple destinations, all your meals, and a wide variety of entertainment and activities. The entertainment on a cruise is world class. From Broadway or Las Vegas type shows, like this one on Norwegian's Hawaiian Island cruise, to comedians, to magicians, to lounge style or dance music – there is something for everyone to enjoy throughout the day and well into the night.

cruise you choose doesn't offer free perks, some of the extras may be worth the cost to you to enhance your experience. And, of course, all these things are optional, so it's all up to what you want out of your cruise and what your budget is. However....one of the expenses that are not included but are also not usually an option are gratuities – you don't "tip as you go", but you are expected to pay a lump sum gratuity that will be divided among the service providers - most of the time you pay this upfront at booking and the crew that are rewarded work hard to make your trip enjoyable, so they deserve it.

A few other things to consider: 1) Cabin category – inside (no windows), ocean view (a small portal or window), balcony, or suite. The cost goes up for each category. I recommend, if your budget allows, to seriously consider a balcony cabin. 2) Check out the shore excursions at each port ahead of time - there are lots of them that offer a wide variety of things to do and prices – choose what fits your interests and budget. Of course, you can go "on your own" when in port, but there are risks and sometimes unexpected expenses to consider. 3) For dinner: there are LOTS of food options all day, every day. But when it comes to dinner, you have a few decisions – buffet or main dining room - in the main dining room, do you want a set time every

Advanced Manufacturing and Engineering Student Makes Tool for SWAT Team

Advanced Manufacturing and Engineering teacher Bill Rakonczay loves when his students get real world experience. Recently Mitch Silversmith, a senior from Medina, was tasked with making a breaching tool for the Buffalo Field Office Special Response Team

The tool resembles a claw and can be used to create a gap in-between the frame and a door making it easier to pry the door open. The Field Office was thrilled with Mitch's tool and even refer to it as the "Mitchell". They came to the Orleans Career and Technical Education Center to give a demonstration to Advanced

Manufacturing and Engineering and the Security and Law Enforcement classes. The students were also able to explore the SWAT vehicle and try out some of their equipment.

At the end of their demonstration on using the "Mitchell" to breach the door, the officers presented Mr. Rakonczay and Mitch a certificate of appreciation. "It was really awesome to see how my tool was going to be used and get this experience," says Mitch.
