

SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

We continue with week twenty-three of our study of the United States Constitution. Article IV – Section 3 – Clause 1 reads "New States may be admitted by the Congress into this Union; but no new State shall be formed or erected within the Jurisdiction of any other State; nor any State be formed by the Junction of two or more States, or Parts of States, without the Consent of the Legislatures of the States concerned as well as of the Congress."

States such as North Dakota and South Dakota were formed by dividing the Dakota Territory. The Confederate States of America were formed in direct opposition to our Constitution.

Article IV – Section 3 – Clause 2 reads "The Congress shall have Power to dispose of and make all needful Rules and Regulations respecting the Territory or other Property belonging to the United States; and nothing in this Constitution shall be so construed as to Prejudice any Claims of the United States, or of any particular State." Many individual territories existed during the formative years of our country until the Territory of Arizona became a state on Wednesday, February 14, 1912, as the last of the 48 coterminous United States.

On Saturday, January 3, 1959, the Territory of Alaska became a state and on Friday, August 21, 1959, the Territory of Hawaii became a state. The United States currently administers three territories in the Caribbean Sea and eleven in the Pacific Ocean. Five territories, American Samoa, Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico and the United States Virgin Islands are permanently inhabited, unincorporated territories while the other nine are small islands, atolls and reefs with no native or permanent population.

Of the nine, only one is classified as an incorporated territory – Palmyra Atoll. Two additional territories – Bajo Nuevo Bank and Serranilla Bank are claimed by the United States but administered by Colombia. Historically, territories were created to administer newly acquired land, and most eventually attained statehood.

Other territories such as the Philippines, the Federated States of Micronesia, the Marshall Islands and Palau later became independent. Territories of the United States are sub-national administrative divisions of the United States government. The various United States territories differ from the individual states and Native American tribes in that they are not sovereign entities. In contrast, each state has a sovereignty separate from that of the federal government and each federally-recognized Native American tribe possesses limited tribal sovereignty as a "dependent sovereign nation".

Territories are classified by incorporation and whether they have an "organized" government through an organic act passed by the Congress. United States territories are under United States sovereignty and, consequently, may be treated as part of the United States proper in some ways and not others. Unincorporated territories in particular are not considered to be integral parts of the United States, and the Constitution of the United States applies only partially in those territories.

In recent years the Territory of Puerto Rico has been considered for statehood. Recently there has been talk of making the District of Columbia a state. However, these considerations have been primarily political to change the balance of power in the U. S. Senate.

Next week, Lord willing, we will continue our study.
