





FLORENCE – The Florence-Lauderdale Convention + Visitors Bureau (CVB) in partnership with the City of Florence Parks and Recreation Department, have secured a three-year contract with the Alabama High School Athletic Association to host the North Regional Softball Tournament from 2022-2024.

Currently, there are 414 senior high members and 287 junior high and middle school members with more than 80,000 students participating in the AHSAA.

"The facilities and staff are always top notch in everything they do. When we come to Florence, we can tell that we are wanted", said Kim Vickers, Associate Executive Director with the AHSAA. "We can't express our appreciation enough for Florence wanting to host our AHSAA events and we look forward to the partnership going forward".

The Florence-

The Florence-Lauderdale CVB and Parks and Recreation secured a two-year contract with the AHSAA in 2019 to host both the 2019 and 2020 tournaments. Covid-19 postponed the 2020 tournament. It rescheduled for May 2021. The host fee for the 2022, 2023, and 2024 tournaments will be \$36,000 per year. The Florence-Lauderdale CVB and the city of Florence will split that hosting fee.

"The memories that these student athletes make in Florence is something they will be able to carry with them for years to come," said CVB Sales Manager of Sport + Travel Trade, **Tyler Dolan**. That's what it's all about."

Tina Kitchens, Director of Parks and Recreation, said gate receipts totaled just over \$39,000, yet were up \$12,000 in 2021. "After a great 2021 tournament and a significant increase in spectators from 2019, we look forward to working with AHSAA to continue to make this a huge success. We greatly appreciate the partnership with the Florence-Lauderdale CVB."

The 2019 tournament produced an estimated \$600,000 in economic impact to the Florence-Lauderdale economy and generated 1145 room nights. Officials anticipate that number being higher for the 2021 economic impact report.

BORROW YOUR OWN MONEY?

Dear Dave.

I have a question about self-banking with whole term life insurance. The way I understand it, you can accrue a cash balance, borrow against it, and then pay interest to yourself. Is this worth it, or should I stay away from it and continue using a bank?

Kunal

Dear Kunal,

Actually, it's a whole life policy, not a term policy. And it's an absolute scam.

Basically, with whole life you pay about 20 times more for the same amount of insurance that you would with a term policy. The extra money goes into a savings account, and you earn next to nothing on it, even after you finally start to build it up. One of the ways they're pitching it now is the selfbanking concept, where you can use your own money. It's nothing magical or anything, because with a regular checking account

you *use your own money.*My advice is to stay away from the company that's offering it and anything else they have. It's a really bad product, and it's a scummy way to sell whole life insurance—which is an awful product to begin with. No one, except for folks in that business, believes in it or talks positively about it anymore.

Being able to borrow your own money? Really? Why on earth would anyone want to borrow their own money? It's ridiculous!



Ways to provide financial assistance. There's more than one way to contribute to your grandchildren's financial well-being. Select the method that works best for your circumstances and will make the greatest impact.

Open and contribute to a 529 plan. A 529 college savings plan can be very helpful. Contributions are tied to the stock market, offering the potential for growth over time. Future distributions will not be taxed, as long as the beneficiary uses the funds for qualified expenses.

 Co-sign on a loan. Credit guidelines have tightened in recent years. Consider co-signing a loan for a grandchild to help pay for school, a reliable car or a first home, as long as you would not be harming your own financial security. Be sure to have a clear understanding of who is responsible for loan payments to avoid loan default.

Pay an expense directly. You can pay college tuition as well as medical and dental bills on another person's behalf without incurring federal gift tax. Make payments directly to the school or provider

to avoid using other gift tax exclusions.

• Buy stock. Stocks and other investments can be purchased by you and gifted to another. You can also transfer ownership from existing stock holdings. Keep in mind if an investment has grown, the recipient will be grown in the recipient will be grown in the recipient will be grown. the recipient will be responsible for paying taxes on any capital gains when the stocks are sold.

 Create a trust. A trust is a useful legal entity when you have significant wealth you'd like to share with your grandchildren. By establishing a trust, you decide at what age your beneficiaries can draw from the trust (while you're still living or after you pass) and the rate at which funds are distributed.

• Give cash. There's always the option to give the gift of cash.

Know the tax rules. Generally, the IRS requires Know the tax rules. Generally, the IRS requires disclosure of gifts of cash or assets over \$15,000 per recipient using IRS Form 709. Giving rules are per person, so both you and your spouse can each give up to \$15,000 per recipient without reporting it. While the giver is responsible for paying gift tax, the lifetime exclusion means you can currently give upwards of \$11 million in gifts without gift tax obligation.

Ask before you give. Financial assistance can be

Ask before you give. Financial assistance can be a sensitive topic. Consider if your grandchildren's parents may want to know about financial gifts intended for their children. This is especially true if the children have access to money without any requirements for its use or if there's a history of money mismanagement.

Consult your financial advisor. To safeguard your own financial position, review your finances before making financial gifts. When giving is a priority, your financial advisor can help you draw down your assets while managing the tax implications.

to send it in to prove who you are. Well, there are a whole lot especially people, people who live in rural communities, who don't there's no Kinkos, there's no OfficeMax near them."

From the coddled queen of a dilapidated, crime-ridden, concrete mecca known as Oakland, CA, we get a public 30-second summary on the disadvantages of living in rural America.

Harris doesn't know that rural folks usually show up to vote in person, so they rarely need a photocopy. And even rural folks know how to use that camera on one of those new-fangled cell phones.

When was Harris last on the ground in rural America to know what it looks like and business, food, what communications and offerings are around?

She had a chance to see some rural surroundings just weeks ago. After over three months as Biden's new Border Czar, Harris finally decided to go witness the "non-crisis issues" in Texas after Trump announced he was going there with Texas Governor, Greg Abbott.

She had the opportunity to go into some rural stretches which comprise 90% of the 32 county Texas border with Mexico (29 legal border-crossing routes) and see for herself. 





House. Examples are past hoopla over common core and current "critical race theory" in the schools, and expansion of Medicaid under the Affordable Care

Perhaps if the legislature were more concerned about fact-based science (compared to Biblical beliefs), and documented history (instead of trying to whitewash it), Alabama might rank higher than 47th among the states in education. More concern for the well-being of its citizens instead of scoring political points might help Alabama advance from 47th in health and last in COVID vaccinations.

Moreover, the same Republican representatives concerned about the rights of states, and sending messages to Washington, often undermine the rights governments local in Alabama. The state is supposed to support governments, suppress them –

and by extension the voters. Examples are Alabama laws aimed at outlawing the removal of Confederate statues and limiting our first amendment protections to protest. (The Republican party even got involved in a UNA student student government controversy.)

Uninspired state legislators jump on Republican bandwagons from other states that are built on political self-They usually interest. limit instead of generating more participation and equity in governing. equity in governing. That Alabama has the longest (and outdated) constitution of any state connotes more control and regulation over local governments - and us.

The next election will be an opportunity to begin to break the chains holding us from achieving a better future for all.

where everyone lives in a world that is not real. The Filter Bubble is kind of the same thing and I think we are all living in one. The Filter Bubble, according

to Wikipedia, is "a state of intellectual

isolation that can result from personalized searches when a website algorithm selectively guesses what information a user would like to see based on

information about the user, such as location, past click-behavior and search history. As a result, users become separated from information that disagrees with their viewpoints, effectively isolating them in their own cultural or ideological bubbles."

THE FILTER BUBBLE **ECHO CHAMBER**

by "The Computer Skeptic"

Translation: Your internet experience is a reflection of your surfing habits. Your personal biases and opinions of everything from politics to vaccines to craft beer to racial issues are continually nourished and reinforced--to the point of radicalization in some cases. The end result is, well, the chaotic, polarized world in which we live.

At the root of this phenomenon is a bit of computer code called 'cookies." Cookies are tiny little computer files that collect information about the pages you view and your activities

on the site, enable the site to recognize you, i.e remembering your user ID, keep track of your preferences if you visit the website again, and deliver ads targeted to you. Some of these cookies send out "beacons" to other websites so that if you perform a search for a weight loss product, you'll instantly start seeing ads for Big Macs.

Another component of the Filter Bubble is "curation." Everything you see on your social media accounts is the result of a mathematical algorithm which takes into account how you have interacted with similar posts in the past.

You only see posts from friends that you've interacted with in some way, but especially with the "like" button.

Filter Bubbles are similar to "echo chambers." The best example of an echo chamber is a Facebook page devoted to anti-vaccine lunacy. Spend enough time in one of those groups and you will soon be convinced that the infinitesimal ingredients in a vaccine cause your body to become so magnetic that you can stick a refrigerator to your forehead. I'm almost not exaggerating here; some people have isolated themselves from reality so much that they believe this.

In my next exciting installment, we will discuss how to extricate yourself from your bubble but I want to leave you with a paraphrase from a world leader that demonstrates my point. Some of you will like the wording and agree with the premise right up until the last two words. That's your bubble filter talking.

"It's become safer to retreat into our own bubbles surrounded by people who look like us and share the same political outlook and never challenge our assumptions. Increasingly, we become so secure in our bubbles that we accept only information, whether true or not, that fits our opinions, instead of basing our opinions on the evidence that's out there." Barack Obama.

Medicare Minute

"Signing up for Medicare Part 2"

Most Americans qualify for Medicare by turning 65 but there are other ways to qualify such as being disabled, having End Stage Renal disease (ESRD) or ALS. Today we are going to look at how you would sign up if you are disabled.

If you are under the age of 65 and disabled, you will automatically be enrolled in Part A and Part B after you have received Social Security or Railroad Retirement Board (RRB) benefits for at least 24 months. If you are disabled, covered by your or your spouse's group health plan and wish to stay on that plan, my suggestion is to contact the plan and confirm that you can remain on the plan even though you have Medicare. This may allow you to delay your Part B until a later date.

You are eligible for Medicare if you have End Stage Renal Disease and you've worked the required amount of time under Social Security, RRB or as a government employee OR you're already getting or are eligible for Social Security or RRB benefits OR you're the spouse or dependent child of one of the previous requirements. You should contact Social Security or the RRB for the amount of time worked to be eligible for Medicare.

If you're under 65 and have ALS your Medicare benefits should begin the first month you start receiving your Social Security or RRB benefits. Again contact Social Security or RRB for a list of the benefits.

Whether it's SSI or RRB disability, ESRD or ALS, I would encourage you to NEVER voluntarily leave your current health plan until you have covered all your bases with your current plan and Medicare.
