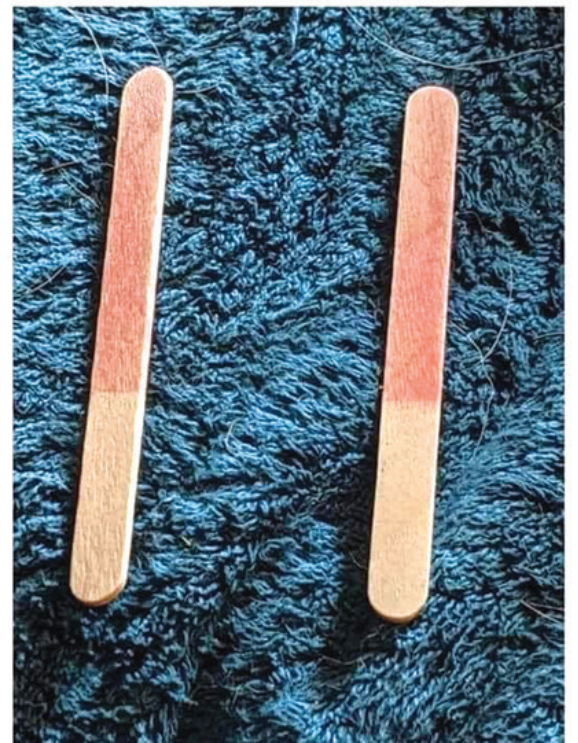

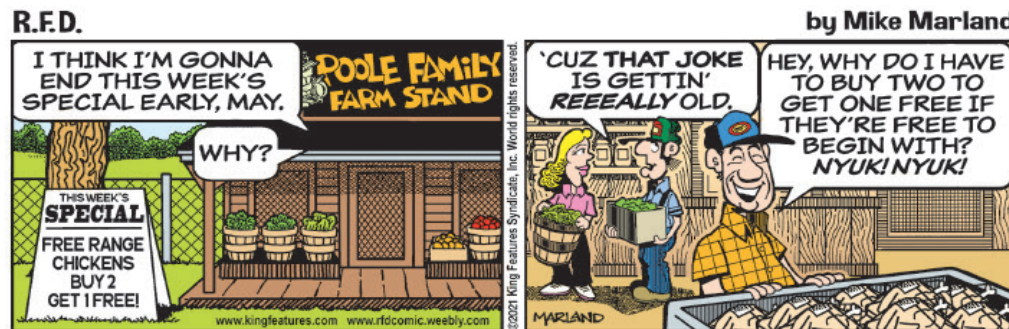
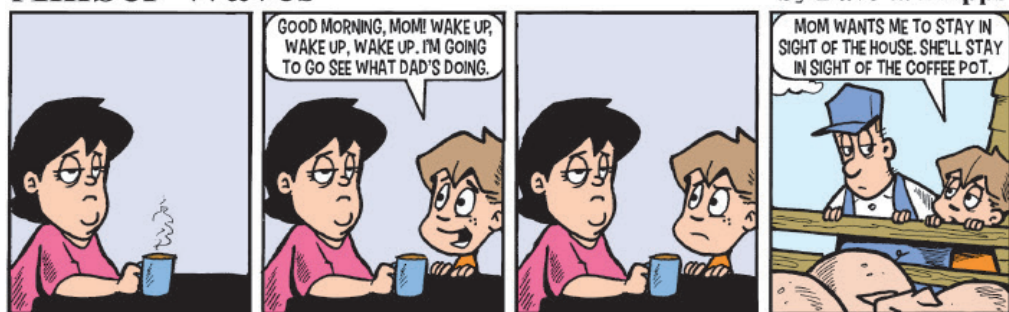

Several years ago, a woman found a cute little Chihuahua mix in her yard. She fed him, and then brought him to us. He was filled with personality, and quickly became a favorite among staff members. He was an older guy, and obviously had been in a home. No one came forward to claim him, though.

Staff members named him Franklin. He was taken to a veterinary clinic for an exam, and during that exam, he was found to have a slight heart murmur.

One day, a scared little dog came in, and staff decided to put him in Franklin's dog run. That is when we discovered the magic of Franklin. Shelter volunteers loved Franklin, and he was taken for many walks outside. He was such a happy-go-lucky little guy, and loved the attention he was given. He

Plastic Fada Radio

Vintage but modern-looking plastic radios are popular with collectors today. The art deco design was popular when Bakelite was introduced as the first molded plastic used for radio cases, in 1933. But Bakelite was either brown or black, sometimes with a marbled look, and customers wanted more color. In 1937, Catalin was a new plastic that was white or beige when used for a molded case. Red and a few other colors were also possible. The famous Fada radio used this plastic, but no one realized that the colors might fade.



This plastic Fada radio was made about 1941. It is alabaster color and about 6 by 10 by 6 inches. Now faded to a light green, it sold for \$1,000.

Today, white cases have yellowed, and blue ones have turned dark green. The cases also shrink, crack and have other damage. But plastic scientists kept improving mixtures and manufacturing methods, and by the 1950s, other better and cheaper radios were made with new materials. Today one of the older plastic radios in good working condition sells for \$440 to \$1,000. This Fada Model 845XA sold at a Palm Beach Modern auction for \$1,000, although it was never tested to see if it works.

Q. I bought a "personal wash set," four pieces consisting of a chamber pot, pitcher and two smaller pieces. On the bottom they're marked "Admiral V.P. Co." I've searched online and can't find

any information on the company or item. It's a pretty floral pattern, purple flowers on a white background, and is in very good shape. The seller thought the piece was made in the 1800s. Can you tell me anything about this set?

A. Wash sets were used in the late 18th and early 19th centuries before indoor plumbing became common. A washstand, usually in the bedroom, held the items necessary to "wash up." The pitcher was used to fill a washbasin or bowl. The chamber pot usually had a lid. Other pieces could include a soap dish, hair receiver, toothbrush holder and slop jar. This mark was used by Vodrey Pottery Company of East Liverpool, Ohio. The company made white graniteware and semi-porcelain. It was in business under that name from 1896 until 1928. A pitcher and bowl set from an average maker sells for \$100 to \$150, the slop jar with lid for about \$75, and small pieces for \$25-\$40.

The Heat is On: How to Stay Cool and Spurn the Burn

When the sun comes out to play, many of us make plans to do the same. The summer months bring the promise of backyard barbecues, pick-up games in the park and wasting away lazy afternoons in the water. This year's summer season feels extra special as COVID-19 vaccines have paved a way for us to once again gather together safely.

Summer also brings the heat – a potential threat to health that we should all stay alert to preventing and treating. Heat-related illness can take on several different forms, from heat rash, sunburn and heat cramps, to even more serious and potentially life-threatening illnesses like heat exhaustion and heat stroke. Heat-related illnesses can strike when the body can't properly cool itself through normal methods like sweating, and some heat-related illnesses can cause damage to essential organs, including the brain, and even be fatal.

Those who are most at risk for developing heat-related illness include senior adults, infants and children, those with chronic health conditions, athletes and outdoor workers. That doesn't let everyone else off the hook, however. Heat-related illness can affect anyone, and additional factors can come into play, including high levels of humidity, obesity, prescription drug use, alcohol use and more. That's why it's important to know the different types of heat-related illness, how to prevent them, what to look out for and what to do if illness strikes.

Preventing Heat-Related Illness

The good news is that heat-related illnesses are preventable and there are some basic tips to remember to help protect yourself and others, including:

- Wearing light, loose-fitting clothes
- Staying cool with air conditioning, and cool showers and baths
- Limiting outdoor activities to cooler times in the morning and evening
- Pacing yourself when it comes to outdoor activity and exercise
- Wearing sunscreen
- Never leaving infants, children or pets in parked cars (even if the windows are cracked open)
- Avoiding hot, heavy foods and
- Staying hydrated with plenty of water (and keeping your pets hydrated, too!)

Heat Rash

Heat rash can present as small pimple-like blisters. If heat rash appears, move to a cool, dry place, keep the rash dry and use powder to alleviate discomfort.

Sunburn

If you're reading this, there's a good chance you've gotten sunburned before and experienced the unwelcome results, including red, painful skin and blisters. If you get burned, it's important to stay out of the sun until your burn heals. Apply cool cloths, aloe or moisturizing lotion to your burn. A cool bath may help soothe your skin, too. Whatever you do, don't break those blisters! Allow them to heal.

Heat Cramps

Heat cramps can bring excessive sweating and muscle pain and spasms. If you get heat cramps, stop your activity and get to a cool place, hydrate and let them pass before resuming any physical activity. If your cramps last longer than an hour, you're on a low-sodium diet or you have heart problems and experience

cramps, you should seek immediate medical help.

Heat Exhaustion

Symptoms of heat exhaustion include heavy sweating; cold, pale, clammy skin; fast or weak pulse; nausea; muscle cramps; fatigue; dizziness; headache and fainting. Get to a cool place, loosen your clothing, apply cool, wet cloths to your body (or try a cool bath) and hydrate. If you are vomiting, symptoms get worse or if they last longer than an hour, it's important to seek medical attention immediately.

Heat Stroke

Heat stroke is the most severe and dangerous heat-related illness. Symptoms include a high body temp (103 degrees Fahrenheit or higher); hot, red, dry or damp skin; fast, strong pulse; headache; dizziness; nausea; confusion; and loss of consciousness. If you or someone you know is experiencing heat stroke, emergency medical attention is vital. Call 911 immediately, move the person to a cooler place, apply cool cloths to the body or take a cool bath, and do not let them consume any liquids.

As we move through the summer months, it's also a good idea to keep an eye on those at greater risk for heat-related illness. Check in on them during the day and watch for the signs and symptoms above. And don't forget to protect yourself. By taking simple preventive steps and knowing what to look for and what to do if heat-related illness rises, you can more safely enjoy the warmer weather and make it a summer to remember.

Board of Supervisors July Meeting Recap Pittsylvania County

The Board of Supervisors held a busy day of meetings on Tuesday. Here are some of the highlights.

Approved Permit for Blue Ridge Rock Festival

After Pittsylvania County underwent a thorough revision of its music festival ordinance in June and a thorough review of the permit application by many regulating agencies and county departments, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved a permit application for the Blue Ridge Rock Festival - a large, four-day rock festival in Blairs that is expected to bring approximately 35,000 people in September.

"We have gone above and beyond our due diligence with both the revisions of our music festival ordinance and in our consideration of the application for the Blue Ridge Rock Festival," said Bob Warren, Chairman of the Pittsylvania County Board of Supervisors. "I am confident that all of the planning will allow this event, as well as the two that were previously permitted, to proceed safely and efficiently."

The permit application was approved with several contingencies. For instance, the particulars of the traffic and parking control plans are still being finalized with input from the Virginia State Police and Virginia Department of Transportation, and the permit was approved contingent on that plan being approved by the regulating agencies.

"These items do not merit withholding approval or denying the permit application, but they are things that will be worked out with all the regulating agencies as we get closer to the event," said Emily Ragsdale, Community Development Director.

Approximately 160 bands are scheduled to play across 6 stages over the four-day event, which is scheduled for September 9-12. According to the permit applications from Purpose Driven Events, approximately 20,000 of the attendees will be camping on-site, with another 15,000 expected to commute into the venue every day. Those who are camping are required to check in on Wednesday September 8 and will check out on Sunday - reducing the expected traffic congestion during the days of the event.

The Blue Ridge Rock Festival is the third and largest music festival at the Blue Ridge Amphitheater in Blairs that has received a permit from the Board of Supervisors. During a special called meeting on June 22, the Board approved permits for Worship at the Mountain - a three-day Christian Music festival expected to draw in more than 8,000 - and the Blue Ridge Country Festival, which is also expected to have more than 10,000 attendees. Worship at the Mountain is scheduled for September 3-5 and the Blue Ridge Country Festival is scheduled for October 1-3.

Pittsylvania County leaders spent months thoroughly reviewing and updating its music festival ordinance, which was created in the 1970s and hadn't been thoroughly revised since then. The Board of Supervisors held a public hearing at their June 15 meeting before approving the comprehensive revision. Under the new code, event promoters are required to submit extensive plans regarding everything from public safety to trash and traffic to EMS for any music festival. These plans have to be approved by the relevant regulating agencies and then the entire permit application has to be approved by the Board of Supervisors. The purpose of these revisions and rigorous permitting process was to ensure that large-scale events could proceed safely and efficiently for all involved and the community as a whole.

Enacted an Increase to the Meals Tax, Created a New Transient Occupancy Tax

In an effort to more equitably spread the tax burden across County residents and collect taxes from those just travelling through or visiting, the Board of Supervisors approved two new taxation options on Tuesday night.

The Board increased the existing meals tax from 4% to 6%, and then the Board enacted a new, 4% transient occupancy tax, which applies to anyone staying in a hotel, Airbnb style lodging, or camping. According to State Code, a locality can adopt a transient occupancy tax, but any proceeds after 2% must be contributed to tourism efforts in the area. The Board of Supervisors plans to hold a public hearing during a future meeting in regards to how the 2% of the transient occupancy tax proceeds will be used to improve tourism efforts in Pittsylvania County.

"With the 2022 Reassessment coming up, we have made it our goal to more fairly distribute the tax burden," said Bob Warren, Chairman of the Board of Supervisors. "In the past we have passed a disproportionate portion of the cost of running government onto our landowners, and

with these new taxes we are trying to capture revenue from other sources - including those traveling into or through our county - so that we can reduce the cost to our taxpayers."

The increase to the meals tax is expected to generate an additional \$400,000 in revenue annually, while it is unknown at this time how much annual revenue will be collected from the new transient occupancy tax since there is no previous county history with the tax. The Board of Supervisors is looking at these options to create additional revenue that would allow a reduction in the Pittsylvania County real estate tax rate with the upcoming reassessment.

On a somewhat related note, the Board of Supervisors approved the creation of a new internal auditor position. This person would work across county government, including with offices like the Commissioner of the Revenue, the Finance Department, the Sheriff's Office, and Economic Development, among others, to audit everything from petty cash to medical billing to incentives and tax breaks to the execution of local taxes - including the newly enacted taxes.

During an afternoon finance committee meeting, the Board of Supervisors discussed additional taxation options - such as a cigarette tax and a fire tax - all with the intention of reducing the burden on property owners. These are options that the Board will continue to consider in the coming months.

Approved Sign-On and Referral Bonuses

During its afternoon Finance Committee the Board of Supervisors considered different options for recruiting talented workers in the midst of a challenging hiring environment. Ultimately, the Board approved \$1,000 sign-on and referral bonuses that will remain in effect for the remainder of the fiscal year.

"We are having a very difficult time finding qualified and talented employees that are willing to join our team," said Pittsylvania County Human Resources Manager Holly Stanfield. "With the difficulties companies and agencies across the country are having with hiring, we know that we need to sweeten the pot and think outside the box to attract top talent."

The \$1,000 sign-on bonus is for employees that join the Pittsylvania County team in fiscal year 2021, and it must be returned by any employee that does not work for Pittsylvania County for at least a year. The \$1,000 referral bonus would be given in two instalments to any current employee that recommends someone who is hired and then works for Pittsylvania County for a year.

Pittsylvania County is currently recruiting for approximately 25 open positions, and is also working on a general campaign to recruit talented people.
