by Steve Weisman Excitement and anticipation are in the air with only a few days until the Okoboji Blue Water Festival, the premier clean water event in the state of Iowa, unfolds at the Preservation Plaza green space in Arnolds Park on Saturday, August 7. It's a day that focuses ALLDAY on fun-filled clean water activities. Plus, it's FREE!

Greg Drees, organizer of the Blue Water Festival shared his excitement for the August 7 event. "We are putting the finishing touches on what promises to be the best Festival yet. The day's activities commence at 9 a.m. and run to about 4 p.m. or so. The day promises to be both informative with lots of interactive activities for families. We want to celebrate our successes toward clean water, while at the same time raise public awareness of water quality issues in the Iowa Great Lakes and beyond."

Drees also shared news about an award the Okoboji Blue Water Festival just received. "The Iowa Great Lakes has been selected as the recipient of the 2021 Community of Character Award, and the Okoboji Blue Water Festival has been recognized as one of the organizations that exemplify how people living and visiting the Iowa Great Lakes demonstrate the Six Pillars of Character Counts. On behalf of all the volunteers that have worked so diligently to make the Festival what it is today, I want to say thank you."

Let's look at the day's activities. **Clean Water exhibitors** 

Up to 40 exhibitors ranging from lake protective associations, non-profits and conservation organizations will be spaced out along the winding sidewalk in the Green Space. "The exhibitors will be answering questions, sharing their clean water stories and addressing questions visitors might have."

#### **Kids' and Family Activities**

At the same time, a designated area will be reserved for the Kids' and Family Activities. According to Drees, "We have a committee that has worked diligently to developing a dozen or so watershed education stations for parents and children. Our goal has been to make the stations both educational and entertaining. Over the years, we have learned that youngsters

enjoy our interactive stations, and that they show a keen interest in enhancing our natural resources. After all, they are the future of that guardianship."

#### Free fishing clinic

For anglers both young and old, a special fishing seminar will take place at 10:30 a.m. under the Big Tent. Clinician will be Dan Spengler, Senior Project Manager-Bait Development with Berkley/Pure Fishing. His topic will be "The Science of Fishing Lures." He will also discuss the development of the Berkley Stunna, the lure that helped win the 2021 Bassmaster Classic. Plus, Spengler will bring plenty of product to share with those in attendance.

#### **Clean water panel**

Another popular component of the day is the panel discussion on important clean water topics, which will take place at 1 p.m. under the Big Tent. This year's panel is a distinguished group of clean water experts. Drees says, "We have a wonderful lineup of speakers from around the State of Iowa. We are hoping to have a big crowd in attendance.'

Panelists include Adam Schneider, who is the Water Quality Coordinator for the DNR; Nathan Anderson from Practical Farmers of Iowa; Sylvia Secchi from the University of Iowa, from the Sustainability Department; Dr. Larry Weber, who is also from the University of Iowa and an Expert Hydrologist; David

Thoreson, Worldwide Traveler and Photographer; Rich Leopold, who heads the Polk County Conservation Board; and Joe McGovern from the Iowa Natural Heritage Foundation.

Shortly after the panel discussion, keynote speaker Robert F. Kennedy, Jr., world renowned clean water advocate, will take the stage under the Big Tent. This should take place around 3 p.m. "All people

The Festival was originally created by the Okoboji Protective Association (OPA) in 2016 to raise public awareness of water quality in the Iowa Great Lakes. Founded in 1905, the OPA is a non-profit organization dedicated to the protection and enhancement of West Lake Okoboji and the entire Iowa Great Lakes watershed. Drees adds, "We continue to work in partnership with the OPA and Historic Arnolds Park, Inc. to make the Okoboji Blue Water Festival the premier clean water event in the state of Iowa.'

The Conference kicks off at 8:15 a.m., and concludes at 5 p.m. Amanda De Jong, Landus Cooperative Business Unit Leader and former Iowa Farm Service Agency executive director, will keynote the Conference. She'll highlight how data can help position Iowa farmers to participate in new carbon and soil health programs and share her experience as the first woman to head the Iowa FSA.

Sue Martin, CEO of AG and Investment Services, Inc. commodity analyst and an Iowa Public Broadcast's Market to Market commentator, will offer her perspective and insights on the challenges of today's current marketing environment.

Dr. Beth Hall, Indiana State Climatologist, Purdue University will deliver a timely focus on climate trends, outlooks, and the impact of climate on agriculture, with the goal of achieving environmental sustainability and global food security.

During the luncheon, participants will enjoy a give-and-take of their own personal pandemic perspectives: "What's your New Normal?".

Participants may choose two of the three following afternoon breakout ses-

### Iowa Lakes Offers New Instructor **Course to Teach Basic Life Support**

### Big 12 Chaos

Horns Down has been a symbol in the Big 12 that a lot of teams use at Texas after they beat them on the football field (which has been happening quite a bit lately) or basketball court as a sign of taunting the Longhorns and their Hook 'Em Horns symbol they use with their hands. Late last week, Texas and their long-time rival Oklahoma gave the Big 12 their own Horns Down and announced that they plan to leave the conference and apply for admission into the Southeastern Conference (SEC). On Sunday the Big 12 tried a last-ditch effort as their Executive Committee met with Texas' and Oklahoma's presidents to see if they could salvage the two schools staying in the Big 12 Conference. Rumor has it that the Big 12 would offer these two schools a larger share of the TV rights (1.5 times) than the other schools receive to make it more lucrative for the two top Big 12 brands to stay in the league.

This is similar to what happened in 2010 when Texas and Oklahoma both flirted with leaving the league for better TV packages, but appears to be more of a possibility this time around. In 2010 Iowa State would have possibly been left behind from another Power 5 league as they were not very marketable with a downtrodden football program (football is what is driving all of these conference decisions) and a television market that is not very enticing to conferences. Fortunately for the Cyclones and their fans, things have totally flipped since 2010 with ISU now a Top 10 football program heading into the 2021 season, and TV households are no longer intriguing to conferences as many people are getting rid of their cable TV and satellite subscriptions in favor of streaming products. ISU's passionate fan base has proven that they will not only come out in full-force to support their Cyclones in Ames and on the road, but they will also consume streaming products that carry ISU. If the Big 12 does fold, look for Iowa State to land either in the Pac 12, which would feature a Midwest Pod (Iowa State, Kansas State, Oklahoma State, Texas Tech, Arizona State, Arizona, Utah and Colorado) and a Western Pod with their West Coast schools; or in the Big 10 where they would possibly join the Big 10 West with Iowa, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Nebraska, Illinois, Northwestern and Purdue. The Big 10 would add another school, possibly Kansas or West Virginia and have a 16-team conference instead of their current 14 team league. This would definitely be the best option for Iowa State if the Big 10 would want them as the travel to games would become much easier for their teams and fans, and it would create some great midwestern rivalries where passionate Big 10 fans could travel to Ames for games. It also would mean that men's and women's basketball would play the Cy-Hawk game twice a year, and that the football game would have possible conference championship implications, which would juice that rivalry up even more.

As with everything in 2020 and 2021, this is an ever-changing situation and things may have even changed from when I am writing this on Monday morning to when you are reading it now. While it definitely makes me worry as a Cyclone fan, I do feel much better about things now than I did 10 years ago, and I fully trust that ISU Athletic Director Jamie Pollard will stay ahead of things like he has proven to do in the past. I do feel like this is the first step to create a 64-team power conference that breaks away from the NCAA altogether. This megaconference would feature the 64 most profitable athletic programs (ISU is currently #44) and allow these schools to negotiate more like the NFL does with their TV/Streaming rights, as well as offer their athletes more NIL opportunities and larger stipends. The SEC appears to be the leader for a conference like this, and rumor has it they are even going after Ohio State, Michigan, Clemson and Florida State to leave their current conferences to join the SEC in what would be a 20-team Power Conference. Again, take that with a grain of salt, as you can't believe everything you are hearing or reading on the internet, especially during these crazy

#### 2021 Project Update

The 2021 trail construction season is well under way with three projects currently in development. Highway 71 Trail: Paving of this extension from Nature Center Road going north to 34th Street in Spirit Lake is nearly complete. The trail provides improved safety and access to the Spirit Lake Trail at a controlled intersection.

Edgewood Drive Trail: Construction of this segment near Gull Point State Park started in May in conjunction with the Edgewood Drive street and water main project. The trail grade is ready and paving will begin soon after Edgewood Drive is paved. This trail offers improved safety and access to the trails system for residents and campers in the area.

Tatanka Ska Trailhead: Work on the trailhead continues with concrete placement in the parking lot and sidewalks around the structure. The contractor will soon begin erecting the steel components and canopy that are due to arrive in early August.

Tatanka Ska Trace: Construction will start in a week or two on the next segment of the rail trail. The project will extend the trail another 1.2 miles from Highway 86 to the town of Montgomery.

In addition to the above projects, the DCTB is also planning to connect the West Okoboji Trail to Tatanka Ska Trace

starting at the West Okoboji Harbor tunnel and going north to where it joins the rail trail near the Highway 86 crossing. We will set a bid letting date as soon as we get approval from the Iowa DOT and hope to get the trail started yet this fall.

Along with donations to the DCTB development fund, the 2021 trail construction plan is supported by over \$1.5 million in foundation and recreational trail grants. The additions will provide for a safer and more connected trail system. 2021 Summer Fundraiser and July

## Free Take-Home COVID-19 Test Kits Available Locally

Test Iowa, the state's free COVID-19 testing program, has transitioned from offering COVID-19 testing at drive-through locations regionally to providing Iowans access to free, self-administered test kits, which are sent into Iowa's State Hygienic Lab for results. Locally, take-home testing kits will be available to pick up in Spencer Hospital's emergency department.

"The free home testing kits are an easy and affordable way for the Iowa Department of Public Health to continue providing COVID-19 testing for Iowans in need, especially those experiencing symptoms so they can seek treatment options. Tests are also convenient for someone who is required to have a COVID-19 test for travel or other events," explained Colette Rossiter, Clay County Public Health Coordinator.

Rossiter explained that each test kit includes step-by-step instructions. Also, once received, the person taking the test needs to go to the Test Iowa website to register their kit in order to receive test results.

"The instructions are detailed, yet sometimes human nature is to not read all the directions first. We encourage people to first read all the instructions, before executing any of the steps," Rossiter cautioned.

Once all the steps are completed, the test kit should be dropped off at a local UPS site or UPS letterbox to be transported to the state hygienic lab. The person who registered the kit will receive an email with instructions to log on to a patient portal where the results will be listed. Once the specimen arrives at the state lab in Iowa City, it will be processed within 24 hours. Depending on transport time to Iowa City, plan on a 72-hour turn-around time.

Test Iowa at-home is a partnership between the Iowa Department of Public Health (IDPH) and the State Hygienic Lab (SHL). The self-collected saliva test kits are authorized by the FDA under an emergency use authorization. More information can be found on the Test Iowa website: *www.testiowa.com*.
