














SPEAK OUT

We continue with week twenty-six of our study of the United States Constitution. Article VII – Clause 1 reads "The Ratification of the Conventions of nine States, shall be sufficient for the Establishment of this Constitution between the States so ratifying the Same."

Even though there were thirteen states represented at the Second Continental Congress, our founding fathers agreed that the signatures of the representatives of nine states would be sufficient for the ratification of our Constitution.

Again, I previously mentioned the comment by George Washington that all the representatives from all thirteen states being in agreement was a miracle.

We conclude the text of our Constitution with the Secretary of the Second Continental Congress writing "Attest William Jackson Secretary...done in Convention by the Unanimous Consent of the States present the Seventeenth Day of September in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty seven and of the Independence of the United States of America the Twelfth In witness whereof We have hereunto subscribed our Names," The following were the signers of the United States Constitution: George Washington (President of the Second Continental Congress and deputy from Virginia), George Read, Gunning Bedford Jr., John Dickinson, Richard Bassett and Jacob Broom (representatives from Delaware), James McHenry, Daniel of St. Thomas Jenifer, Daniel Carroll (representatives from Maryland), John Blair and James Madison (representatives from Virginia), William Blount, Richard Dobbs Spaight and Hugh Williamson (representatives from North Carolina), John Rutledge, Charles Cotesworth Pinckney, Charles Pinckney and Pierce Butler (representatives from South Carolina), William Few and Abraham Baldwin (representatives from Georgia), John Langdon and Nicholas Gilman (representatives from New Hampshire), Nathaniel Gorham and Rufus King (representatives from Massachusetts), William Samuel Johnson and Roger Sherman (representatives from Connecticut), Alexander Hamilton (representative from New York), William Livingston, David Brearley, William Paterson and Jonathan Dayton (representatives from New Jersey), Benjamin Franklin, Thomas Mifflin, Robert Morris, George Clymer, Thomas FitzSimons, Jared Ingersoll, James Wilson and Gouverneur Morris (representatives from Pennsylvania).

Anyone studying our Constitution will notice some alterations and erasures. The word, "the", being interlined between the seventh and eighth lines of the first page, the word "Thirty" being partly written on an erasure in the fifteenth line of the first page, the words "is tried" being interlined between the thirty second and thirty third lines of the first page and the word "the" being interlined between the forty third and forty fourth lines of the second page."

There are 4543 words in the Constitution. Our United States Constitution is located in Washington, D. C., in the Rotunda for the Charters of Freedom on the upper level of the National Archives Museum. The Rotunda for the Charters of Freedom is not only the permanent home of our United States Constitution but also the original Declaration of Independence and the Bill of Rights.

Next week, Lord willing, I hope to continue our study with a summary of how our Constitution became law.





- Check clothes and skin often for ticks while outdoors.
- Use insect repellent.
- Stay on cleared, well-traveled trails. Walk in the center of trails. Avoid dense woods and bushy areas.
- Bathe or shower within 2 hours after going indoors to wash off and easily find ticks.
- Do a full-body tick check at the end of the day and remove ticks right away.

How to Remove a Tick

- Using fine tipped tweezers, grasp the tick near mouthparts as close to skin as possible.
- Pull tick in an upward, steady motion away from skin.
- Clean the bite site with soap and water, rubbing alcohol, or hydrogen peroxide.
- Record date and location of tick bite. If a rash or flu-like symptoms appear, contact your health care provider as soon as possible.
- The risk of Lyme disease is lower if the tick is removed within 24-36 hours.
