



HOLLYWOOD

HOLLYWOOD - British actor Rege-Jean Page made a splash in Shondra Rhimes' Netflix series "Bridgerton" on Christmas night of 2020. He became an overnight sensation. Fans of the show were shocked when he announced he'd be leaving the series after the first season. When he hosted "Saturday Night Live," he confirmed he'd left the show. Netflix knew what they had and immediately signed him to star in the \$200 million film "The Gray Man," opposite Ana de Armas, Chris Evans and Ryan Gosling, expected to be released for streaming next year. Then Paramount Pictures cast him opposite Chris Pine and Michelle Rodriguez in "Dungeons & Dragons" (due March 3,

Paramount was so impressed with him that they've handed Rege-Jean the plum title role of "The Saint" in the reboot of the 1962 British series that starred Roger Moore, a future James Bond (1962-69), then Ian Ogilvy in "The Return of the Saint" (1978-79) and finally Val Kilmer in the 1997 theatrical film, which flopped.

Paramount Pictures is in a dangerous place. They agreed to release "A Quiet Place 2" for 90 days into theaters after "A Quiet Place" grossed \$350 million. But then they decided to cut the time in theaters in half so they could boost their Paramount+ downloading platform. Producers John Krasinski and Michael Bay, plus its star, Emily Blunt, were poised to receive a big bonus from the theatrical release, and they now are demanding that Paramount make up the monies they've lost due to the shortened release in theaters. Stars such as Tom Cruise and Mark Wahlberg are watching closely to see what Paramount will do, since both of them have major film releases upcoming through that studio. What Paramount does could affect the entire industry and some or all of the streaming platforms.

Meanwhile, MGM has been accused by director Andrew Levitas of trying to bury his film "Minamata" because of the personal negative baggage of its star, Johnny Depp. The film was acquired last fall after MGM relaunched American International Pictures (the studio that gave us the "Beach Party" movies with Frankie Avalon and Annette Funicello in the 1960s). This comes on the heels of Warner Brothers asking Depp to resign from his role of Grindelwald in the Harry Potter spinoff franchise "Fantastic Beasts."

We are convinced that microchipping dogs and cats provides the best chance that a lost animal can be reunited with a home. It is becoming more common for people to pick up strays and decide to keep them and a microchip is an undeniable proof of ownership.

When the Danville Area Humane Society first took over operation of the city animal shelter in 1984, the popular method of proving ownership in cats and dogs was tattooing. Unbelievably, the owner's Social Security number was tattooed on the inner part of one of a dog's or cat's back legs! Can you imagine that in today's world?

A lot has changed since 1984, except for the reality that millions of lost dogs and cats enter shelters each year, and relatively few are returned to the owner, unless that owner has been diligent about providing an easy way home for the animal. In Virginia, shelters and rescue groups are required by law to make a reasonable effort to contact owners within 48 hours of an animal's arrival in their facility, if the animal has some form of identification on

State and local dog license laws are supposed to help return lost dogs to their owner, but very few localities require the licensing of cats. In addition, collars and tags can easily get lost. What, then, can an owner do to increase the odds that their beloved missing pet can be found and returned home?



CITY COUNCIL PLEADS FOR CITIZENS TO GET VACCINE

Mayor Alonzo Jones and other members of Danville City Council pleaded Tuesday night for citizens to get inoculated against COVID-19 amid a surge in cases.

"I don't understand why it is such a battle for people wanting to take care of themselves," Jones said at last night's meeting of the City Council. "Here we have something (a vaccine) that can help us, but because of the politics we are willing to risk not only our lives but the lives of the kids."

His comments followed comments from Vice Mayor Dr. Gary Miller and Councilman Lee Vogler.

Miller said the Delta variant is affecting children now, while Vogler lamented COVID has been politicized.

"There are folks who are big supporters of our current president, and there are folks who are big supporters of our previous president," Vogler said. "There's probably not a lot of things that Joe Biden and Donald Trump have in common, but there's one thing they do have in common, they both got the vaccine. I think everyone should get it."

Miller said he visited the intensive care unit at Sovah Health-Danville earlier in the day.

"There are 14 people on a ventilator. Twelve of them have COVID-19. None were vaccinated," Miller said. "Anybody that doesn't think we have another crisis has their head buried in the sand."

Councilman Sherman Saunders talked about citizens expressing theological excuses against getting the vaccine.

"God will provide,' yeah, God gave you common sense too," Saunders said.

Councilman Lawrence Campbell, who battled COVID and lost his wife to COVID, again shared his experience.

"To have experienced having the virus and in the process thinking you are going to die. You can't breathe. You can't walk. ... I don't know why I am sitting here. Honestly, if anybody should be alive, it should be my wife. ... My wife was a holy lady."

Campbell added, "You (those who remain unvaccinated) are going to play around with life and death when you have an opportunity to not only protect yourself but your family and friends? We know what is going down. This is serious."

Councilman Barry Mayo talked about the surge in COVID cases and how it could place in jeopardy the return of children to the school classrooms.

"It is almost a begging moment to ask the parents who have not even thought about taking the vaccine to look at how serious of a situation this is," Mayo said. "... What is it going to take to say, "I need to do this (get the vaccine).' Don't fool yourself."

Mayor Jones agreed, saying, "I want to encourage everybody to do what it takes, if not for you, then for your kids. I don't see schools staying open if it (surge in COVID cases) keeps going like it is."

On Tuesday, there were 53 new cases of COVID-19 reported in Danville and Pittsylvania County. That number was the highest since February. The spike in caseloads also prompted Sovah Health-Danville to impose restrictions on visitors.

The Centers for Disease Control lists both Danville and Pittsylvania County as areas with high transmission. The CDC uses a fourtiered system to measure a community's level of transmission: low, moderate, substantial, and high.

A community's level of transmission is based on just two metrics: new Covid-19 cases per 100,000 people and the positivity rate, both measured over the last seven days.

Council members also offered their thoughts and prayers to Danville police officer Bonnie Jones and her family. Jones is hospitalized and on a ventilator at Sovah Health-Danville because of COVID.

In addition to her parents, Mrs. Dowdy was predeceased by her siblings, Vernon Crowder and George Crowder, Jr.



In a large bowl, whisk together eggs, salt, pepper, and hot sauce.


Add hash browns, shredded cheese, cottage cheese, bacon and onions.

Mix until combined.




