Water Shuttle in Labor Day Weekend Preview

In the works for a couple of years, the Twin Cities Water Shuttle will have a preview on the upcoming Labor Day Weekend. And the best part is that you'll be able to ride free as the shuttle boat makes its way around several stops on the St. Joseph River, preparing for full-scale paid operation in 2022.

MoodyOnTheMarket.com sat down with the man behind the Water Shuttle idea, Brady Cohen. Cohen is the general manager of the Inn At Harbor Shores. However, the water shuttle is an expansion of his side business, which has been operating the Southwest Michigan Cycle Boat the past couple of Summers. Brady co-owns the cycle boat and shuttle with his brother and business partner, Brandon Cohen.

Brady Cohen is excited about the Water Shuttle: "This has been in the works for two years. We're finally going to be able to get people on the water. We're going to help people experience the Twin Cities' biggest asset, the water," says Cohen. He describes the planned route for the shuttle as having several major stops: The Inn at Harbor Shores, the St. Joseph Arboretum, Tavern On theRiver, and Riverview Drive in Benton Harbor (near Breadbar and Babe's).

Cohen's vision for the ticketed shuttle in 2022 is for an All Day Pass, in the \$10-\$15 per

person range. He says, " Maybe they'd park at the Courthouse Lot. board at the Arboretum, perhaps stop for a couple of beverages along the way, enjoy dinner, and come

Our event hopes to raise awareness for any person taking on a unique journey with a disability or developmental difference while raising funding for the rare disease non-profit for children, The TBCK Foundation.

ABOUT THE TBCK FOUNDATION

The TBCK Foundation is a rare disease non-profit founded for research, advocacy, and education of the rare pediatric neuro-genetic disease, TBCK Syndrome. Part of the mission of The TBCK Foundation is accelerating research for TBCK Syndrome, which remains underresearched with limited understanding of the disease. Our other focus is supporting TBCK families and other "rare" families as they navigate through the world of disability and raising medically-complex children.



back to their starting point. They could make a day or evening of it!3

Cohen says there's nothing similar to the Twin Cities Water Shuttle in the immediate Lake Michigan region. However, he's seen it work in the Naples, Florida area, where he lived and worked for several years.

Cohen describes the recent acquisition of the shuttle boat as "the major hurdle" to his plan. He located what he describes as a "26 foot former Navy Whaler" in Northern Michigan, thoroughly checked it out, and purchased it. The boat arrived in St. Joseph recently. He says it's expected to handle 20 passengers, once certified by the Coast Guard. And a former Coast Guardsman will be the primary captain. Cohen says that Andrew Vanderveen spent 25 years with the Coast Guard and has been handling the Cycle Boat this Summer. He anticipates Vanderveen will be captaining the Water Shuttle next year.

Helping organize the Water Shuttle, arranging for the dock facilities and providing needed financial backing is Cornerstone Alliance, the area's economic development organization. Cornerstone Alliance President Rob Cleveland shares Cohen's excitement about the project, and the Labor Day preview event:

"Cornerstone Alliance is excited to offer the community a new amenity, that provides a new mode of transportation, a new way to access the water, and new connectivity throughout our communities. The water taxi is a pilot program that will be used to define the long-term interest of this kind of service during the summer months. It is another key piece of the development of the harbor, along with new features like a kayak launch on Riverview Drive in Benton Harbor. "

Cleveland says the Water Shuttle is a perfect example of the kind of creative development that warrants community support:"

"This is about trying something new and different, and is an attempt to set our community apart from the other communities along Lake Michigan. We've heard from many people that this is the kind of thing they would use, if it were available. The ultimate success of a water taxi will be directly dependent upon the community. We need people to come out and try the water taxi. We need people to get out at the stops and enjoy dinner or drinks at the restaurants and bars along the way. We need community partners to financially support the long-term sustainability of the water taxi.'

The free Labor Day preview of the Twin Cities Water Shuttle will run from noon to 8 pm, stops are confirmed at the Inn at Harbor Shores, the Upton Arboretum, Tavern On The River and along Riverview Drive in Benton Harbor.

Female Combat Vet Pens Novel With A Message

"I'm excited to share my stories with the World."

That from a Southwest Michigan mother of two, Army combat veteran, wife and St. Joseph credit union employee who lives in Allegan. Next month, she's launching her literary career with the release of her first novel, flowing from her service in Iraq.

Cecilia A. Garcia is the author of the upcoming 'Always Forward' series. It's a mili-



tary fiction series that faces issues dealing with post traumatic stress, survivor's guilt and sexual trauma in captivity. Although 'Always Forward' is completely fiction, Garcia did draw off her own experiences from

serving in the US Army.

Garcia served eight years in the Army as an '88M20', a truck driver, with one combat deployment to Iraq. She received the Purple Heart from injuries sustained in action on May 25th, 2004. Since leaving the military, Garcia has become an advocate for the mental health community and raising awareness around what it is like to live with PTSD.









Garcia tell us that she has a passion for speaking out on mental health and breaking the stigma around living with PTSD. Her goal is that mental health becomes normalized and more people realize that it truly is "okay to not be okay". Through her writings, she hopes that people can connect with the stories, no matter if they have military background or not.

Garcia has been married to her husband, whom she met in the military, for 21 years. Together, they have two daughters, three dogs and two cats. When she is not writing, she loves to run, practice yoga, working in her gardens and of course, she loves to read!!

Of course, you're wondering about the plot of the book! So here's a tease, the blurb or synopsis of 'Always Forward' from Garcia's website:

Sgt. Emily Sanders considered herself a soldier first, but that didn't make it any easier to leaver her four-year-old daughter and infant daughter behind when she left for a year-long deployment to Iraq. Sanders' was on a routine mission when her convoy was ambushed by insurgents. Those that survived had no choice to leave the casualties behind. But when the unit went back to clear the vehicles and retrieve the fallen, Sanders was not one of the confirmed dead.

After eight years of searching, the military had no choice but to change her status from MIA-missing in action, to KIA, killed in action. Tara Sanders might have been young when her mother left and never returned home, but she never believed that her mother was dead. Tara is going back to the last place her mother was seen alive in the hopes to learn more about her mother's death. If there was anything Tara remembered about her mother it was her motto, you only move in one direction- Always Forward.

Where did the concept come from? Garcia tells us, "I originally came up with the story line for Always Forward while serving in Iraq and it stayed in my head for about 16 years before I



began to write bits and pieces of it. The fall of 2019 was when I got serious with writing it and then when Covid hit, I continued to write.

"She

says she's

not done with Sargent Emily Sanders and her family. "I plan on releasing two more novellas in this series (both in 2022), and will have a spin-off series for some of the other characters as well (2023-2024)."

Garcia says the writing has been very personal. "Although this series is fiction, I drew off many of my personal experiences of being injured in Iraq and living with PTSD."

MOTM asked her why she slightly altered her identity to become an author. "I chose a pen name because- why not?! This series is going to be a little controversial for some people and groups, and I wanted to distinguish myself as an author and try to keep this separate from being a mother, wife and credit union employee. The name Cecilia was given to me at my 8th grade confirmation, and is the patron saint of music. And music is a huge part of my life, so it fits me perfectly!"

Garcia feels her new role as a professional author will contribute to what she considers her higher mission in life. "Over the last 17 years since being home from Iraq, I have made it my mission to raise awareness around mental health. I organized for three years an event called Upward Spiral, which was a 24-hour free event where people could run/walk on an indoor track, do yoga, and other activities. We partnered with Allegan County Mental Health to have resources on site for people, along with Griffin's Place and other organizations. It was great and helped to bring awareness to mental health and how physical activities can help you mentally."

She adds, "I have also done other big runs, like my Alive Day Run in 2017 for Honor Credit Union, where I ran 40+ miles in 12 hours to raise money for several Veteran Organizations and the VA hospital. I also speak to businesses and organizations on what it's like to be a female combat veteran and the stigmas that go with that label."

Garcia told us she now considers Michigan's Great Southwest to be home. "I am originally from Ohio, and moved to Michigan after my husband and I completed our active duty Army enlistment contracts. He is from West Michigan, and we wanted to be close to his family and still be relatively close to mine. We have lived in Allegan for the last 18 years, and even in the same historic farmhouse for all these years!"

'Always Forward' is set to release on September 25.

In July, the housing market sales dropped 19 percent behind from a year ago while the selling prices increased and set records when compared to previous years. The robust market continued even a 37 percent drop in

inventory of houses for sale.

In July, at 388, the number of houses sold fell 19 percent below the 479 houses sold in July 2020. Yearto-date, the number of houses sold at the end of July was 2132, up 22 percent over July 2020 (2132 vs.1748). This notched a new sales record in the year-over-year sales records since 2006.

Selling prices continued to set new record levels each month in 2021. The average selling price in July 2021 was \$351,131 compared to \$337,697 in July 2020, for a 4 percent increase. Year-to-date selling prices at the end of July also set records in the yearover-year comparison. The year-to-date average selling price in July 2021 rose 19 percent over July 2020 (\$321,074 vs. \$268,934).

The median selling price in July 2021 increased 5 percent to \$240,500 from \$230,000 in July 2020. Year-to-date, the median selling price climbed 13 percent (\$225,000 vs. \$200,000). The median selling price and year-to-date median selling price also set new record prices in the month of July in the yearover-year comparison.

The median price is the price at which 50% of the homes sold were above that price, and 50% were below.

The Housing Market in Southwestern Michigan

The inventory of houses for sale plummeted 37 percent from a year ago (889 vs. 1399), bringing the inventory of houses for sale to a 3.1-months supply of inventory available for buyers. This is the highest inventory level this year. At the end of July 2020, the market had a 6.6-months supply of houses for sale. For comparison, in July 2009, there were 3661 houses for sale and an 18.1-months supply of inventory.

The total dollar volume dropped 16 percent in July 2021 (\$136,238,880 vs.161,759,996). Due to the number of sales at higher prices, the year-to-date total dollar volume set new records for the dollar volume at the end of July (\$684.530.317 vs.\$470.098.082). The year-to-date total dollar volume rose 46 percent.

The number of bank-owned or foreclosed homes as a percentage of all transactions staved at 1 percent in July, which it was in June and May. This was the lowest percentage in 2021. In January, the rate was 4 percent. The previous lowest percentage in July was 1 percent in 2020. The highest percentage in July was 35 percent in 2009.

We can no longer report the local mortgage due to the difficulty in obtaining rates from lenders. Nationally, the Freddie Mac mortgage rate in July was 2.8, down slightly from 2.98 in June for a 30-year conventional mortgage.






