World War II museum dedicated to Berks general preparing to open in Boyertown

In the five years that the General Carl Spaatz National U.S. Army Air Forces Museum in Boyertown has been planned, the focus has been on creating a place that would present World War II history in interesting and exciting ways, said Col. Keith Seiwell, CEO.

With the museum's grand opening now set for Saturday, Oct. 2, and six of its 10 exhibits designed to be interactive, the retired Marine from Schwenksville said its mission is close to being accomplished.

"We wanted it to be a living history museum," he said, "and we're taking it to the next level." The museum at 28

Warwick St. is dedicated to Spaatz, who was born and raised in Boyertown and who trained most of the American pilots who fought in WWI.

Spaatz also pioneered air-to-air refueling and commanded the Strategic Air Forces of WWII that forever changed the way war is fought, Seiwell said. He became the first chief of staff of the new U.S. Air Force in 1947, and his commands included the Eighth Air Force, North African Air Force, U.S. Strategic Air Forces in Europe and all American Air Forces in the Pacific after the war was won in Europe.

Renowned American

generals such as Patton, Nimitz and Bradley have museums dedicated to them, and now Spaatz deservedly will too, Seiwell said.

But the museum will also bring to life the entirety of World War II, he said.

In addition to self-guided tours with audio descriptions, the museum will also offer an enhanced, immersive experience that invites small groups to "live the mission."

Exhibits will guide them through preparing for, flying and surviving flight and combat. Museum staff, dressed in WWII uniforms, will talk the talk of the wartime era. They will immerse museum visitors in the sights and sounds of aerial warfare, including attending pre-flight briefings, donning gear and equipment, piloting a bomber, acting as crew members and bombardiers.

Though the B-17 flight simulator exhibit won't be ready when the museum opens, the other interactive exhibits will be, including two escape rooms based on a POW barracks and a French

farmhouse.

There will also be a Hall of Heroes telling the stories of men and women from Berks who served during the war.

The interactive format should be especially appealing to school-age children and young adults, who are a big part of the museum's focus, Seiwell said.

"It's a fun way to teach people," he said. "We're providing a learning experience about World War II that the youth of today may not get anywhere else."

Thousands of hours of work from about a dozen volunteers have gone into preparing the museum to open, and those people have done work that ranged from carpentry and electrical upgrades to painting and cleaning, Seiwell said.

"They made this possi-

ble, along with the generous people who supported us with much-needed financing," he said.

The website for the museum is still being set up, but those interested can find out more at its Facebook page at facebook.com/GeneralSpaatzMuseum.

The grand opening will take place at 10 a.m., and the museum will open that day at 1 p.m. for self-guided tours for \$5.

The museum's regular hours will then be from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. each Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday, with general admission/self-guided tours costing \$10. The interactive tours, which will require online reservations, will cost \$25 at first, but will likely rise to \$35 when the flight simulator opens.

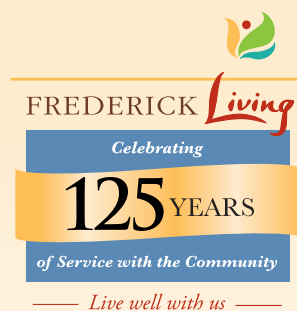

45th Annual Hay Creek Festival returns to Historic Joanna Furnace

Living history event Sept. 10 to 12 shows rural life of 19th century iron-making village

Organizers, sponsoring partners and almost 800 interpreters, craftsmen and volunteers are fine-tuning countless details for the opening of the 2021 edition of the Hay Creek Festival in Morgantown.

From Friday through Sunday, Sept. 10-12, the 45th annual event will be held from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on the grounds of the historic Joanna Furnace Ironworks, an 18th and 19th century charcoal-fueled iron furnace and community.

Visitors travel through time to the 19th century Joanna Furnace community, experiencing the sights, sounds, aromas and activities of life in a rural industrial iron-making village. The interpretation timeline runs from the beginning of the furnace in 1791 up to the 1950s. Visitors will experience the sights, sounds, aromas and activities which have long since disappeared from contemporary life.

Living History

The Hay Creek Festival is truly a one-of-a-kind "living history adventure". The exhibits and demonstrations include traditional early American crafts, a contemporary craft market, living history presentations and interpretations, vintage industrial revolution era working equipment, threshing demonstrations, a working sawmill, children's hands-on activities, a traditional four-square kitchen herb garden, Civil War and World War II encampments, antique vehicles, steam engines and tractors, traditional folk music presentations, homemade festive foods and more.

The Early American

Crafts area includes domestic and village industry demonstrations of skills which were necessary for a self-sustaining rural industrial community through the 18th and 19th centuries. Open fire cooking, food preservation and bake oven demonstrations will take place throughout the weekend. Samples of these early American foods will be available.

This year's Creekside Crafts Market includes redware pottery, ceramics, dolls, cloths, soaps & lotions, jewelry, woodcrafts, antiques and many home décor items.

In the Mechanical Technology area, visitors will see an assortment of early gas and steam engines, models, antique cars and tractors, sawmill and threshing demonstrations and a line shaft powering 100-year old industrial machinery in the Joanna Furnace Mechanical Technology

Building. A newly expanded World War II encampment will also be featured in this area.

The Civil War Encampment celebrates how soldiers lived and trained in the mid-19th century. Visitors can chat with Civil War era soldier and civilian re-enactors to learn more about that epic time. Reenactors will also offer a mini skirmish each day at the festival.

For the first time, visitors will be able to see Hay Creek's latest restoration project — The Joanna Furnace Wheelwright Shop. This historic building, restored in 2019 and completed in 2020, houses the Parke Fleming wheelwright tool collection from Geigertown. The wheelwright shop will be used for live interpretation of the wheelwright's activities. This building has been underwritten by an anonymous donor family of the Hay

Creek Valley Historical Association.

In the Joanna Furnace Mule Stable, Hay Creek's new Tri-County Heritage Library committee will exhibit various artifacts and displays from the community including Grace Mines, Col. Jacob Morgan's home, World War II veterans and more local relics.

Activities for Children

Sept. 10 is designated Student Day at the festival. In past years, as many as 1,000 students have taken advantage of Student Day activities. Public, private and home school groups and co-ops are invited to participate in this fun, learning historic experience. Download a Student Day registration form at www.haycreek.org.

There will be children's activities throughout the weekend, including archaeological segments, candle and

papermaking, early American games, Civil War marching and drilling, to name a few. Children should pick up their "chores list" at the festival gate which will feature all the hands-on activities at the event. Upon completion of a variety of tasks children will be rewarded with a free wagon ride.

Festival Food

Truly a feasting paradise for festival goers, the wide menu is prepared and served by Hay Creek volunteers and community non-profit organizations and includes chicken pot pie, hamburgers, hot dogs, turkey and roast beef sandwiches, festival-favorite Mabel's open fire cooked soups, breads, hand-dipped ice cream, funnel cakes, and French fries.

The festival also features homemade corn and shepherd's pie for visitors to enjoy. Freshly pressed apple cider will be made daily in the

Joanna Furnace cider mill. Many of the festival foods are also available to purchase to take home.

Admission is \$10 for adults, \$2 for children ages 6 to 12, free for children age 5 and younger. The Festival runs each day from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Parking is free on the festival grounds on Friday. For the safety of visitors, all are encouraged to park safely on the easy access lots just off Route 10. Free continuously running shuttle buses will be provided from an off-site parking area from 9:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.

The Hay Creek Valley Historical Association's Joanna Furnace site is located three miles north of Morgantown on Route 10, with close access to both the Pennsylvania Turnpike Morgantown Interchange 298 and Route I 176.

Annual Chester County Day set for Oct. 2

WEST CHESTER » The 80th Annual Chester County Day will be held on Saturday, Oct. 2, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Being the longest running historic home tour in the country, the tour has so much to offer in the way of history, architecture, and interior design.

A project of the Women's Auxiliary to Chester County Hospital, "The Day," as it is affectionately called, has raised more than \$5 million for the hospital. Proceeds from this year's tour will benefit the Women's Auxiliary's new pledge toward a state-of-the-art Women's Breast Center at Chester County Hospital.

The 2021 tour will feature Chester County's most beautiful homes and exquisite gardens in the south-

west quadrant, including a walking tour in West Chester Borough. We invite you to visit five historic and interesting homes in the Everhart Park area of the town. The Park is the second oldest park in the borough. The 10.2 acres of land was originally owned by William Everhart and donated to the town in 1905. A gazebo was built in 1908 and rare trees were planted in 1909. Stop at the park to enjoy a picnic lunch. Boxed lunches are available for purchase from Arianna's Gourmet Café or bring your own.

Continue the tour to enjoy local art that will be on display in the galleries at the nearby Chester County Art Association.

The tour continues into East Bradford township to visit six historic properties including an 1850s home

that was originally an Arabian horse farm and later a dairy farm, with many interesting architectural features, collections of 18th and 19th century furnishings and beautiful gardens. Nearby enjoy touring a sprawling 1775 farmhouse with many additions including construction of a new barn, our second lunch and picnicking stop where you can also enjoy a boxed lunch from Arianna's.

Deborah's Rock Farm is a special property to tour. The land was first settled in 1724 and today it includes 90 conserved acres adjoining the Stroud Preserve. The existing homestead was constructed in three phases, most recently it was fully restored in 2015 by the current owners.

Continue on in East Bradford to visit a 1730's co-

lonial style farmhouse and another sprawling farm on Lucky Hill Road. The core of Seeds Rock Farm on Alerton Road was likely built before 1764 with additions in 1860 and its newest addition in 2016. This property was once the site of the Brandywine Fox Hunt.

Visit the quaint village of Unionville to see the original General Store and Post Office now home to Catherine's restaurant where you can enjoy lunch inside or on the shady outdoor patio. Stroll down to the historic buildings nearby which is home to Kinloch Woodworking and Farmer and Co. Visit the tranquil Unionville Community Park to take in the views and enjoy a picnic lunch in their pavilion.

hunt. The 2021 event will be hosted by the Cheshire Hunt just outside Unionville, complete with hounds, horses, and horns, and will set off promptly at 9 am. Nearby in hunt country, visit a circa 1864 brick farmhouse with a 1932 addition. Situated on 60 acres, this magnificent home has remained in the same family. Enjoy the lovely countryside to visit a newer home

set on 250 acres. The interior features beautifully carved mantles and archways and generations of family photos that mirror fox hunting history for which Unionville is famous.

Boxed lunches must be pre-ordered before the Day. Boxed lunches from Arianna's Gourmet Café are available for pick up at two lunch stops on the tour route or
