What started as a three-block festival to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the burger has turned into an eight-block event featuring four stages of non-stop entertainment, amateur and professional burger eating competitions, beer and wine gardens, children's activities, quality artisans and crafters, and of course, LOTS of burgers.

3rd, 4th, Pine, and State Streets in the downtown business district will be closed to vehicular traffic to allow 38 restaurants, caterers, and community organizations to grill their most tantalizing burgers and whip up sensational side dishes for thousands of visitors to sample. Creativity and unique combinations are the norm, as vendors vie for the Best Burger award determined by panels of "food junkie" judges. Of course, winners of the contests get bragging rights for the year, in addition to the awards presented by a panel of judges. But not only are there burgers. Numerous other concessionaires sell a variety of other tasty foods that pair well with burgers: fries, pierogis, mac and cheese, salads, funnel cakes, ice cream and other desserts just to name a few.

The festival is organized and hosted by Our Town Foundation, Hamburg's non-profit community revitalization corporation, who is proud to present this family-fun festival that offers free admission and is affordable for all to attend.

"Steer" yourself to Hamburg, walk your "buns" to the downtown, and "relish" the experience. There is no "bull" about it - you will have an "udder-ly" great time and possibly "ketch-up" with some friends. But remember, come early and come hungry!

Parking

When you get to the festival, parking is available in four designated areas for a nominal fee of \$5. All parking proceeds benefit the festival. The four areas are: the Hamburg Field House at the rear of 127 South 4th Street, the Hamburg High School parking lot at 701 Windsor Street, a lot between State Street and the Schuylkill River located at 137 Schuylkill Avenue and a lot located at the intersection of Grand and Front Street. If you are arriving from the east via State Street, it's best to use the Hamburg Field House parking lot. If arriving from the west via State Street, turn left directly after crossing the Schuylkill River bridge and someone will guide you to the Schuylkill Avenue lot.

For those traveling north via Rte 61, the Hamburg High School is your better choice. Those traveling South on Route 61, the Front and Grand Street lot is best. We offer shuttle bus transportation from Hamburg High School, the Hamburg Field House and the Grand and Front Street parking lots. The shuttle bus is not equipped to accommodate wheelchairs. (See Handicap Parking.)

If you would prefer to find your own free, on-street parking, we suggest that you get to the festival early because the spaces go quickly!

Handicap Parking

Handicap parking is located at the First United Church of Christ parking lot located at the intersection of 3rd & Pine Streets. Entry to the parking lot must be made from Peach Alley. Only guests with handicapped placards will be allowed to enter. All others will be towed at the owner's expense. There are also handicapped spaces available on the Hamburg Field House lot; however the shuttle from that lot is not equipped to accommodate wheelchairs. Handicapped guests are also welcome to be dropped off at the blocked intersections; however your vehicle must be moved immediately to one of the parking lots.





Outside of the industrial ruins of early 20th century boom towns where steel mills and coal mines thrived and steam engines thundered through the valleys, Cody Tyler & Gypsy Convoy are forging their own path through the foothills of Appalachia. The songs on their forthcoming debut album are the product of Cody Tyler's musings while hunting deep in the Pennsylvania wilderness. With a long history that dates back to the colonial era, Cody's family has hunted the hard timbers, tilled the fields, worked in the mines, and sweated in the steel mills of Pennsylvania for generations. Cody's father, a third-generation trucker, inspired Cody's love of roots music and hunger for the open road from a young age. Like his family of truckers and travelers that came before him, his yearning for the road was bred into him. At just 27 years old, his musical journey has barely begun, but his yearning to travel the open road with his songs written from his tree stand have already taken him across the United States as a solo artist.

Cody and the Convoy may be from above the Mason-Dixon line in Reading, PA, but they have forged a country/roots sound of their own that tips its hat to the blue collar men and women of the Keystone State's Appalachian heartland. Gypsy Convoy are a collection of battle-tested musicians that have collectively earned their stripes sweating it out in venues across the state for decades.

In 2019 and 2020, the Central Pennsylvania Music Hall of Fame nominated Cody Tyler & Gypsy Convoy for three Central Pennsylvania Music Awards. Cody was a Top 150 vocalist for Season 14 of NBC's The Voice, reaching the executive producer callback auditions in Los Angeles. In 2019, the band were the runner-up in the Tumbleweed Country Music Festival Rising Star Talent Search, which featured over 300 artists from the United States and Canada.

Their forthcoming debut album encompasses the sound Cody describes as "Black Dirt Country," which derives its name from the fertile dirt tilled by the Amish for centuries and the rocky soil of the Appalachian coal country. The feel of the songs is just as dark, as if they flowed down the mountains and into the Susquehanna River

In addition to Cody, the band features an all-star lineup of the best musicians from across the Keystone State.

Bass guitarist Kenny "Play" Peffley is an experienced songsmith and vocalist. He utilizes 5-string basses and uses the band "Rush" philosophy for writing. Arranging and crafting songs with Cody Tyler together they create memorable verses, bridges and choruses.

Drummer Kenneth Mettam studied music at the Berklee College of Music in Boston, MA, the US Naval School of Music at the Little Creek Amphibious Base in Norfolk, VA, and earned a Bachelor of Science in Music Education at Lebanon Valley College in Annville, PA. He also spent two years studying with jazz musician and educator Joe Morello at his studio in West Orange, N.J. Kenneth spent two years touring the US, Canada, and Europe with Blues legend and W.C. Handy Award nominee, "Big" Jack Johnson and the Oilers. He has honorably performed as a member of the 389th Army Band.


On harmonica is the postman-by-day Murray Perlstein, who enjoys disc-golf and fishing when he isn't on the road delivering mail or traveling with the Convoy.

The newest addition to the Convoy is Lenny Casper on keys. Lenny brings a whole new layer of depth and blistering hot piano solos to give the Convoy a southern edge, reminiscent of the music on which Cody was raised.

You know you got the blues when you are Pawn\$hop Bound...

Named after a song by the late great bluesman William Clarke, Pawnshop Bound strives to bring the blues to a larger audience. Formed in 2011,the band started as a harmonica and guitar drenched rockin' blues quartet. Today P\$B has evolved into a drivin' blues band featuring keyboards, guitar, bass and drums. There are many influences evident in the music which include the legends Muddy Waters and Freddy King to their contemporaries Tommy Castro and Poppa Chubby.

Over the years Pawn\$hop Bound has performed at many area clubs, bars, restaurants, wineries, breweries, music and blues festivals and private events. In August of 2018 the band was honored to be inducted into the Berks County Rock and Roll Hall of Fame.


