very season has something unique to offer the Rock Island visitors, but Park Manager Damon Graham's favorite season is spring. The profusion of wildflowers, including some rare orchids, as well as migrating birds, make Rock Island feel magical.

Have you ever seen an osprey, with its six-foot wingspan, pulling its sushi dinner out of the river right in front of you? That is a sight to behold and something to put on your bucket list. In addition to osprey, eagles call the park home year-round, and visitors can see a wide variety of songbirds, some rare, at the park. Birds are most likely to be seen during spring and fall during migration when the park has fewer visitors. The quiet surroundings make bird sightings more common.

#### Spring

Spring rains make the park water levels change drastically. The roar of the water and awe-inspiring churning help one to appreciate the power and strength in all of those individual droplets merging in the rivers. While not all trails and areas are accessible with high water, it is a sight to behold.

Be aware of potential water release by the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA). If you hear sirens or notice rising water, retreat immediately to higher ground.

The centerpiece of the 883-acre Rock Island State Park is the beautiful Center Hill Lake along with three rivers: Caney Fork, Collins, and Rocky River.

#### Summer

Summer brings an influx of visitors for the variety of outdoor activities available. Weekends are often overflowing, so be sure to arrive early or plan to visit midweek to enjoy the park. Families enjoy swimming at the sandy beach on Center Hill Lake and taking advantage of the three boat launches. Fishing is always popular at Rock Island; be sure you have your license if you are 13 years or older. Camping and picnicking help to extend the outdoor experience. Eating outdoors gives you a million-dollar view and enhances the flavor of your food.

Seasonal ranger-led activities include kayaking, nature walks, and animal presentations, among others. Check the park's website for schedule information.

#### Fall

The coolness of fall brings fewer visitors and a return of migrating birds. It is a wonderful time to lose yourself in the oasis of Rock Island. Enjoy the crunchy leaves as you hike or the beauty of the fall colors as you kayak around Center Hill Lake.

People who have mobility challenges love seeing an amazing waterfall from the parking lot. At Rock Island beauty is available to people with all levels of health and fitness.

Immerse yourself at Rock Island by staying for a few days. RV hookup sites are available year-round while tent camping can be done March 15 - October. Camping is a wonderful way to get back in touch with nature, but if a few more luxuries are your preference, there are lovely rental cabins available.

#### Winter

Winter at Rock Island can have a magic of its own. The leaves have fallen so you can see the views more clearly with the fewest visitors. A vigorous walk in a beautiful place warms both body and soul.

As John Burroughs said, "I go to nature to be soothed and healed, and to have my senses put in order." Rock Island State Park is nearby in every season to assist with our mental and physical health.

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



# **Concert Venue**

### in McMinnville

Adventure and beauty await you above and below ground. Release your inner explorer.

Where is the coolest place to see a concert in Middle Tennessee? Yep. Cumberland Caverns. As a concert venue, it is literally the coolest place to see a concert with a year-round temperature of 56 degrees. Plus, it is a space that rivals other unique concert experiences like Red Rock Amphitheater in Colorado or Dalhalla Amphitheatre in Sweden.

Did you know that people come from all over the United States and the world to explore Cumberland Caverns? At 32 miles long, it is the second-longest cave in Tennessee and makes the list of longest cave systems in the world. It has been open for exploring since 1956. Even on the shortest walking tour, explorers will be fascinated by the history of the cave while getting to see an underground waterfall, gleaming pools of water, and some of the largest rooms inside the cave system. This is truly something that must be experienced first-hand.

Concerts aren't the only offerings at Cumberland Caverns. Weddings and other events happen regularly inside the cave. If you like staying above ground and shopping, there is a delightful gift shop. When you've finished your browsing and purchases, sit a spell in the rocking chairs on the front porch and admire the view.

If you want an all-out intensive cave experience, you can release your inner spelunker. The Legacy Tour is the most extreme tour at Cumberland Caverns with rock climbing, crevasses, and a canyon. The trip includes areas of the cave not previously permitted to the public and will give you a true taste of adventure. There are even 20,000 year-old lynx bones that you will view. You must be at least 16 years old to participate in the Legacy Tour.

There are other less intense spelunking tours, depending on your age and desired level of adventure.

If you want the coolest campout ever, you've got to try one of the overnight caving adventure packages. Technically, it will be a "camp in" since you get to camp overnight inside the cave and go exploring. If you have a lot of friends who want to join you, not to worry,

groups of 200 can stay overnight. The campouts are paired with a cave tour, so you can enjoy the level of challenge and adventure that feels right for you.

If you want a small taste of caving before committing to a bigger adventure, try the Discovery Walking Tour. This 90-minute tour is an excellent opportunity to see a sampling of Cumberland Caverns' jaw-dropping beauty. They offer this tour daily, departing every hour, on the hour beginning at 9 AM until 5 PM Central Time so there are plenty of opportunities to take a tour.

If hiking is for you, but caves don't appeal, there are hiking trails above ground you can explore. Wear sturdy shoes, and experience following trail blazes or markers is suggested. Spring is a particularly beautiful time to go hiking and admire the wildflowers.

Cumberland Caverns was discovered in 1810 by surveyor Aaron Higgenbotham who made the mistake of venturing into



the cave alone. He was stranded for three days on a ledge after his torch went out. Local legend says that his hair turned completely white while waiting to be rescued.

Not to worry, the experts at Cumberland Caverns are professionals, and, rest assured, you will have a safe adventure. No food, drinks, tobacco, or gum are permitted on the tour. Yes, there are restrooms in the cave as well as electricity in select areas. It truly is something to experience firsthand.

Cumberland Caverns is open 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. central time, 362 days a year (closed on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve, and Christmas Day; Easter Sunday they open at 1 p.m.). They are located at 1437 Cumberland Caverns Road in McMinnville. Whatever pleases you, you can find it at Cumberland Caverns.

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


ISHA offers stress relief, meditation and outdoor recreation

For those visiting overnight or for a couple of days, the facility serves two vegetarian meals and a snack each day. Cooking



classes are also among one of the many classes Isha offers to its visitors. Some of the programs offered are the Bhuta Shuddhi program, Samyama Sadhana for both men and women, and Inner Engineering Completion, among others. These programs all vary in technique, but all strive to reach a state of harmony and balance through purifying breathing techniques. The classes and programs vary in experience so there is something for everyone, whether you are a beginner or an experienced visitor.

The Isha foundation is mostly run by more than 11 million volunteers from all kinds of backgrounds worldwide. Many of these volunteers are previous visitors that have become inspired by their own experience at Isha and now seek to share Sadguru's teachings.

The Isha foundation is so committed to helping people obtain a deep sense of well-being that once a month, they offer a free yoga day. During this special event, visitors can expect a yoga class of at least fifteen minutes and a quick cooking class that is healthy and supports the liveliness of the body. These free yoga classes do not require physical agility or previous experience, therefore making it suitable for everyone.
