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Piedmont Pets
September 2, 2021 By Paulette Dean

Hurricane Ida struck Louisiana on Sunday, August 29th, bringing back horrible memories of Hurricane Katrina. I remember hearing the horror stories of people evacuating on buses having to leave their beloved pets behind. One little boy I remember sobbed as he told the story about leaving his little terrier on the sidewalk beside the bus. I realize I am a broken record when it comes to advocating disaster plans for pets.

We received some of the Katrina animals and a few days after we received them, we had a rainstorm. All of the dogs and cats brought from Louisiana shook in fear, even though it was not a hard rain.

Benjamin Franklin once said, "Experience keeps a dear school, but fools will learn in no other." Because of the experience of Hurricane Katrina, local/state/federal emergency and disaster plans must include pets.

Individual households also benefit from having an emergency response plan in place. Any plan must include your companion animals. Your animal's best protection is to be with you. But taking a pet requires special planning. Locate a safe place for your pets before disaster strikes. Evacuation shelters generally do not accept any animal, so we suggest you call hotels and motels a reasonable distance from your home and ask if they accept pets, under what conditions, and whether there are any restrictions as to the size and number of animals. We have prepared the city animal shelter for an emergency; however, do not rely solely on local animal shelters, because during emergencies they are filled beyond capacity with strays and rescued animals.

A few simple steps can protect your pets: Keep up-to-date identification on your dog or cat at all times. Make sure the collar is properly fitted (avoid chain link collars for dogs and use breakaway collars for cats). For the best protection, have all your dogs and cats microchipped; be sure to register the chip number. Keep current color photos of your pet, showing any distinguishing marks, with your emergency supplies. If you and your pet become separated, these photos will help identify him/her. If you know a disaster is imminent, bring your pets inside immediately! (The obvious exception to this is in the case of a house fire.) Get your animals under control as soon as possible, either on a leash or inside a carrier.

Disasters often strike while you're away from home. Consider an arrangement with a neighbor who would be willing to evacuate your pet in your absence.

My church teaches us to be personally prepared for emergencies, and we are counseled to have an emergency supply kit available for each member of the household. An emergency kit for each of your pets' needs is also essential. Include in this kit at least a three-day supply of food and water, food/water bowls, regular medications, a first aid kit, a carrier (essential for cats), leashes, and a litter box and litter for cats. Small mammals and birds must have cages.

Dogs and cats are not the only pets that should be included in your plan. Birds can be transported in a pet carrier or travel cage. When it's cold, wrap a blanket around the cage. A few slices of fresh fruit or vegetable with a high water content placed in the cage will provide fluid temporarily.

Other small mammals should be placed in secure, suitable carriers. Be prepared to provide bedding materials, food, bowls, and water bottles.

Reptiles also need special care. Snakes may be able to be transported in a pillowcase, but must be transferred to more secure housing when the destination is reached. Take food and bowls, and include a bowl large enough for soaking. Also take a heating pad. House lizards can be transported the same way birds are.

Remember, during an emergency, your pets will also suffer from stress and trauma, just as you will. Do not expect them to react in a normal manner, so make special efforts to make them feel secure.

If we do not learn from the costly experience of past disasters, we will be very foolish indeed.

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

Satsuma Vase

Satsuma pottery is from Japan. It was made in the 1860s and was sometimes purchased by American visitors to Japan and brought home. During World War I, American housewives who enjoyed hand-painting china could not get any from Germany, so they imported undecorated white Satsuma and made what is now called "American Satsuma" with stylized art deco decorations. But by the 1950s, the antique Satsuma was rediscovered by collectors and the pottery from Asia was prized. Old Satsuma has a creamy, slightly yellow background decorated in red, green, blue and orange, and highlighted with gold paint.



This Satsuma vase with intricate reticulation and decoration brought over \$14,000 at a Cottone auction.

A rare type of old Satsuma made in the Meiji period (1868-1912) is called Reticulated Satsuma because it has not only painted decorations, but also designs made of tiny, shaped holes. A vase of this type needs a liner to hold water if it is used for flowers. Reticulated china is very complicated and difficult to make. Large pieces often collapse in the kiln.

Cottone Auctions had a spring sale that featured a 19-inch vase with an 11-inch diameter that was totally covered with a painting of iris leaves and flowers, and a partial design of a woman in a garden painted over a black background. The vase came with the original insert and was signed by the artist. The successful auction bid of \$14,160 was over the high estimate of \$10,000. Look for the Shimazu crest mark on old Satsuma. It is a circle with a cross inside.

Q: I have a "long case" clock with "Edm Smith, Edm St Bury" on the face. I think it means it was made by Edmund Smith in Bury St Edmunds, but I can find very little information about it. Can you tell me more about it? I'm also trying to establish a value.

A: Long case clocks were first made in England about 1660. They are usually at least 6 feet tall and have a long case that encloses the weights and pendulum. They are also called "tall case clocks" or "grandfather clocks." The term "grandfather clock" became popular because of the

song "My Grandfather's Clock," which was written in 1876. Edmund Smith was a watch and clockmaker in Bury, St. Edmunds, from 1753 to 1779. Your long case clock, in good working condition, might sell at auction for about \$1,500 to \$2,000. It should have a chime for the hour or more often.

Alkaline Diet May Help Boost Cancer Treatment

DEAR DR. ROACH: What is your opinion of the alkaline diet? I have several friends who have battled cancer, and they have adopted alkaline diets as adjuncts to their cancer treatments. Do alkaline diets assist in the treatment and prevention of cancers, or is it just another urban myth? -- T.F.C.

ANSWER: A diet high in fruits and vegetables may have a beneficial effect on cancer treatment, in combination with the best cancer treatments available, whether they are surgical, chemotherapeutic or radiation-based. Some of the "alkaline diets" I have read about do emphasize fruits and vegetables, and they may help and certainly will not hurt. However, there is no diet that is a substitute for comprehensive cancer care.

The body has powerful mechanisms for maintaining an exact pH, regardless of the acidity (or alkalinity) of the food you eat. Both the lungs and the kidneys work together to maintain the body's pH at a slightly alkaline 7.4. Only with severe illness will the body's pH come out of its narrow range of normal, and when it does, that portends a poor outcome without immediate treatment.

The mechanism by which fruits and vegetables have been shown to benefit some cancers is not precisely known, but it probably has to do with healthful components of the food, not through any effect on body alkalinity.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 67-year-old male in excellent physical health. The only issue I have is occasional bouts of vertigo. These episodes started when I was about 44 years old. My symptoms are varying degrees of dizziness and, with extreme episodes, nausea. The frequency has increased the past couple of years to about every two weeks.

I do the Epley maneuver to relieve the symptoms, which go away one or two days after doing so. Epley is the only treatment available that works for me. Is there any new research or treatments for this? I am also curious about what foods might be contributing to the onset of vertigo. -- R.W.

ANSWER: Vertigo is a sensation of movement when there isn't any. Most often, people will describe a spinning sensation. Others say the world is spinning, but swaying or tilting are other descriptors. Although dizziness is a very nonspecific term, vertigo has a fairly limited number of diagnostic possibilities. Further, the fact that you get better with the Epley maneuver (more on that below) tells me the diagnosis is very likely to be benign paroxysmal peripheral vertigo.

Each ear contains an organ of balance, also called the semicircular canals, which work by the movement of hair cells inside those fluid-filled bony structures. Sometimes small crystals (called otoconia) form in one semicircular canal. These press on the hair cells and cause the two organs of balance to send conflicting signals to the brain about movement, which is perceived as vertigo. Diet is not likely to have a significant effect on causing or treating BPPV.

The Epley maneuver, like other repositioning maneuvers, is designed to move the crystals out of the semicircular canals. Recurrence of vertigo after a successful Epley maneuver is not uncommon, but recurrences as often as every two weeks for over 20 years is outside my experience. I have read about surgical options for refractory BPPV, but I have had success referring patients to vestibular rehabilitation, performed by trained occupational or physical therapists.

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Little Know Social Security Program Helps Seniors Manage Their Money

Dear Savvy Senior,

Does Social Security offer any special help to beneficiaries who struggle managing their benefits? My aunt, who has no children, has dementia and struggles keeping up with her bills and other financial duties.

Inquiring Niece

Dear Inquiring,

Yes, Social Security actually has a little-known program known as the "representative payee program" that helps beneficiaries who need help managing their Social Security benefit payments. Here's what you should know.

Representative Payee Program

Authorized by congress back in 1939, the Social Security representative payee program provides money management help to beneficiaries who are incapable of managing their Social Security income. Beneficiaries in need of this help are often seniors suffering from dementia, or minor children who are collecting Social Security survivors' benefits.

Currently more than 5 million Social Security beneficiaries have representative payees.

Representative payees also handle benefits for nearly 3 million recipients of Supplemental Security Income (SSI), a Social Security administered benefit program for low-income people who are over 65, blind or disabled.

Who Are Payees?

A representative payee is typically a relative or close friend of the beneficiary needing assistance, but Social Security can also name an organization or institution for the role – like a nursing homes or social-service agency.

Some of duties of a representative payee include:

Using the beneficiary's Social Security or SSI payments to meet their essential needs, such as food, shelter, household bills and medical care. The money can also be used for personal needs like clothing and recreation.

Keeping any remaining money from benefit payments in an interest-bearing

bank account or savings bonds for the beneficiary's future needs.

Keeping records of benefit payments received and how the money was spent or saved.

Reporting to Social Security any changes or events that could affect the beneficiary's payments (for example, a move, marriage, divorce or death).

Reporting any circumstances that affect the payee's ability to serve in the role.

As a representative payee, you cannot combine the beneficiary's Social Security payments with your own money or use them for your own needs. The bank account into which benefits are deposited should be fully owned by the beneficiary, with the payee listed as financial agent.

Some payees, generally those who do not live with the beneficiary, are required to submit annual reports to Social Security accounting for how benefits are used. For more information on the responsibilities and restrictions that come with the role, see the Social Security publication "A Guide for Representative Payees" at SSA.gov/pubs/EN-05-10076.pdf.

How to Get Help

If you believe your aunt may need a representative payee, call Social Security at 800-772-1213 and make an appointment to discuss the matter at her local office. Applying to serve as a payee usually requires a face-to-face interview.

Social Security may consider other evidence in deciding if a beneficiary needs a payee and selecting the person to fill the role, including doctors' assessments and statements from relatives, friends and others in a position to give an informed opinion about the beneficiary's situation.

You should also know that if you become your aunt's representative payee you cannot collect a fee for doing it. However, some organizations that serve in the role do receive fees, paid out of the beneficiary's Social Security or SSI payments.

Biggest Raise in Decades for Social Security?

Don't count your money before it's in hand, of course. But word is that the Social Security increase we see in January could be as much as 6.1%, the largest since 1983.

For the average benefit recipient, currently receiving \$1,543, that could amount to \$94 per month. It's a few years too late for a serious increase, but certainly better than the 1.3% bump we saw for 2021 and the 1.6% the year before. Social Security is calculated by the cost-of-living adjustment in the third quarter each year. For 2021, they calculated that a 1.3% increase should be plenty. We know that was wrong, as prices of everything had climbed. It's all in how and what they calculate. They use the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W), which measures prices on certain goods and services. But we're not wage earners, and we don't work in offices. We spend our money on different things. We wonder why they don't use the index for the elderly (CPI-E), which takes into consideration the things we do buy, such as medical care, medical services, housing and health insurance. (There's a bill in the House of Representatives -- H.R.4315 -- to do that very thing.) We spend less than the CPI-W group on transportation, food, clothing, entertainment, education and communication.

The Federal Reserve Bank did a midsummer survey on what consumers are expecting for the rest of 2021. The expectation of responders is that we'll see a 4.8% increase on top of what we've already seen this year.

Keep an eye on the news in October, when the rate of next year's Social Security increase is finalized.

Meanwhile start planning for next year as soon as you can. Look for savings everywhere you can find them.

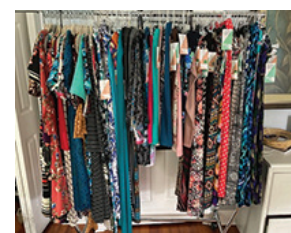

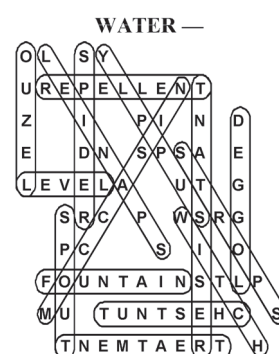
