

SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

We continue with our study of "The Signers of our United States Constitution". These were truly great patriots!

Nathaniel Gorham was born on Tuesday, May 27, 1738, in Charleston Neighborhood, Boston, Suffolk County, Massachusetts, British Colony. He represented Massachusetts at the Second Continental Congress on its Committee of Detail and for six months served as its Presiding Officer. He died on Saturday, June 11, 1796, in Charleston Neighborhood, Boston, Suffolk County, Massachusetts.

Alexander Hamilton was born on Saturday, January 11, 1755, at Charlestown, Island of Nevis, in the Federation of Saint Kitts and Nevis, Leeward Islands, West Indies. He represented New York at the Second Continental Congress, founded the Federalist Party, the United States Coast Guard, and the New York Post newspaper. He was also the first Secretary of the Treasury. He died on Thursday, July 12, 1804, at Greenwich Village, New York City, New York.

Jared Ingersoll was born on Friday, October 24, 1749, at New Haven, New Haven County, Connecticut, British Colony. He represented Pennsylvania at the Second Continental Congress and was the U. S. Attorney for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania from 1815 until he died on Thursday, October 31, 1822, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

Daniel of St. Thomas Jenifer was born in 1723 at "Coates Retirement" (now Ellersite), an estate west of Port Tobacco, Charles County, Maryland, British Colony. He represented Maryland at the Second Constitutional Convention and served in the Maryland State Senate from 1777 to 1780. He died on Tuesday, November 16, 1790, at Annapolis, Maryland.

William Samuel Johnson was born on Tuesday, October 7, 1727, at Stratford, Fairfield County, Connecticut, British Colony. He represented Connecticut at the Second Continental Congress, served as a U. S. Senator for Connecticut from Wednesday, March 4, 1789, to Friday, March 4, 1791, and served as the third president of King's College, now known as Columbia University. He died on Sunday, November 14, 1819, at Stratford, Connecticut.

Rufus King was born on Monday, March 24, 1755, at Scarborough, Cumberland County, Massachusetts, British Colony (which is now in the state of Maine). He represented Massachusetts at the Second Continental Congress, served New York as a U. S. Senator and ran for the Presidency under the Federalist Party ticket in 1816. He died on Sunday, April 29, 1827, in Jamaica, Queens County, New York.

John Langdon was born on Monday, June 26, 1741, at Portsmouth, New Hampshire, British Colony. He represented New Hampshire at the Second Continental Congress, served as a U. S. Senator from New Hampshire and the Governor of New Hampshire. He died on Saturday, September 18, 1819, at Portsmouth, Rockingham County, New Hampshire.

William Livingston was born on Tuesday, November 30, 1723, in Albany, Albany County, New York, British Colony. He served in the New York General Assembly from 1759 to 1761, represented New Jersey at the Second Continental Congress, and was the first Governor of New Jersey from Saturday, August 31, 1776, until he died on Sunday, July 25, 1790, at Elizabeth, Union County, New Jersey.

Lord willing, we will continue our study next week.

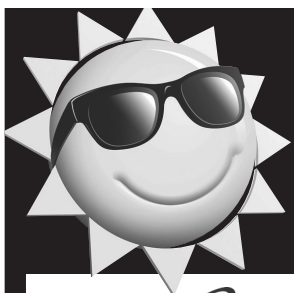

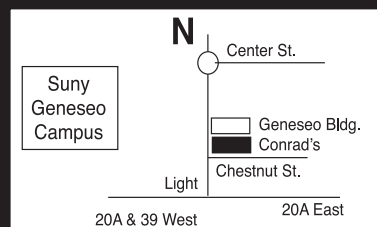



Please be aware that school reopens on Tuesday
September 7, 2021. Please keep your eyes open for
children crossing the street. Remember, when a stopped
school bus flashes its red light(s), traffic that approaches
from either direction, even in front of the school and in
school parking lots, must stop before it reaches the bus.
You should stop at least 20 feet away from the bus. Before
a school bus stops to load or discharge passengers, the
driver will usually flash yellow warning lights. When you
see them, decrease speed and be prepared to stop.
When you stop for a school bus, you cannot drive again
until the red lights stop flashing or when the bus driver
or a traffic officer signals that you can proceed. This law
applies on all roadways in New York State. You must
stop for a school bus even if it is on the opposite side
of a divided highway. After you stop for a school bus,
look for children along the side of the road. Drive slowly
until you have passed them. Remember that vehicles
that transport people with disabilities can be equipped as
school buses and you must stop for them as you would
for other school buses.

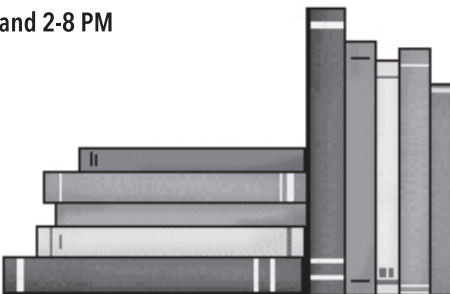

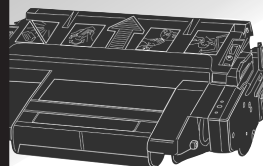

- The remembrance of those innocent victims who died Sept. 11, as heroes, one and all;

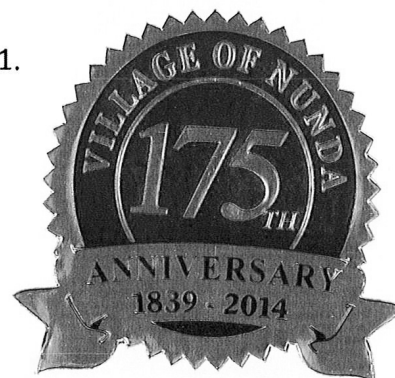

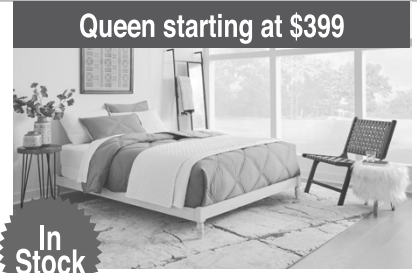

Do You Have A Disaster Plan?

September is National Preparedness Month. The theme this year is “Prepare to Protect. Preparing for disasters is protecting everyone you love.” Amidst the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, it is vital that individuals and families understand their personal roles in preparing for disasters and emergencies by taking action now. As part of National Preparedness Month, the Livingston County Department of Health and the Livingston County Office of Emergency Management will share weekly information throughout September. This week’s theme is “Make a Plan to Prepare for before, during, and after a disaster”.

Before you make a plan, talk to your friends and family about how you will communicate before, during, and after a disaster. It is also important to be sure to include recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control (www.cdc.gov) due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Below are simple steps to follow when creating a plan:

Step 1: Put a plan together by talking about the following with your family, friends or household to start your emergency plan:

- What is my shelter plan?
- What is my evacuation route?
- What is my family/household communication plan?

Step 2: Consider specific needs in your household: animals, special needs, ages, etc.

Step 3: Fill out a Family Emergency Plan- visit <https://www.ready.gov/plan>

Step 4: Practice your plan with your family/household

In addition to the above steps, the New York Citizen Preparedness Training is an online option which provides residents with the tools and resources available to prepare for any type of disaster, respond accordingly, and recover as quickly as possible to pre-disaster conditions. This free training course will provide an introduction to responding to a natural or man-made disaster. Participants will understand how to properly prepare for any disaster and includes developing a family emergency plan and stocking up on emergency supplies. 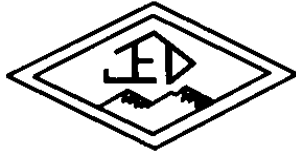

COVID-19 Update from Livingston County

The Livingston County Department of Health reports that the County's current COVID-19 vaccination rate is 61.3%. In addition, there is a COVID-19 case volume of 96, weekly positivity rate over 5.7%, ICU bed capacity of 85%, and no hospitalizations related to the virus.

For residents who would like to receive a COVID-19 vaccine, appointments can be made through New York State at <https://covid19vaccine.health.ny.gov/>.

“Even as many of the County's current positive cases are among the vaccinated population, the facts are clear that – on a national level – the vast majority of cases leading to hospitalization and, sadly, deaths are among those who are not vaccinated,” stated Jennifer Rodriguez, Livingston County's Public Health Director.

County Administrator Ian M. Coyle would like to commend Livingston County staff and residents for their resiliency and pragmatism during the latest COVID-19 wave.

“Our staff continues to serve the public with the highest regard for both safety and service, and our residents, customers, taxpayers and clients have been respectful and receptive to our continuation of operations during the pandemic. We are thankful for that,” stated Coyle.

“In Livingston County, we have a strong tradition of both robust public health efforts and an emphasis on personal responsibility. Despite what you might hear in other places – we believe those two traditions are mutually compatible,” continued Coyle. “You have a role to play in the community. Be safe, smart and health-conscious. Know that vaccinations work. We have said all along that COVID-19 appears to be staying, and the virus will morph and have variants. The case volume, too, will have ebbs and flows.”

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Livingston County is at a high level of community transmission.

Coyle said, “Please understand what the classification of high means to Livingston County and the actual statistics. High for our county means 96 confirmed cases out of a population of over 61,000 residents. That, of course, means scores if not more of unconfirmed cases because of the often asymptomatic nature of the virus response in certain individuals. That being said, of our 96 confirmed positives, many are fully vaccinated individuals. Our vaccination rate is over 60% and rising daily, albeit very slowly at this point. While we still encourage the usual and customary vigilance and protective efforts in a pandemic, the sky isn't falling. COVID-19 is here to stay, and you will likely get exposed to the virus. We will get through a variant wave like we got through other, previous waves of this pandemic.”

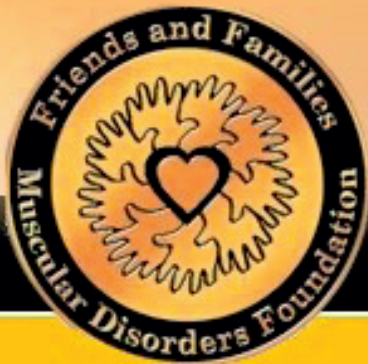
“From a county government operations perspective, our situation remains status quo. Our building access and mask policies currently in existence will continue as is for the present time,” continued Coyle.
