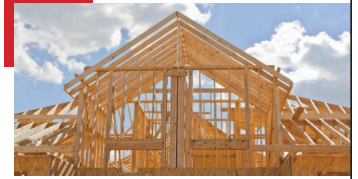

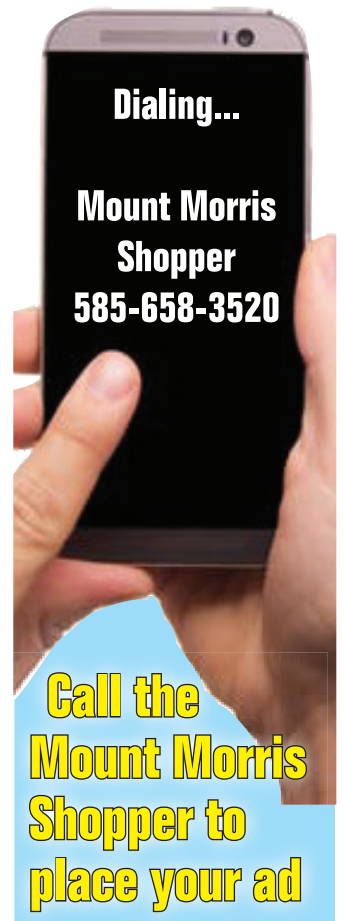

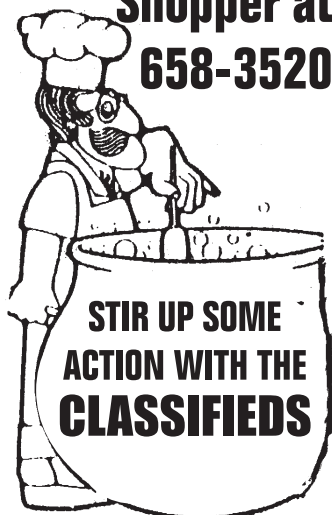

# SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

We continue with our study of "The Signers of Our United States Constitution". They were truly American statesmen.

**James Madison, Jr.**, was born on Tuesday, March 16, 1751, in Port Conway, King George County, Virginia. He represented Virginia at the Second Continental Congress and served as the fourth President of the United States from 1809 to 1817. He is hailed as the "Father of the Constitution". He died on Tuesday, June 28, 1836, at Montpelier, Orange County, Virginia. I am proud to be a direct descendant of him.

**James McHenry** was born on Friday, November 16, 1753, at Ballymena, County Antrim, Northern Ireland. He represented Maryland at the Second Continental Congress and served as U. S. Secretary of War from 1796 to 1800. Fort McHenry was named after him. He died on Friday, May 3, 1816, in the City of Baltimore, Maryland.

**Thomas Mifflin** was born on Friday, January 10, 1744, in Philadelphia, Province of Philadelphia, British Colony. He represented Pennsylvania at the Second Continental Congress and served as the first Governor of Pennsylvania from 1790 to 1799. He died on Monday, January 20, 1800, in the City of Lancaster, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania.

**Gouverneur Morris** was born on Monday, January 31, 1752, in the Morrisania neighborhood, (modern day Bronx), Province of New York, British Colony. He signed the Articles of Confederation, wrote the Preamble to the Constitution and represented Pennsylvania at the Second Continental Congress. He died on Wednesday, November 6, 1816, in the Morrisania neighborhood (same room where he was born), (modern day Bronx), New York City, New York State.

**Robert Morris** was born on Wednesday, January 20, 1734, in Liverpool, England. He represented Pennsylvania at the Second Continental Congress, served as a U. S. Senator from Pennsylvania from 1789 to 1795, is called the "Financier of the American Revolution" and significant to us... Mount Morris was named after him. He died on Thursday, May 8, 1806, at Forked River, Ocean County, New Jersey.

**William Paterson** was born on Friday, December 24, 1745, in County Antrim, Ireland. He represented New Jersey at the Second Continental Congress, served as the second Governor of New Jersey from 1790 to 1793 and served as an Associate Justice of the United States Supreme Court from 1793 until his death on Tuesday, September 9, 1806, in the City of Albany, Albany County, New York.

**Charles Pinckney** was born on Wednesday, October 26, 1757, at Charles Town, Charleston County, South Carolina. He represented South Carolina at the Second Continental Congress, served as a United States Senator and Member of the House of Representatives. He was the first cousin once removed of fellow signer Charles Cotesworth Pinckney. He died on Friday, October 29, 1824, in the City of Charleston, Charleston County, South Carolina.

**Charles Cotesworth Pinckney** was born on Friday, February 25, 1746, at Charles Town, Charleston County, South Carolina. He represented South Carolina at the Second Continental Congress. He died on Tuesday, August 16, 1825, in the City of Charleston, Charleston County, South Carolina.

Lord willing, we will continue our study next week. I pray you are enjoying our walk back into our country's history.
