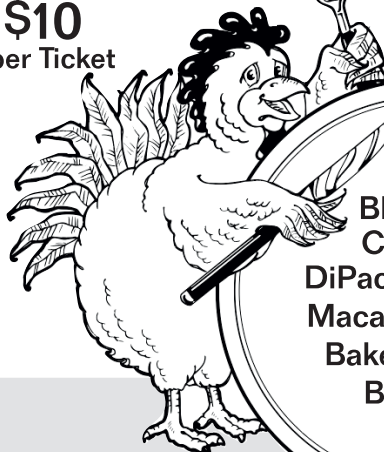

SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

We continue with our study of "The Signers of Our United States Constitution". Knowing our history will preserve it.

George Read was born on Friday, September 18, 1733, in Cecil County, Maryland. He signed the Declaration of Independence, the Petition to the King in 1777, represented Delaware at the Second Continental Congress and served as a United States Senator in the first United States Senate. He died on Friday, September 21, 1798, in the City of New Castle, New Castle County, Delaware.

John Rutledge was born on Thursday, September 17, 1739, near Charles Town, Charleston County, South Carolina. He represented South Carolina at the Second Continental Congress, served as South Carolina's first governor, later as one of the first Associate Justices of the Supreme Court and later as its Chief Justice. He died on Saturday, June 21, 1800, in the City of Charleston, Charleston County, South Carolina.

Roger Sherman was born on Saturday, April 19, 1721, in Newton, Middlesex County, Massachusetts. He represented Connecticut at the Second Continental Congress and was the only person to sign the Continental Association, the Declaration of Independence, the Articles of Confederation and the Constitution of the United States. He served as a United States Senator from Connecticut from 1791 until he died on Tuesday, July 23, 1793, in the City of New Haven, New Haven County, Connecticut.

Richard Dobbs Spaight, Sr., was born on Saturday, March 25, 1758, in New Bern, Craven County, North Carolina. He served as Governor of North Carolina from 1792 to 1795, represented North Carolina at the Second Continental Congress and served in the United States House of Representatives for the 10th District of North Carolina from 1798 to 1801. He died on Monday, September 6, 1802, in the City of New Bern, Craven County, North Carolina.

George Washington was born on Friday, February 22, 1732, on Popes Creek Plantation in Westmoreland County, Virginia. He is called the "Father of His Country" and was the first President of the United States from 1789 to 1797. He died on Saturday, December 14, 1799, at his home at Mount Vernon in Fairfax County, Virginia, and was buried in the old Washington family vault at his home at Mount Vernon.

Hugh Williamson was born on Monday, December 5, 1735, at West Nottingham Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania. He represented North Carolina at the Second Continental Congress and served North Carolina's 4th District in the United States House of Representatives from 1791 until 1793. He died on Saturday, May 22, 1819, in New York City, New York.

James Wilson was born on Friday, September 14, 1742, at Carskerdo Farm, Fife, Scotland, Great Britain. He represented Pennsylvania at the Second Continental Congress and served as an Associate Justice of the United States Supreme Court from 1789 until 1798. He died on Tuesday, August 21, 1798, in the Town of Edenton, Chowan County, North Carolina.

We conclude our study of "The Signers of Our United States Constitution". In all, 55 delegates attended the Second Continental Congress but only 39 signed our United States Constitution. I pray you have enjoyed and learned from our study.

Lord willing, we will summarize our study next week.

Is Your Home Safe from Radon?

According to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Livingston County is one of many counties in New York State considered to have a high potential for high radon levels. Radon is a cancer-causing radioactive gas that you cannot see, smell, or taste. It can be present in your home without you knowing and has been identified by the Surgeon General as the second leading cause of lung cancer in the United States. The EPA reports that radon is responsible for approximately 20,000 deaths annually.

Radon is produced naturally by the decay of radioactive material in soil, rock and in groundwater. It moves upward in the soil and can enter your home through cracks and other holes in your home's foundation or with groundwater from a well. Houses located (i) on highly permeable, gravel concentrated soils or (ii) on or around limestone rock formations may be at higher risk for elevated indoor radon levels.

The only way to determine if radon is a concern in your home is to test for it using a radon detection kit. The Livingston County Department of Health reminds residents that these kits are available free of charge to Livingston County residents who are homeowners. 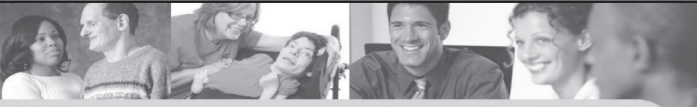
