





Laborshed Study To Be Conducted in lowa Lakes Corridor Region

The Iowa Lakes Corridor Development Corporation (Corridor) is partnering with Iowa Workforce Development and Iowa Economic Development Authority to complete a Laborshed employment study for the Estherville, Spencer, Spirit Lake and Storm Lake areas. This study will geographically define which communities contribute to each city's workforce, regardless of political boundaries. This defined area is called a Laborshed area and is based upon commuting

The purpose of this Laborshed study is to measure the availability and characteristics of a community's area workers. Laborshed studies are useful tools for economic development teams and existing or prospective employers to understand the local labor market, make informed expansion and site selection decisions, and maintain/recruit a high-quality workforce.

The Laborshed boundary is based on the place of residence of individuals commuting into the community for employment. For the success of this study, the Corridor will send letters to employers in Estherville, Spencer, Spirit Lake and Storm Lake asking that they provide us with aggregate counts of their employees' residential ZIP codes. This reporting will give us an understanding of where each community's workforce resides.

Every year Iowa Workforce Development conducts Laborshed studies across the State. The results of each analysis are publicly available online at www.iowalmi.gov/laborshed. A QUICK RETROSPECTIVE

The Fair was fun for all! While we enjoy good tasty food -- and plenty of it -- The Old Professor is

a lousy farmer. And he'd be a lousy beef, pork, chicken, or lamb producer, too. ('Didn't even get a vegetable garden planted this summer, and will have only a few volunteer Yellow Squash to harvest soon -- from the front yard, where Ms. Rambo has suspicions that our little furry friends with the bushy tails buried seeds they found elsewhere! We'll let you know...

What we know now -- even as a city kid -- and with the attendance figures still outstanding -- is that the 2021 Clay County Fair, with its many attractions, was fun for all. For us, of course, the entertainers were highest on our list of options -- and top notch, too! It

took us until Wednesday to understand why the guys and gals on stage were all so good. Some were singers or musicians, Others were comedians. And we even stopped to see a juggler -- after almost missing the pig and llama show near the Farmers Bank Stage.

(It wasn't our first choice; but after driving down from her home in Redwood Falls, Minnesota, research director RD insisted on it.) And the live animal show was a hoot -- even for this city kid.

With all the fine performances, it is too still too difficult for us to select the best show. It was easy, though, after seeing many of the free shows (including Hillbilly Bob (with Old Ruthie), comic C. Willi Myles, Gary Lewis and The Playboys, and Herman's Hermits, starring Peter Noone (who even sang a ditty about being in Spencer, Iowa at the Clay County Fair!) to understand what made each act so good. While they were all terrific performers, they got their applause by instantly developing a rapport with the audiences!

The simplest example of that came when we entered the Farmers Bank tent to see Steve Russell, who was billed as a comic juggler. The show was fun, of

course; but what we watched most was a group we learned only after the show was one of six 4th-grade groups from Spencer's Lincoln Elementary School -- Ross Johnson's class. The kids were enthralled with the action and silliness. Then, when Russell asked for a volunteer assistant, two young girls popped up without hesitation and jumped on to the stage. Since Breezelynn Hamrick was first, she became Russell's assistant, constantly picking up the things he "dropped." As soon

as Breezelynn would pick up one piece, she had another opportunity to do it, again and again, much to the delight of the crowd -- including her classmates!

It takes a lot more than just a song and dance to get the attention and adoration of an audience. It requires showmanship. It's what Marilyn Maye has been doing since she was old enough to perform on the radio in Des Moines more than 80 years ago! It's what she is still preaching, teaching and demonstrating on stage, today, to a generation of students who, for the most part, don't understand face-to-face communication without a cellphone or keyboard to buffer the conversation. By the way, Ross Johnson told us he is "very proud to represent this group of fourth graders." He has every right to be proud of his students. They were very well behaved, while having a great time at the Fair. Russell was very willingly sharing his stage with the students, including those who politely remained in their seats to applaud...

For the record, each time we passed the Northwest Bank stage to see and hear The Britins (a Beatles tribute band) the place was packed, but had fairgoers three and four deep standing, listening intently, on the three exposed sides of

If you have missed much of the free halls and entertainment over the years, be sure to check out places like Grandpa's Barn, and the Sundholm cabin and gardens, too, in the years ahead -- or even right after all the big equipment is off the grounds. It's a nice walk -- 'til it snows!

With The Fair folding its tents, and the summer season almost history on campus, there will be somewhat less live entertainment in the weeks ahead. Note that the first day of Autumn is Wednesday...

Boji Bill and his better half (Jackie) will be entertaining Sunday afternoon at 2-5:00 at the Senior Center in Spirit Lake. Bill asked us to note that "All ages are welcome..."

Little Swan Lake Winery has a lot planned over the next few weeks, starting Thursday, when Sounds Fishy will take the stage in the barn from 6-8:00. Saturday will see the return of The Ridottos, also from 6-8:00... And Charlie Leissler with Abby Soul, along with Four Way Suite will perform from 4-6:00 on Sunday, in tribute to The Beatles, and Crosby, Stills and Nash. It's really two shows in one -- for which there will be one small cover charge...

Jeremy DeWall will be performing on Thursday, the 30th, from 6-8:00. Terry Brooks will open October's entertainment on Saturday, the 2nd, from 6-8:00, with Jacob and Adam filling the stage in the barn on Sunday, October 3rd, from 4-6:00...

It appears that research director RD's efforts will actually see ink this week -- noting songs that have hit Number One on the charts during the week of September 21st. Included in the group would be Sleep Walk, by Santo and Johnny (1959), My Heart Has a Mind of its Own, by Connie Francis (1960), Blue Velvet, by Bobby Vinton (1963), and Cherish, by The Association (1966). Each song remained at the top of the charts for two weeks -- except the last, Cherish, which was Number One for three weeks!

Wednesday is Doodle Day, for which there can be only one song, A Doodlin' Song, written by Carolyn Leigh and Cy Coleman, and first recorded by Jackie Cooper in 1958. Other versions soon followed, including those by Blossom Dearie (1959), Peggy Lee (1963), and on The Dick Van Dyke Show by Rob and Laura Petrie, in the October 30,1963 episode, Too Many Stars...

Singer Ray Charles was born in Albany, Georgia, on September 23, 1930. Also a songwriter, pianist, and composer, Charles was catapulted to fame with Georgia On My Mind, written by Hoagy Carmichael and Stuart Gorell in 1930, when he recorded it in 1960, for his The Genius Hits the Road LP, on the ABC Paramount label. The song rose to Number One, and was designated the Official State Song of Georgia 19 years later, in 1979...

Additionally, I feel as though publishing such blatant misinformation is disrespectful to our local public health officials and healthcare providers who have worked tirelessly over the past 19+ months to keep us educated and safe throughout this pandemic. Just as individuals have the First Amendment right to express their opinions, newspapers have a First Amendment right not to publish every letter to the editor. I urge The Lakes News Shopper to exercise this important freedom.





member Sherry Fuhrman first brought the efforts of the museum to the attention of the chapter. An initial \$200 contribution was made by the group to support the special signage of buildings in downtown Spirit Lake for The Stroll Back in Time. Then Curator Mary Dreier was asked by the chapter's Expenditure Chairman Sharon Wellendorf to prioritize the needs of the museum as it seeks to better serve the county residents. Communicating with the community regarding the museum's many activities was a high priority concern as Dreier was having to use her home printer to prepare posters and news releases.

Since its organization in 2010 by co-founders Sue Fontaine and Daphne Davis, the local Questers chapter has financially supported numerous projects in keeping with the International Questers goals of Preservation, Restoration, and Education. The revitalization of Arnolds Park Amusement Park has been a foremost endeavor including the sponsoring and organization of the fundraiser 125th Anniversary High Tea in 2015, the purchasing and placing of a bench in the Park, and the acquisition and framing of historical posters advertising musical events at the "old" Roof Garden. This last project was partially funded by grants from the Iowa Questers and from International Questers.

A previous International grant had allowed the Okoboji Queen Chapter to contribute to the Sheldon, Iowa community's effort to move and restore the Baker one-room school. Locally members had supported the Dickinson County Sesquicentennial School by volunteering as guides. Modern education efforts were also targeted when the chapter hosted the Graettinger-Terril students' placing their well-researched marker at the Abbie Gardner Cabin site.

Over the past ten years these various community efforts have been led by presidents Sue Fontaine, Tami Horsman, Donna De-Wall, Donna Mau, and the current president, Maryanna Hubbard. The vitality of the local chapter is mirrored by the progress of former Lakes Area resident and co-founder Daphne Davis within the International organization. Davis has organized a chapter in her Arizona retirement community, served as Arizona Quester State President, and is now a candidate for International Q First Vice President.

Okoboji Queen members are enthusiastically proud of their organization's efforts to meet International goals at the local level and would appreciate any suggestions for appropriate projects needing their support.

City of Spirit Lake Clean Up Days



September 27th thru September 30th Within the City of Spirit Lake, residential customers may dispose of items not normally picked up by the sanitation department.

Fall Cleanup days will coincide with resident's normal day of garbage pickup

This Cleanup will not include construction, debris, paint, toxic or flammable chemicals, nor material from construction or commercial establishments.

TAGS will be required for all white goods, electronics items, car & truck tires (no rims), mattresses and box springs, daybeds & futons with mattresses.

ALL TAGS MUST BE PURCHASED AT CITY HALL.

ITEMS THAT REQUIRE A TAG WILL NOT BE PICKED UP UNLESS THEY ARE TAGGED.

A tag will not be required on couches and chairs on cleanup days only. Carpet and pad will be picked up as long as rolls are cut to 4 ft. lengths and tied with string, wire or duct tape. Lumber will also be picked up as long as all nails are pulled or bent over and the lumber is cut and bound tightly with wire or string with bundles no longer than 4 ft. in length and 12 inches in diameter.

1/2 teaspoon seasoned salt 1 pound boneless skinless chicken breasts, cut into 2" wide chunks


Bette Jo Miller, 95, of Spirit Lake, passed away on Wednesday, September 15, 2021, at Accura Healthcare of Spirit Lake.
