





Piedmont Pets

The first time I saw newborn guinea pigs, I was amazed. They are born with eyes open, all of their hair, and a full set of teeth. In fact, within hours of being born, they can eat solid food.

Guinea pigs readily interact and bond with humans. They may be the ideal companion for someone who lives in an apartment, but still wants to have a companion. Be aware, though, they still require attention and play time outside of the cage.

Guinea pigs originally came from South America and are considered a source of protein. I tried not to be too appalled when I learned that a friend of mine who had served a mission to Argentina had actually eaten them.

Although parents must realize that they will be the ones ultimately responsible for the care of any companion animal in the home, guinea pigs may be a good choice of a first pet for older children. They have very specific needs that should be carefully monitored.

Guinea pigs can live to be about eight years old in a home where their dietary needs are fulfilled. They must have constant access to a high-quality guinea pig food, Timothy hay, and some fruits and vegetables (especially those high in vitamin C). Any fresh food not eaten within 24 hours should be discarded.

Guinea pigs need to have fresh, clean, chlorine-free water every day in a bottle that is kept clean and sanitary.

The biggest concern we have is the size of a cage. If your guinea pig spends most of the time in a cage, then it needs to be a large one. If a store employee suggests the minimum size, increase that! There must be a solid floor and paper bedding should be used. Cedar shavings are a huge no-no. The cage will quickly

smell if not kept clean every day; solid waste should be removed every day and wet spots should also be removed daily.

Guinea pigs love time outside their cage; however, they should never be taken outside and left there. In fact, a hawk would not be bothered by a human standing nearby and can snatch guinea pigs before the owner has time to react. In addition, guinea pigs can also get infested with fleas and other small creatures. There are plenty of ways to let guinea pigs get exercise inside.

If you believe a guinea pig may be a good first pet for your older child, there is a lot of information on-line. And don't forget - animal shelters also have guinea pigs for adoption. We currently have several for adoption. There is no need to buy one; a homeless guinea pig may be waiting for you at the shelter!

Wooden Tea Caddy

It seems strange today that early wooden tea caddies (special boxes for tea) were made with a lock and key. Tea was a very expensive drink in the 1600s. It gave added energy and after the addition of sugar, milk and sometimes lemon, it had a pleasing taste.

The earliest tea caddies in England were made of porcelain shaped like a bottle with flat sides and a lid. Most were made in Holland. By the 1700s, there were large tea chests (caddies) that were made of mahogany, rosewood and other attractive types of wood. The valuable tea was kept in a box decorated with ivory, brass, ebony or silver to show its importance. Most had two or three sections that held a glass liner for the tea. The tea was served in an important room, so the tea caddy was made to resemble the furniture of the day.

A recent Cottone auction sold an English Tunbridge ware tea caddy with inlay picturing Queen Victoria. The caddy was connected to a pedestal, also decorated with inlay. The impressive tea caddy sold for \$2,950.

Q. I'm a retired letter carrier. **W.** When my son was born in 1975, one of my patrons gave me a gift of Dewar's White Label Scotch Whiskey. I've never opened it. The bottle is encased in cardboard and is in the original tin box. Is there any value because of its age? Is it still good to drink?

White Label Scotch Whiskey was first made in 1899. The company changed hands several times and has been owned by Bacardi since 1998. White Label is Dewar's most popular brand and a top seller in the United States. Old liquor in unopened bottles is safe to drink. Some people think older bottles of scotch and other distilled spirits are better than newer ones. An old bottle of Dewar's White Label Scotch Whiskey in a tin box sold online for more than \$100. Even an old partly full bottle without the box sold for more

than a new bottle. The old tin boxes are collected and sell for near \$100. A new, full bottle is about \$25. An empty bottle is worth under \$10.

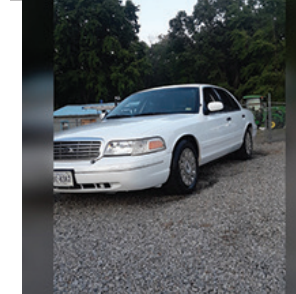

Pittsylvania County, Schools, and RiverStreet Networks Commit to Expanding Internet Coverage

internet is on the way - with wifi signals

With MOU, Pittsylvania County and RiverStreet Commit to Providing Universal Coverage Across the County

Pittsylvania County and RiverStreet Networks are jointly committed to creating an extensive fiber-to-the-home network that reaches almost every home in the county. During Tuesday's Board of Supervisors meeting, Chairman Bob Warren, School Board Chairman Sam Burton, and RiverStreet Networks CEO Eric Cramer signed a memorandum of understanding agreeing to leverage all possible funding opportunities to continue to expand fiber across Pittsylvania County.

As the first phase of this joint project, Pittsylvania County and Pittsylvania County Schools are committing a combined \$16.5 million to a \$75,696,939 fiber-to-the-home project. RiverStreet Networks is also willing to provide a \$19.6 million match. The remaining \$39.5 million is expected to come from a grant from the Virginia Telecommunication Initiative (VATI) through the Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development. Within approximately three years, RiverStreet Networks is planning to pass 11,985 unserved places, as defined by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), with this fiber network. Additional funding opportunities are being sought to expand the number of unserved homes that can be passed with this fiber network.

"This Board of Supervisors understands that reliable and affordable internet access is no longer a luxury; it's a utility that every resident of Pittsylvania County should have available to them," said Bob Warren, Chairman of the Pittsylvania County Board of Supervisors. "We are committed to expanding access to fiber networks to all of our residents and businesses through every resource at our disposal. Through this significant investment and lasting partnership with RiverStreet, we will continue to leverage other funding opportunities to give more of our

community the ability to get online. After realizing several years ago that the Laurel Grove community would never get reliable broadband without significant investments, Dan River Supervisor Joe Davis has been persistent in keeping the issue of broadband access in front of the Board of Supervisors – as well as the community at large."

"We are thrilled to bring fiber based high speed internet to Pittsylvania County. Upgrading and expanding our existing network in Pittsylvania County into more rural communities will be the foundation for better connectivity for the community," said Eric Cramer, President and CEO of RiverStreet Networks. "The current pandemic has given us an immediate, real world, example of how access to technology and connectivity are vital to educational, civic and economic successes. This partnership will align with our goal of providing more unserved and unserved communities with broadband connectivity."

"Pittsylvania County Schools is so glad to be able to partner with RiverStreet Networks and Pittsylvania County to expand internet access across our communities," said Sam Burton, Chairman of the Pittsylvania County School Board. "The need for every student of Pittsylvania County Schools to have reliable and affordable internet access was already apparent before the COVID-19 pandemic hit, and the last year and a half has only crystalized that need even more. We are excited for the progress that this partnership and project will make in connecting so many of our students."

Anybody who wants to learn more about Pittsylvania County's commitment to expanding internet access should visit pittsylvaniacountyva.gov/broadband, and those who want to learn more about RiverStreet Networks' service and express interest in receiving internet access should visit join.buildpittsylvania.com.

This partnership represents a major shift in the way that the Board of

Supervisors is working to tackle a lack of internet access, one of the biggest problems facing Pittsylvania County. As part of a strategic plan adopted in 2019, the Board of Supervisors set a goal of that at least 90% of county residents should have broadband access by 2024. Within that plan, the Board committed to helping facilitate broadband from the private sector, but Pittsylvania County is now significantly increasing its investment, and as a result will participate in a revenue-sharing agreement with RiverStreet Networks. This means that Pittsylvania County will generate revenue from all new customers within the county, and all of those funds will be re-invested into broadband expansion efforts.

RiverStreet Networks is an award-winning communications technology company headquartered in Wilkesboro, NC. For 70 years, RiverStreet Networks has played an active role in providing telecommunication services and connecting communities with broadband service. RiverStreet Networks is focused on delivering the latest and best technology to unserved rural areas. Service is provided in areas of North Carolina and Virginia with excellent telephone, internet, video, security systems and business solutions.

While there are a few other internet providers in Pittsylvania County, none of them have demonstrated a commitment to leveraging available funding opportunities to reach those who are currently unserved. RiverStreet Networks is built on a mission of using creative means to provide internet in rural areas that are simply not cost-effective markets for companies focused on profits. This project specifically targets those that do not have broadband access at this time.

As defined by the FCC, broadband access means download speeds of at least 25 megabits per

second and upload speeds of 3 megabits per second. This is often referred to as speeds of 25/3. While this is the bare minimum speed for broadband, the majority of customers on RiverStreet's network are expected to have speeds that significantly exceed the broadband threshold, with the majority of them even having speeds of 100/100.

The current project will pass 11,985 eligible funded locations, as defined by the FCC. The Memorandum of Understanding between RiverStreet Networks and Pittsylvania County shows the commitment of both organizations to expand broadband access to every Pittsylvania County residence by jointly pursuing other funding opportunities on the state and federal level. Pittsylvania County and RiverStreet Networks share a singular goal: providing universal coverage across Pittsylvania County.

Pittsylvania County and Pittsylvania County Schools are both contributing a significant portion of the funds received from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to this project. Pittsylvania County Schools are contributing \$5.5 million and Pittsylvania County is contributing an additional \$6.5 million. For the remaining \$4.5 million, Pittsylvania County is taking out a revenue bond, the payments for which will be covered by the revenue generated through Pittsylvania County's revenue sharing with RiverStreet Networks.

Pittsylvania County first announced a partnership with RiverStreet Networks in March of this year for a joint fixed wireless project. That was always seen as a stopgap before fiber coverage could be provided, which is why those funds are being rolled over into this fiber network expansion. Now that additional funding opportunities are available, Pittsylvania County and RiverStreet Networks are focused on expanding the fiber network, which will provide the highest speed and reliability for county residents.

Creating Healthier Families One Shot at a Time

As an obstetrician-gynecologist with Sovah Health, my goal is to always provide the best possible care and medical advice for expectant mothers and individuals who plan to become pregnant. I love helping moms-to-be stay healthy and prepare to welcome their baby into the world. As you can imagine, one of the most important conversations I've been having lately with my patients is around COVID-19 vaccines and their safety for those who are pregnant or who are in the planning stage of their pregnancy journey.

First of all, let me say that COVID-19 vaccines continue to be proven safe and effective against serious illness, and being vaccinated is our best defense against this disease. That holds true for pregnant women and individuals who are planning to become pregnant. As a joint statement from a number of leading expert organizations in maternal care and public health just declared, all pregnant individuals, newly pregnant individuals, those planning to become pregnant, those who are breastfeeding and others are strongly encouraged to get vaccinated against COVID-19.

These vaccines have undergone extensive research and testing, and there is no known evidence of adverse effects on fertility (for women or men) or fetal development as a result of becoming vaccinated before or even during pregnancy. Whether you are currently expecting, have recently had a baby or are planning to start or expand your family, I sincerely encourage you to get vaccinated if you have not already done so. I also hope you'll take a moment to review my answers to some of the most frequently asked questions about COVID-19 vaccines and pregnancy and that it will help you attain the peace of mind that comes from being protected against this virus.

Why is it important for pregnant women or those planning to become pregnant to be vaccinated against COVID-19? With the ongoing spread of the virus and the increased risks for severe illness and pregnancy complications that can arise from a COVID-19 infection in pregnant individuals, it is vitally important to get vaccinated to help protect the health and safety of both you and your baby.

If you have any concerns about being vaccinated, I encourage you to discuss them with your provider and make the choice to be a Vaccine Hero. Let's work together to put an end to this pandemic and help create a healthy future for our families.

- 2 tablespoons taco seasoning

Salad:

- 2 pounds boneless, skinless chicken breasts
- 2 tablespoons taco seasoning
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 head leaf lettuce, chopped
- 1 avocado, chopped into bite-sized pieces
- 1 cup black beans, drained and rinsed
- 1 cup corn

- 1 pint grape or cherry tomatoes, chopped

To make dressing: In small bowl, stir yogurt, buttermilk, lime juice, cilantro and taco seasoning until combined. Taste and adjust lime juice and cilantro as needed. SOUTHERN FRIED CABBAGE AND BACON



Seasoned cabbage fried in butter and tossed with extra crispy bacon, caramelized onions, garlic and spices! So easy and delicious! Perfect as a main meal or side dish!

Ingredients

- 1 head of cabbage (about 3 lb cabbage) cut, cored & sliced into strips
- 16 oz bacon diced into small pieces
- 1 small yellow onion diced
- 1 tablespoon granulated sugar
- 1 tablespoon garlic minced
- 2-3 tablespoons unsalted butter
- 1/4 teaspoon red pepper flakes
- sea salt, cracked black pepper, onion powder, & garlic powder to season

Instructions

Heat a very large stainless steel or cast iron deep skillet, and add bacon. (You may need to add a little olive oil if using a turkey bacon)

Cook bacon pieces until extra crispy and remove from pan with a slotted spoon. Leave about a tablespoon of bacon grease in the pan along with any burnt pieces stuck to the bottom of the pan (this has lots of flavor)

Add onions to pan and toss onions with sugar.

Cook until onions are tender and caramelized.

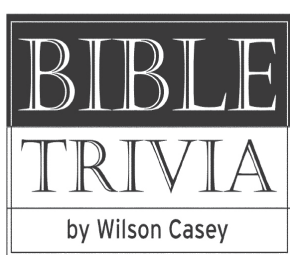
Add garlic and cook until garlic is fragrant. Add butter and stir until butter is melted. Stir in red pepper flakes.

Add cabbage to pot and toss so that cabbage is coated in the butter mixture. Let cabbage fry until tender, stirring frequently.

Season cabbage generously with sea salt/seasoning salt, cracked black pepper, onion powder and garlic powder.

When ready to serve stir in bacon (or add it to individual bowls if you want it to remain extra crispy)

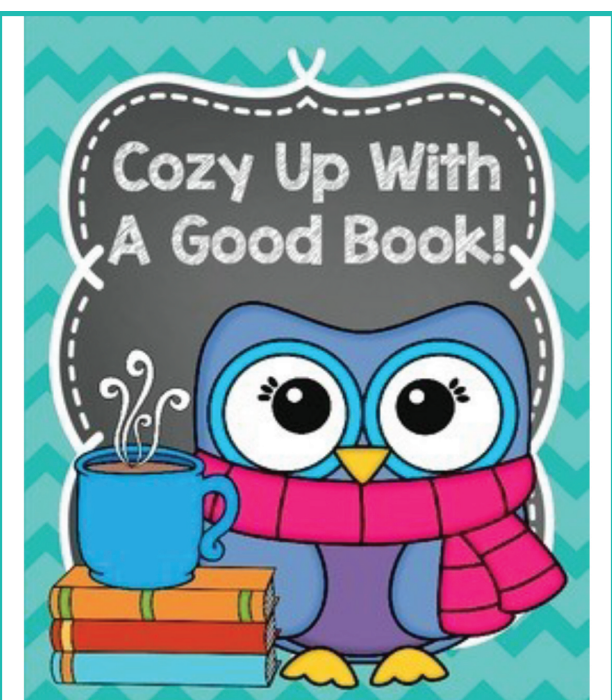
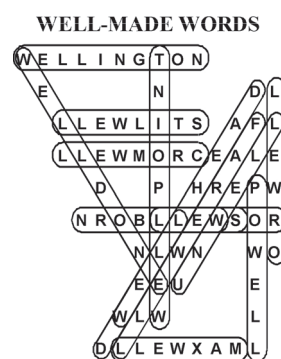

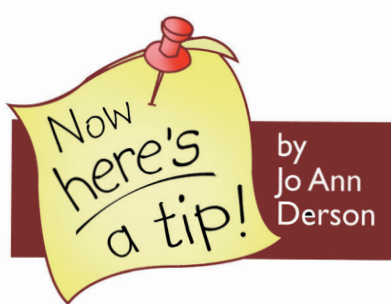

* Have your carpets cleaned. High-traffic areas may require cleaning as often as every three or four months, but bedrooms can go as long as 18 months. Use runners and area rugs to safeguard spots that may be vulnerable, like under a vanity or by your sofas.

* "I had some residue on my bathroom ceiling from hard water condensation. I happened to have a set of crutches lying around. I used a hair elastic to secure a hand towel to the arm rest of one crutch. Then I sprayed it with water and used it to scrub the ceiling. It worked really well. I was done in no time." -- A.A. in Florida

* Two ways to remove a bandage: Rub a little baby oil or vegetable oil over it. The oil will soak in and make it easier to remove. Or -- and this works especially well with kids -- have them soak in the bath and use baby shampoo to soften the sticky edges.

* A baking soda and water mix is great for tile floors if you want a quick mop up. If a lot of your floors are tile, do yourself a favor and invest in a steam mop. They clean and sanitize, leaving your floors brilliant.

* Be sure you use a trivet or other protectant when placing flowerpots on wood floors. Also, purchase felt pads for the bottoms of furniture. This will eliminate divots or other kinds of depressions or scratches in the floor.

* "Tiny tears in your window screen can be secured with clear nail polish. I dab the spot, then use tweezers to line up the tiny wires, then dab again. Just make sure the window is open, or the screen might stick to the windowpane." -- T.T. in Indiana

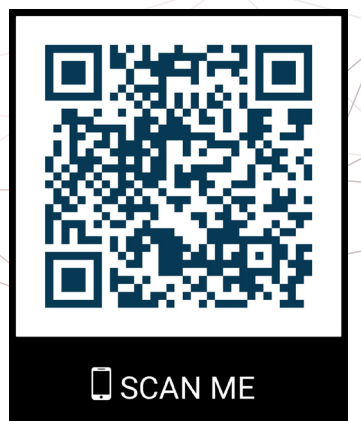
