#### **MEDIATION** FOR CHILD **CUSTODY CASES**


Divorce is complicated, especially when determining the custody of children. 





# Healthy Activities for kids of all ages

The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends various amounts of daily physical activity for children depending on their ages and abilities. Adhering to these recommendations is especially important in the wake of what many public health officials fear has become an epidemic of childhood obesity in

many nations.



Routine physical activity can help children maintain healthy weights, and it also pays dividends for youngsters' mental health. According to the American Psychological Association, children between the ages of six and 18 who exercise regularly tend to have lower levels of depression, stress and psychological distress. And the mental benefits don't stop there, as the study also found that youngsters who are physically active also have higher levels of positive selfimage, life satisfaction and psychological well-being.

The amount of physical activity children need each month depends on their age, and the AAP recommends the following agebased guidelines:

- Infants: The AAP recommends infants get at least 30 minutes of tummy time and other interactive play throughout the day.
- Toddlers: Toddlers can be tough to keep up with, and parents can channel that energy into something positive by ensuring their kids get at least three hours of physical activity every day. Free play outside and daily neighborhood walks are some examples of appropriate physical activities for children in this age group.

- Preschoolers: 3+ hours of physical activity, including one hour of moderate to vigorous exercise, is recommended for preschool-aged youngsters. Tumbling, throwing and catching are some of the activities recommended by the AAP.
- Elementary school students: Schoolaged children need at least 60 minutes of physical activity on most days of the week. The AAP recommends giving children in this age group ample opportunities for free play but also notes that organized sports focused on fun can be great outlets for kids in elementary school.
- Middle school students: Students in this age group need the same amount and types of exercise that elementary school students need. But the AAP advises parents to guide children toward physical activities that encourage socialization and to avoid having kids this age specialize in a single sport.
- **Teenagers:** Teenagers need an hour or more of physical activity most days of the week. Muscle/bone strengthening activities should be included three days per week. Activities that encourage socialization and competition are beneficial to teenagers' development. •

#### **Travel Thoughts By Kim** Let's go on an adventure together....to Wisconsin!

Let's talk about Wisconsin. I spent some time there in September 2016 during our cross country motor home trip. My sister-in-law is from small towns in Wisconsin called Tomah and Tunnel City and she still has family there. We stopped in Tunnel City to pick up her sister to join us for the rest of the trip.

So, when you think of Wisconsin, you probably think of the Green Bay Packers, Oshkosh B'Gosh, and dairy products - especially cheese. Well, there is all that, for sure. But, I learned some very interesting things about Wisconsin while I was there. Like, did you know that Wisconsin is a HUGE producer of cranberries? It is a major agricultural product for the state where bogs stretch across A typical cranberry bog full of mature cranberry the horizon and color every aspect of life in the community. Warrens, WI – near where we stayed in Tomah / Tunnel City – is the cranberry capital, producing more cranberries than any other state in the USA. In fact, according to their Cranberry Discovery Center, "Wisconsin cranberry growers annually harvest enough cranberries to supply every man, woman, and child in the whole world with approximately 26 cranberries." That's a LOT of cranberries!!! Most people I talked to about seeing cranberry bogs in Wisconsin were also surprised, thinking that the New England states were where you most likely find cranberry bogs. Well, maybe



guite ready and when we returned to drop her back home on the Cranberry bogs are planted adjacent to ponds and trenches that are used to gently flood the bogs when way back, most were done harvesting or just finishing up and weren't actively gathering berries the days we were there. the cranberries are ready for harvest. Once flooded, the cranberries are raked off the plants so they can float up to the surface to be collected.

are ready to harvest. When ready - typically late September, early October or so - the bogs are flooded. The bogs

have big ponds adjacent to them with a ditch all around the bog - the trenches are flooded from the ponds so that the water will gently gravitate into the bogs without harming the plants - no direct water pressure goes into the bogs during the flooding process. Once the bogs are flooded, the cranberry bushes are raked, causing the cranberries to float up to the surface of the water so they can be skimmed from the top of the water. Really cool! We toured a museum in the Cranberry Discovery Center in Warrens and saw antique equipment that was once used to manually harvest the cranberries. Of course, now, they use mechanized equipment

Of course, we bought all kinds of cranberry products to bring home – cranberry wine, famous Wisconsin cheese with cranberry marbled through it, and much more. I also learned that fresh cranberries can be frozen without first processing them - I assumed they should be blanched or something before freezing. I also learned that you can tell the best cranberries by seeing if they BOUNCE – the very best ones will bounce – imagine that!

We spent a few days in the Tunnel City area visiting with my sister-in-law's family and friends and did a few things in addition to the cranberry bogs. We had dinner at a wonderful Norwegian restaurant in Osseo, WI called Norske Nook





# Popular restaurant dining styles



ining out provides an opportunity to try many different foods that people may not normally prepare at home. It also introduces individuals to various themes and styles of dining.

Broadening one's culinary horizons can contribute to well-rounded adults and children who are likely to adapt well to various social situations. New dining experiences also may serve as the basis for making conversation or even developing new relationships.

Dining styles vary depending on the type of restaurant. The following rundown is ideal for diners who want to try new things and eat a great meal at the same time.

#### Hibachi

Hibachi restaurants provide both a meal and a show. Hibachi is a Japanese style of cooking and the word translates to "fire bowl." Hibachi involves cooking foods on a high-heat metal cooking plate, according to Shinto Japanese Steakhouse & Sushi. The cooking plate often is built into a table that diners sit around. The chef prepares the food while engaging the customers in the experience.



Tapas style features several small plates of food. Tapas are small, savory dishes, but can be quite filling when several dishes are chosen. Tapas traces its origins to Spain, but has become a notable restaurant trend in many different countries. Eating tapas enables diners to try many different things and share plates with others.

#### Family style

Family style of service is common in Italian and some Greek restaurants. It falls in between buffet dining and more formal plated sit-down dinners. According to the food and dining resource Grooving Gourmet, family-style involves wait staff bringing food to the table in large serving dishes. These items are passed around for each person to fill his or her plate. Family-style is reminiscent of dining at home, where one to three different foods are offered and guests serve themselves.



#### **Buffet**

With buffet dining, diners visit a centralized food station and serve themselves foods from various platters or chafing dishes. Sometimes food is spooned or served by personnel staffing the buffet table. Buffets let people try a variety of foods in sizable amounts.

#### Café or bistro
