MEDIATION FOR CHILD CUSTODY CASES

Divorce is complicated, especially when determining the custody of children. Generally, the court considers numerous variables: the wishes of all parties, including children; the relationship between children and parents; and adjustments to home, school, and community. Without an agreement of legal custody in place, the court may mandate that divorcing parties attend mediation to resolve these matters. A negotiation overseen by a third party, mediation settles any issues between parties, often resulting in a more economical and longer-lasting agreement. Under the guidance of a family law attorney, this can avoid acrimonious litigation and unnecessary expense. If mediation fails, a hearing or trial will force the court to resolve these disputes, leading to a protracted and expensive legal battle.

The mediation process is generally confidential and mediations are usually conducted without a court reporter. As such, parents can speak freely without fear of anyone learning what was discussed. Additionally, mediation is a much more cost-effective solution to resolving custody disputes than engaging in protracted litigation. 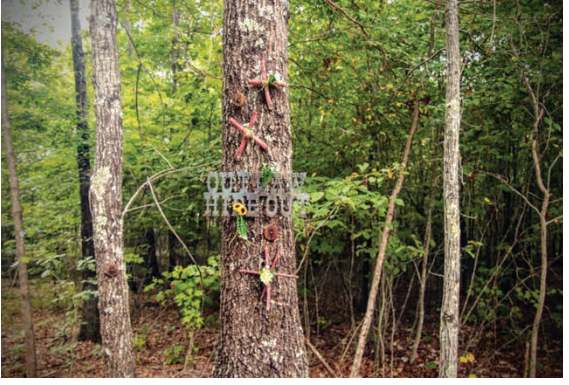

Even more boxed into NY, what I then called the Island, we made another mad dash down the 3rd week of September and looked at 6 more properties. The first one was The One. It was on the Sunset side of the mountain vs. the previous one which was on the Sunrise. Perfect since when I told my Mom we put an offer on a Sunrise, she was disillusioned because anyone who knows her knows she loves a Sunset. Thirty days later our Sunset piece on Mockingbird Lane was officially ours. We have had many brainstorming ideas about what to name our property and I wanted to call it The Great Escape. To me it holds double meaning. On our travels to build and Live life, it seemed we were being Outlaws for making the journeys. But when we arrived and felt the warmth and acceptance of the community, who were like minded in their value of the greatest treasure of all, Freedom, it was our Great Escape. My Aunt asked why we decided to take the Escape to TN and after careful thought it was clear. After feeling trapped in your own body with debilitating illness and then feeling trapped in your own surroundings with mandates we wanted to Live. Live freely, with our whole hearts, without bitterness. Life is too short to hold back or allow others to hold you back. It was just that simple. The Outlaw mission was a bit of a foreshadowing, when just before we headed out this June my friend Kathy S. gifted me a sign that read "Outlaw Hideout". Right away we knew it was Mockingbird Lane. A full circle moment. Where is your Great Escape?

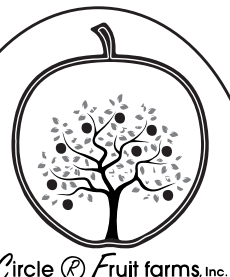

Healthy Activities

for kids of all ages



The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends various amounts of daily physical activity for children depending on their ages and abilities. Adhering to these recommendations is especially important in the wake of what many public health officials fear has become an epidemic of childhood obesity in many nations.

Routine physical activity can help children maintain healthy weights, and it also pays dividends for youngsters' mental health. According to the American Psychological Association, children between the ages of six and 18 who exercise regularly tend to have lower levels of depression, stress and psychological distress. And the mental benefits don't stop there, as the study also found that youngsters who are physically active also have higher levels of positive self-image, life satisfaction and psychological well-being.

The amount of physical activity children need each month depends on their age, and the AAP recommends the following age-based guidelines:

• **Infants:** The AAP recommends infants get at least 30 minutes of tummy time and other interactive play throughout the day.

• **Toddlers:** Toddlers can be tough to keep up with, and parents can channel that energy into something positive by ensuring their kids get at least three hours of physical activity every day. Free play outside and daily neighborhood walks are some examples of appropriate physical activities for children in this age group.

• **Preschoolers:** 3+ hours of physical activity, including one hour of moderate to vigorous exercise, is recommended for preschool-aged youngsters. Tumbling, throwing and catching are some of the activities recommended by the AAP.

• **Elementary school students:** School-aged children need at least 60 minutes of physical activity on most days of the week. The AAP recommends giving children in this age group ample opportunities for free play but also notes that organized sports focused on fun can be great outlets for kids in elementary school.

• **Middle school students:** Students in this age group need the same amount and types of exercise that elementary school students need. But the AAP advises parents to guide children toward physical activities that encourage socialization and to avoid having kids this age specialize in a single sport.

• **Teenagers:** Teenagers need an hour or more of physical activity most days of the week. Muscle/bone strengthening activities should be included three days per week. Activities that encourage socialization and competition are beneficial to teenagers' development. •

Signs of a HEART ATTACK

Travel Thoughts By Kim
 Let's go on an adventure together....to Wisconsin!

Let's talk about Wisconsin. I spent some time there in September 2016 during our cross country motor home trip. My sister-in-law is from small towns in Wisconsin called Tomah and Tunnel City and she still has family there. We stopped in Tunnel City to pick up her sister to join us for the rest of the trip. So, when you think of Wisconsin, you probably think of the Green Bay Packers, Oshkosh B'Gosh, and dairy products – especially cheese. Well, there is all that, for sure. But, I learned some very interesting things about Wisconsin while I was there. Like, did you know that Wisconsin is a HUGE producer of cranberries? It is a major agricultural product for the state where bogs stretch across the horizon and color every aspect of life in the community. That was the biggest surprise for me!

Warrens, WI – near where we stayed in Tomah / Tunnel City – is the cranberry capital, producing more cranberries than any other state in the USA. In fact, according to their Cranberry Discovery Center, “Wisconsin cranberry growers annually harvest enough cranberries to supply every man, woman, and child in the whole world with approximately 26 cranberries.” That's a LOT of cranberries!!! Most people I talked to about seeing cranberry bogs in Wisconsin were also surprised, thinking that the New England states were where you most likely find cranberry bogs. Well, maybe

are ready to harvest. When ready – typically late September, early October or so – the bogs are flooded. The bogs have big ponds adjacent to them with a ditch all around the bog – the trenches are flooded from the ponds so that the water will gently gravitate into the bogs without harming the plants – no direct water pressure goes into the bogs during the flooding process. Once the bogs are flooded, the cranberry bushes are raked, causing the cranberries to float up to the surface of the water so they can be skimmed from the top of the water. Really cool! We toured a museum in the Cranberry Discovery Center in Warrens and saw antique equipment that was once used to manually harvest the cranberries. Of course, now, they use mechanized equipment for the process.

so, but not as plentiful as in Wisconsin, where about 70% of the nation's cranberries are harvested in the fall each year! And, while Ocean Spray's corporate offices may be near Boston, they have multiple industrial sites in Wisconsin, including the one in Tomah, WI that produces 31 million pounds of dried cranberries and concentrate every year in that one facility, alone.

We visited some cranberry bogs and learned about how they grow and are harvested. It was all very interesting! I was disappointed that we just missed the active harvesting of bogs in the area – when we were there to pick up Donna, they weren't quite ready and when we returned to drop her back home on the way back, most were done harvesting or just finishing up and weren't actively gathering berries the days we were there.

So, here's how it all works: The bogs are square areas recessed to look like shallow square plots of land. The cranberry plants are planted in the sand in these bogs to grow until they

Of course, we bought all kinds of cranberry products to bring home – cranberry wine, famous Wisconsin cheese with cranberry marbled through it, and much more. I also learned that fresh cranberries can be frozen without first processing them – I assumed they should be blanched or something before freezing. I also learned that you can tell the best cranberries by seeing if they **BOUNCE** – the very best ones will bounce – imagine that!

We spent a few days in the Tunnel City area visiting with my sister-in-law's family and friends and did a few things in addition to the cranberry bogs. We had dinner at a wonderful Norwegian restaurant in Osseo, WI called Norske Nook Restaurant & Bakery that had the most incredible desserts. And, just down the street from the restaurant we saw

Popular restaurant dining styles
