



it take for police, fire, ambulance, to arrive? Where is the Coast Guard? Where are the Marines? is there one old farmer with enough common sense to just cut the strings? The desert air grows chilly as the sky darkens. I grow weaker. Dizziness overcomes me and I begin to drift off into that gray space somewhere between the living and the dead. Help finally arrives. One of the police officers bends down so I can see his face. "Hold on! A fire engine is here. There are six men aboard."

I do the math. Two big, strong cops and six burly firemen must move a ton of dead weight off me. That's two hundred forty five pounds each. No way can they possibly do that – but somehow, miraculously, they do. A couple of neighbors who have arrived at the scene stand by to catch me. They lower my limp body to the ground

where I lie in a broken heap.

Why didn't they cut the strings? They could have saved a long, tortured hour. How heavy is hay? A piece of hay is about the weight of a feather. How many pieces of hay does it take to make two thousand pounds? Lots. That package of sixteen bazillion individual pieces of hay wrapped in a gigantic bundle is a crushing weight. 

DATE PECAN TEA BREAD 1 LOAF ½ CUP SPREAD

INGREDIENTS

- 2-1/2 cups chopped dates
- 1-1/2 cups boiling water
- 1-1/2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1-3/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/4 teaspoon each ground cloves, cinnamon, ginger and nutmeg
- 2 tablespoons butter, softened
- 1-1/4 cups sugar
- 1 large egg
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1-1/2 cups coarsely chopped pecans

SPREAD:

- 3 ounces cream cheese, softened
- 2 tablespoons chopped dates
- 2 tablespoons coarsely chopped pecans
- 1 tablespoon 2% milk

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Place dates in a large bowl. Combine boiling water and baking soda; pour over dates. In a small bowl, combine the flour, cloves, cinnamon, ginger and nutmeg; set aside.
- 2. In another large bowl, beat butter and sugar until crumbly. Beat in egg and vanilla. Add flour mixture alternately with date mixture. Stir in pecans.
- 3. Pour into a greased and floured 9x5-in. loaf pan. Bake at 350° for 65-75 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the

center comes out clean. Cool for 10 minutes before removing from pan to wire rack to cool completely. 4. In a small bowl, combine spread ingredients. Cover and refrigerate for 1 hour. Serve with bread.

PRALINE-TOPPED APPLE BREAD 1 LOAF

INGREDIENTS

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup sour cream
- 2 large eggs, room temperature
- 3 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1-1/2 cups chopped peeled Granny Smith apples
- 1-1/4 cups chopped pecans, toasted, divided
- 1/2 cup butter, cubed
- 1/2 cup packed brown sugar

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°. In a large bowl, mix flour, baking powder, baking soda and salt. In another bowl, beat sugar, sour cream, eggs and vanilla until well blended. Stir into flour mixture just until moistened. Fold in apples and 1 cup pecans.
- 2. Transfer to a greased 9x5-in. loaf pan. Bake until a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean, 50-55 minutes. Cool in pan 10 minutes. Remove to a wire rack to cool completely.
- 3. In a small saucepan, combine butter and brown sugar. Bring to a boil, stirring constantly to dissolve sugar; boil 1 minute. Working quickly, pour over bread. Sprinkle with remaining pecans, let stand until set.

ORANGE BANANA NUT BREAD 2 LOAVES

INGREDIENTS

- 1-1/2 cups sugar
- 3 tablespoons canola oil
- 2 large eggs, room temperature
- 3 medium ripe bananas, mashed
- (about 1-1/4 cups)
- 3/4 cup orange juice
- 3 cups all-purpose flour



- 1-1/2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1-1/2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup chopped walnuts

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Preheat oven to 325°. In a bowl, combine the sugar, oil and eggs; mix well. Stir in bananas and orange juice. Combine the dry ingredients; add to banana mixture, beating just until moistened. Stir in walnuts. Pour into 2 greased 8x4-in. loaf pans.
- 2. Bake until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean, 50-60 minutes. Cool for 10 minutes; remove from pans to a wire rack to cool completely.

Freeze option: Securely wrap cooled loaves in foil; freeze. To use, thaw at room temperature.

SWEET POTATO CINNAMON BREAD 4 MINI LOAFS

INGREDIENTS

- 3-1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2-2/3 cups sugar
- 2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
- 1-1/2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves
- 4 large eggs, room temperature
- 2 cups mashed sweet potatoes
- 2/3 cup canola oil
- 2/3 cup 2% milk
- 1-1/2 cups raisins
- 1 cup chopped walnuts

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°. In a large bowl, whisk the first 8 ingredients. In another bowl, whisk eggs, sweet potatoes, oil and milk until blended. Add to flour mixture; stir just until moistened. Fold in raisins and walnuts.
- 2. Transfer to 4 greased 5-3/4x3x2-in. loaf pans. Bake 35-40 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool in pans 10 minutes before removing to wire racks to cool.

HONEY SPICE BREAD 1 LOAF

INGREDIENTS

2/3 cup packed brown sugar 1/3 cup 2% milk 2 cups all-purpose flour



- 1-1/2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1/8 teaspoon ground cloves
- 2 large eggs, room temperature
- 1/2 cup honey
- 1/3 cup canola oil

GLAZE:

1/3 cup confectioners' sugar

2 teaspoons 2% milk

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Preheat oven to 325°. In a small saucepan, combine brown sugar and milk. Cook and stir over low heat until sugar is dissolved. Remove from heat.
- 2. In a large bowl, whisk flour, baking powder, cinnamon, nutmeg and cloves. In another bowl, whisk eggs, honey, oil and brown sugar mixture until blended. Add to flour mixture; stir just until moistened.
- 3. Transfer the batter to a greased 8x4-in. loaf pan. Bake 50-60 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean (cover top loosely with foil if needed to prevent over browning).
- 4. Cool in pan 10 minutes before removing to a wire rack to cool completely. In a small bowl, stir glaze ingredients until smooth; drizzle over bread.

Freeze option: Securely wrap cooled loaf in foil and then freeze. To use, thaw at room temperature. Glaze as directed.



Auman, MADD spokesman, reminds us every year to show up, get the T-Shirt, and bring your hats, gloves, brooms, and/or rakes. There will be a variety of locations needing workers, and you'll meet some fun new people.

**If your plants are looking poorly after the very stressful summer extremes, try feeding your plants. Too much rain and heat can leach out essential nutrients from the soil, but by adding compost to your plants or a balanced granular fertilizer (such as 0-10-10 which has less nitrogen to pollute water basins) a few days after the run-off of water may help them regain much needed nutrition. If you don't yet

have a mature compost source, good quality mushroom compost or composted manure from a garden center will help. Another organic fertilizer source, fish emulsion (also called "fish fertilizer"), is very effective and healthy for veggies and ornamental plants. Mix a tablespoon in a gallon of water and apply.

**Here's what you can plant now: But first, If you get a soil test done before you plant, you will find out what to add to your soil to make your veggies thrive. Beets, broccoli, cabbage, carrots, cauliflower, Chinese cabbage, collards, kale, kohlrabi, lettuce, mustard, onions, radishes, snap beans, spinach, summer squash, turnips, white potatoes, winter squash.

The Claybank Master Gardeners are again meeting every 2nd Wednesday of the month, with masks and socially distanced, at 11AM at Hoppergrass Restaurant in Ozark, 129 S. East Ave. (But please first call the Dale County Extension Office at (334) 774-2329 to be sure in case of changes). This month, we meet on October 13th. Interesting speakers, on different topics related to gardening, are usually with us.
