Piedmont Pets

Virginia has laws requiring a high standard of care for each companion animal. While not perfect, the laws on the books define what "adequate food, water, space, exercise, and shelter" must be provided. Owners of companion animals must provide "veterinary care when needed to prevent suffering or disease transmission". Another provision requires owners to provide "adequate care and treatment." That is open to a lot of interpretation.

We repeat now what we have said through the years: The law can make you provide food, water, and shelter for your pets, but the law cannot make you love your pets and want to spend time with them, even when that can be defined as "adequate care and treatment."

It is absolutely heartbreaking to see dogs leading solitary lives in backyards or in dog lots. It is equally as heartbreaking seeing small companion animals forced to live their complete lives in small wire cages.

Several years ago, we were asked to investigate the care of a dog being kept in a lot in a remote area. When we went to the address provided, we found a nice, big dog lot with a lone dog in it. The ground was muddy, but the dog had a bowl of water. He was not fat, but not thin. What really caught our attention was how lonely he seemed. He strained to reach us through the fencing, and wagged his tail every time we gave him any attention. A neighbor told us that the owner came by every day or so to give him food or water, but the owner no longer lived there. That means the dog, basically led a solitary life

with only the sight of traffic on the road to occupy his interest.

We have seen this over and over, multiplied thousands of times through the years. I overheard a man speaking with his wife one day at the shelter, and he told her that it would be selfish to adopt any animal with their current lifestyle. I was grateful that he recognized that.

The animals that we take into our homes and lives to be our companions have certain requirements to be happy, beyond the basics of food, water, and shelter. Only people who are willing and prepared to give time and love should be the ones to have companion animals. Having a pet is not a right; having a pet is a privilege that comes with the responsibility of making sure the animals' emotional and psychological needs are also met.

Board of Supervisors Legislative Committee to Discuss Limiting Solar Projects

Solar Development in Pittsylvania County

A called meeting of the Legislative Committee of the Pittsylvania County Board of Supervisors has been scheduled for 5 p.m., Tuesday, October 5 at the request of Dr. Charles Miller, Chairman of the Legislative Committee and Banister District Supervisor. Among other things, the legislative committee will be considering different options for limiting solar development across Pittsylvania County.

A public hearing regarding solar development and revisions to Pittsylvania County's solar ordinance surrounding revenue sharing options was advertised and scheduled for last week's Board of Supervisors meeting. To allow for additional consideration to be given to the matter, that meeting ultimately was pushed back to a later date. With help from Community Development and the Commissioner of Revenue, the Board of Supervisors has been considering different taxation options for solar projects for several months.

Pittsylvania County's zoning ordinance has a variety of requirements and regulations for any utility-scale solar facility. This includes limits on the zoning designations where solar can be developed, decommissioning bond requirements, and setback and buffer regulations. There are also regulations about the distance between each solar project. The committee will examine these current requirements and regulations and consider ways to limit solar development across the county.

The legislative committee will also discuss revisions to the music festival ordinance, which was revised earlier this year. The committee is interested in changing the structure of the ordinance so that the threshold for regulation is based on the number of attendees instead of the hours of amplified music.

The legislative committee of the Board of Supervisors makes recommendations regarding policy or ordinance changes, which are then considered by the full Board of Supervisors. In addition to Chairman Miller, the other two members of the legislative committee are Westover Supervisor Ron Scarce and Dan River Supervisor Joe Davis.

This meeting will be held in the main conference room in the County Administration building, located at 1 Center Street, Chatham, VA 24531.

The 2021/22 Aviation Teachers Grant program offers a \$500.00 grant to teachers who develop a lesson plan utilizing aviation concepts. The deadline for applications is February 28, 2022.

The Virginia level of the International Aviation Art Contest is open to students ages 6-17 and this year's theme is "Design Your Perfect Aircraft." Artwork must be mailed to the Department of Aviation by January 10, 2022.

There are three scholarships available to Virginia high school seniors including the 2021/22 John R. Lillard Scholarship, 2021/22 Kenneth R. Scott Aviation Scholarship and the 2021/22 Willard G. Plentl, Sr. Aviation Scholarship. The scholarships range from \$2,500 to \$3,000 and applications must be received by March 11, 2022.

The Chad Weaver Aviation Scholarship provides up to \$800 for ground school and flight training for teenagers and adults to pursue a private pilot license or flight instructor certificate.

The Virginia Department of Aviation's Mission is to: Develop an advanced aviation system that is safe, secure, and fosters economic development; Build an appreciation by the public for the importance of aviation and to inspire the next generation of aviation professionals; and Provide safe and highly efficient flight services for the Commonwealth's leadership and state agencies.

Statement on Blue Ridge Country Festival

As has been widely reported, the Blue Ridge Country Festival, which was scheduled for this weekend, has been postponed until 2022. During a special called meeting in June, the Board of Supervisors had approved the issuance of a permit for the Blue Ridge Country Festival. This application was approved with conditions around Purpose Driven Events, the company operating the Blue Ridge Amphitheater in Blairs, providing proper plans and final documentation for areas like traffic, parking, camping, and security, among other things. However, those final documents were never provided, Purpose Driven Events never paid the required permit fee, and an actual permit for the event was never officially issued.

Pittsylvania County Administrator David Smitherman, after consulting with officials including the Pittsylvania County Sheriff, Virginia State Police, Virginia Department of Health, VDOT and other regulatory agencies, sent a letter to Purpose Driven Events on Tuesday, September 21 stating that the festival permits were rescinded until updated and complete plans were submitted to the proper agencies. That letter offered Purpose Driven Events several steps to complete by Thursday, September 23 if they wished to move forward with planning their event and obtaining an official permit.

On Thursday, the event promoter informed Pittsylvania County that it was highly likely that the event would be postponed due to the COVID-19 pandemic and said that, as a result, he would not move forward with providing the requested documentation. The next day, the event promoter informed Pittsylvania County that he was working with artists and other parties to make a formal postponement announcement, which was released to ticketholders on Monday and the general public today.

The Chatham Star Tribune reported that, according to Pittsylvania County and the Health Department, the event organizers provided verifiably false reason as to why the event was canceled. That is incorrect. While the permits for the festival were rescinded, the event promoters stayed in consistent contact with the County and were transparent that COVID implications would likely require postponement of the event. The requested documentation was not provided due to these COVID related concerns.

Husband Is Always Tired

DEAR DR. ROACH: My husband is tired all the time. He functions, but frequently has to sit to recoup his energy, even after a shower. He is diabetic and has been for over 10 years. He does not take insulin and manages to keep his A1C within 7.1 to 6.9. He weighs 207 pounds, and he's 6 feet, 1 inch tall and 75 years old. His bloodwork always comes back normal, and a nuclear stress test came back negative. We have discussed this chronic fatigue with our family doctor. His only explanation is possibly low testosterone (the low end of normal). We know that some if not all of his medications list fatigue as a side effect, but we cannot persuade our doctor to do further tests. My husband does have an appointment with a cardiologist in May for a consultation and any suggestions, and also a check-up in six months with our family doctor. My concern is his medications and the fact that they are generic. I have read many stories about generic drugs and problems with their effectiveness. -- J.C.

ANSWER: Fatigue, which is the sensation of feeling tired, is a nonspecific symptom and a complaint that's commonly heard by general doctors. It can be related to many diseases, as disparate as multiple sclerosis to heart failure, anemia to depression, and chronic infection to sleep disturbances. However, your husband notes a severe intolerance to exertion, which makes me suspect systemic exertion intolerance disorder, also called myalgic encephalomyelitis or chronic fatigue syndrome. Poor sleep, difficulty thinking or concentrating, and

having worse symptoms with standing also go along with this diagnosis. There is yet no lab test for confirmation. The diagnosis is made after considering other causes, and testing for those that make sense after a careful history and exam.

Diabetes, when not well controlled, may lead to chronic fatigue. I'm not so concerned with generic medications as I am about too many or the wrong ones, so a careful review of medications is appropriate.

I have previously recommended a graded exercise program for this condition; however, the study that led to this recommendation had several significant issues; many people will actually have worsening of their post-exercise fatigue, so exercise must be used very cautiously and on an individualized basis. Cognitive behavioral therapy has had some benefit, but we desperately need better treatments.

DEAR DR. ROACH: In a recent column, you said that using peroxide in the ear is a bad home remedy. Would you please expand on this subject? My children grew up with me using peroxide to clean excessive wax from their ears, and they now use the same remedy on my grandchildren.

ANSWER: Most earwax does not need to be removed. It should be removed only when there are symptoms (such as poor hearing, ear pressure or pain, and sometimes itchiness or dizziness), and when it is clear that the symptoms are coming from excess earwax. This requires a look in the ear, since similar symptoms may come from infection. Hydrogen peroxide is too harsh to put on skin. Doctors may use it to irrigate the ear canal while looking into the ear, but it is diluted, usually 1:10. Over-the-counter earwax preparations, such as carbamide peroxide, may also be recommended once the diagnosis is clear.

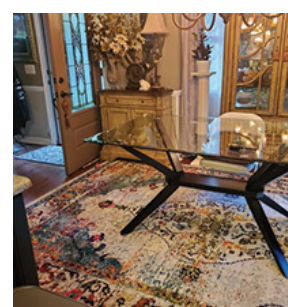

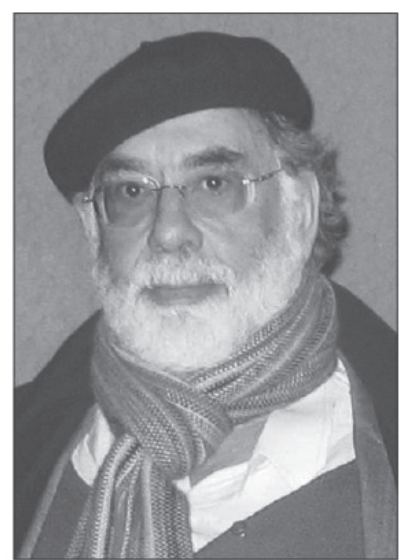
HOLLYWOOD — Francis Ford Coppola won five Oscars before he was 36 and is now 82 years young. He intends to "put my money where my mouth is" in making his next film, "Megalopolis." He's even willing to put up whatever he can't raise of the \$120 million budget, vowing, "I'm prepared to match outside financing."

Of his past 10 films (since 1986), only "Peggy Sue Got Married" (1986), "The Godfather Part III" (1990) and "Bram Stoker's Dracula" (1992) were successful. His last film, "Twixt," made in 2011, was a horror film with Val Kilmer, Bruce Dern, Elle Fanning and Ben Chaplin, which earned only \$1.3 million of its \$7 million budget. What has sustained Coppola financially for all these years, besides his Coppola wine, is earnings from the 1979 film "Apocalypse Now." He explains, "It's been a big money-maker because I own the negative. The reason I own the negative is because nobody wanted it!"

Coppola's betting his own money that "Megalopolis" will be a big hit and possibly his swan song. He's rounding up a first-class cast that includes Oscar-winners Cate Blanchett, Forest Whitaker, Jessica Lang and Jon Voight, as well as Zendaya, Michelle Pfeiffer and, for good measure, his "Godfather" Sonny Corleone, James Caan. We're pulling for you Francis, you're a great director and screenwriter, and we need you as much as you need this.

Jason Statham is producing another edition of "The Expendables," starring Sylvester Stallone, Dolph Lundgren, Randy Coltrane, and of course, Statham himself.

Another great talent struggling to continue working movie magic is Frank Oz. As a performer, he created some of our most beloved characters. His unforgettable characters for "Sesame Street" include Miss Piggy,

Cookie Monster, Grover, Fozzie Bear and Bert, to name a few. Oz dominated eight Muppet movies, was the voice of Yoda in a slew of "Star Wars" films and was visible onscreen in "Knives Out" (2017) as Alan Stevens.

As a director, he helmed "The Dark Crystal" (1982), "The Muppets Take Manhattan" (1984), "Little Shop of Horrors" (1986), "Dirty Rotten Scoundrels" (1988), "What About Bob?" (1991), "In & Out" (1997), "Bowfinger" (1999) and "The Stepford Wives" (2004), to name just some of his hits. When Disney bought Jim Henson's characters in 2004 (but not the "Sesame Street" gang), Frank Oz found he was considered expendable. He laments, "They don't want me because I won't follow orders and do the kind of Muppets they believe in. The soul's not there, the soul is what makes things grow and be funny!"

Maybe Frank Oz should go to Warner Brothers (they own "The Wizard of Oz"). Maybe he can be the NEW "Wizard of Oz"!

EASY APPLE COBBLER RECIPE



INGREDIENTS

- 2 honey crisp apples peeled, cored and cut into 1/4-inch slices
 - 2 gala apples peeled, cored and cut into 1/4-inch slices
 - 1/4 cup brown sugar
 - 2 tablespoons granulated sugar
 - 3 tablespoons all-purpose flour
 - Juice from 1 small lemon about 1 tablespoon juice
 - 1 teaspoon vanilla paste or 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
 - 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
 - 1 teaspoon ground ginger
 - Teeny pinch of ground cardamom
 - Teeny pinch of ground cloves
- TOPPING:**
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
 - 2 teaspoons baking powder
 - 1/4 teaspoon kosher salt
 - 1/2 cup granulated sugar
 - 3/4 cup whole milk
 - 6 tablespoons unsalted butter melted
 - 1 teaspoon vanilla paste or 2 teaspoons vanilla extract

INSTRUCTIONS

- PREP:**
- Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F. Grease or butter a baking casserole dish that's 9x6 or something comparable. Use what you have! And then set it aside.
- TO MAKE THE FILLING:**
- In a large bowl, add the sliced honey crisp apples, gala apples, brown sugar, sugar, flour, juice from 1 lemon, vanilla and spices (cinnamon, ginger, cardamom and cloves). Toss it all together until combined. Add the filling to your prepared baking dish.
- TO MAKE THE TOPPING:**
- In a medium bowl, whisk together the flour, baking powder, salt and sugar. Add the milk, butter and vanilla; mix until combined. Pour the topping on top of the filling. It's ok if some of the filling is peaking through or it's not a totally perfect on top. I like it when some of the filling shows through. And then transfer to the oven to bake for about 40 to 45 minutes, until the filling is bubbling and the top is golden brown.
- Remove from the oven and serve warm with cold vanilla ice cream.
