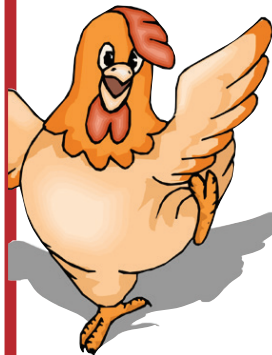

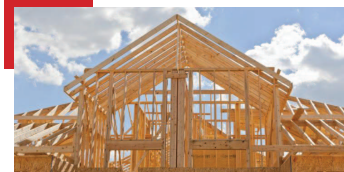

SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

During the past seventy-five years since the end of World War II, we Americans have lost our resolve to win our wars. We have now exited Afghanistan and are considering leaving Iraq after decades with thousands of American military killed and wounded in action.

When a country enters a just war, there should be a commitment to fully destroy the enemy to the extent that the enemy will not be a thorn in our side again.

ARE YOU PREPARED FOR FLU SEASON?

Flu season is approaching fast! The Livingston County Department of Health wants you to be protected. The best way to prevent the flu or influenza is by getting your seasonal flu vaccination, which is recommended for all individuals six months of age and older.

Seasonal flu is a respiratory illness that can spread easily from one person to another. Most of the time flu causes mild illness, but for certain individuals it can be much more severe. Flu and COVID-19 share many symptoms. It can be hard to tell which illness you have without a test. The only way to be sure you are protected is by getting your flu vaccine.

In addition to being vaccinated some other ways to help prevent the flu include:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick, and avoid going near people when you are sick.
- Stay home from work, school and public gatherings when you are sick.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when coughing or sneezing.
- Wash your hands often. Keeping your hands clean can help stop the spread of germs.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth because this is how germs are spread.

By following these tips, you can protect yourself and your family from the flu. Watch for the flu vaccine near you at your doctor's office or local pharmacy.
