News of a new band in town is always good news, especially when its name is a part of musical history.



The lyrics (Look 'em up or check out the song on YouTube) require some knowledge of history to understand the references to such things as "A Barnum and Bailey World," which is a reference to the Ringling Bros. and Barnham and Bailey Circus that toured the United States from 1919, until about 2007. Reading the next question on your lips as to who was first to sing the song, It's Only A Paper Moon, we'll tell you it was Claire Carlson, in 1932; though the big hit came for Nat King Cole's Trio, in 1944, as a breakout from a self-titled first album. The song was much later recorded by Ella Fitzgerald...

The motion Picture, Paper Moon, Starring Ryan O'Neal and his daughter

Tatum, was released in 1973 with great box office success...

The three will be performing Thursday, October 28th, at The Beach Club, in Arnolds Park. Before we left for a brief vacation two weeks ago, we noted the success of the 2021 Clay County Fair from an entertainment standpoint. Right after we left, Fair manager Jeremy Parsons made some numbers public, noting, that after a hiatus in 2020, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Clay County Fair returned to a lot of sunshine and smiling fairgoers -- all eager to participate in many new events. Parsons measured the Fair's success with its youth Involvement of 708 4-H and FFA exhibitors from 42 counties in Iowa, Minnesota, and Nebraska participating in livestock and human sciences events, along with approximately 1,300 third and fourth grade students from 16 regional schools visiting the Fair as part of the AgCiting and SciCiting field trip programs coordinated by ISU Extension Clay County.

Fairgoer Spending at concessions, and carnival rides totaled over \$2.5 million dollars, breaking the record set in 2017. Preliminary fairgoer spending set three single-day records. More than 450 commercial exhibitors, concessionaires, and vendors showcased at the Fair. And with at least 150 ag-specific exhibitors, the Fair again hosted the largest farm machinery and ag equipment show at any fair in the United States.

Fair attendance totaled 277,389. Obviously, there were many records set this year -- more than we have space for in *Ramboling*; but you get the idea. Congratulations is in order to all who participated -- as concessionaires, vendors, volunteers, exhibitors, as staff, and/or visitors. To note a refrain from a Sinatra







Huge Game for Hawks

Iowa will host one of their biggest games in recent memory when Penn State comes to Kinnick Stadium on Saturday for a 3:00 kickoff. This is a top five matchup between the #3 Hawkeyes and #4 Nittany Lions and will go a long way to helping one of these teams have a solid chance at making the College Football Playoffs. One could argue the game is bigger for Penn State as far as their B1G championship hopes as the Nittany Lions can ill-afford a loss because they have #7 Ohio State and #9 Michigan in their division while there is not another team in the West that is sniffing the Top 25.

Iowa flexed their muscle against Maryland on Friday night in a game that featured two 4-0 teams heading into the game that the Hawkeyes dominated in their 51-14 win. Iowa forced seven (no that's not a misprint) Terrapin turnovers, including six interceptions, and Spencer Petras threw for three touchdowns while running for two in the Hawkeye route. Maryland's Taulia Tagovailoa came into the game leading the B1G in passing with just one interception, but Iowa's defense picked Tagovailoa off five times and the Hawks outscored Maryland 31-0 in the second quarter to blow the game wide open. Iowa's defense leads the nation with 12 interceptions (no other B1G team has more than five), and the unit continues to put the offense in great field position with their turnovers. If the Hawks don't force a turnover, they are capable of flipping the field with All-American punter Tory Taylor.

Penn State enters this contest coming off a 24-0 win against Indiana and looks very similar to Iowa. Much like Iowa, the Nittany Lions are fueled by an incredibly strong defense. Penn State is allowing only 4.7 yards per play and has allowed only 10 total points in their two B1G victories. Also similar to Iowa is that Penn State had a very impressive non-conference win when they took down #18 Auburn 28-20 a week after Iowa won 27-17 at then #7 Iowa State. Another similarity in these two teams is that neither offense has been spectacular, but both have had moments where they have shown potential. Penn State's passing offense ranks 42nd nationally with 286 yards per game, but their rushing offense is 164th nationally at 132 yards per game. Iowa's passing offense is 169th nationally at 194 yards per game and their rushing offense is 173rd with 126 yards per game.

All this sets up to be a defensive showdown in front of a frenzied Kinnick Stadium crowd. Although the offensive numbers haven't shown it yet, I do think Iowa's offense is more explosive than Penn State's with running back Tyler Goodson and the big arm of Spencer Petras. I also believe that Iowa's defense is superior to Penn State's and will once again win the turnover battle, which will be the key factor in this game. Look for Iowa to continue their strong start with a 21-10 victory over the Nittany Lions, giving the Hawks two Top 10 victories and putting them strongly in the driver's seat of the B1G West.




















Also, for those who are uninsured or under-covered through insurance, check with Clay County Public Health about the Care for Yourself program, which offers assistance for women's health screenings including breast and cervical cancer screenings."

Hasley added that Spencer Hospital's Women's Health Center offers educational materials regarding a myriad of women's health topics, including breast cancer. The Women's Health Center is accredited by the American College of Radiology as a Breast Imaging Center of Excellence and features 3D mammography. $All\,of\,Spencer\,Hospital's\,mammographers\,are\,registered\,through$ the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists.



The Iowa State University Extension and Outreach Dairy Team has been proactive in bringing education to Spanish-speaking employees in the agricultural industry over the past several years. This has included on-farm training, videos and resources for

working in dairies. While sharing these resources, the team found that a focus on life skills in Spanish was also needed to help the two cultures understand and prosper in these changing times. That idea evolved into partners across the communities joining

together to provide a bi-monthly newsletter in Spanish to bring timely and topical information to employees and their families. The "Latinos Trabajando en Siouxland/Celebración de Vida"

newsletter has been distributed to employers in Northwest Iowa for placement on breakroom tables and throughout local businesses. It is also available as a free download at https://www. extension.iastate.edu/dairyteam/hispanic-resources.

While producers use the dairy team's Spanish videos and brochures to teach professional skills, this newsletter will address life skills for employees working in a new culture, according to Fred Hall, dairy specialist with ISU Extension and Outreach.

"The dairy team is excited to expand our reach to Spanish-speaking employees in the food-producing and handling industries," said Hall. "By working with employers to make the newsletter available on break room tables, we hope it develops conversations on topics that will help blend the two cultures in the workplace."

In addition to the Iowa State University Extension and Outreach dairy team and the Human Sciences team, Iowa Legal Aid and Head Start are partners who have provided information for the first issue. 



Laborshed Study will be Conducted

The Iowa Lakes Corridor Development Corporation (Corridor) is partnering with Iowa Workforce Development (IWD) and Iowa Economic Development Authority to complete a Laborshed



employment study for the Estherville, Spencer, Spirit Lake and Storm Lake areas. This study will geographically define which communities contribute to each city's workforce, regardless of political boundaries. This defined area is called a Laborshed area and is based upon commuting patterns.

The purpose of this Laborshed study is to measure the availability and characteristics of workers in Estherville, Spencer, Spirit Lake and Storm Lake. Laborshed studies are useful tools for economic development teams and existing or prospective employers to understand the local labor market, make informed expansion and site selection decisions, and maintain/recruit a high-quality workforce.

For the success of this study, we are sending letters to randomly selected households asking residents to take a confidential online survey. Survey questions will cover topics such as: employment status, current and desired wages, current and desired benefits, education level, and type of occupation, among other things. However, Iowa Workforce Development will not be asking survey takers identifiable information such as: name, social security number, or date of birth. Participation in this workforce study is greatly appreciated regardless of employment status whether you are currently employed, unemployed, a homemaker, retired, etc. Your input is highly valued.

Following the conclusion of the online surveying efforts IWD will conduct telephone surveying in the area through a third-party vendor. The survey call originates out of Missouri and the incoming number will have the 573 area code. The same survey questions asked in the online survey will be asked of those who participate in the survey on the phone and again, no identifying information will be collected. All the survey answers collected will be combined and reported together. Individual answers are completely confidential.

Every year Iowa Workforce Development conducts Laborshed studies across the State. The results of each analysis are publicly available online at www.iowalmi.gov/laborshed. 





Members of Iowa Questers Okoboji Queen Chapter celebrated their tenth anniversary with a very special tea featuring a very special program "The Life and Times of Sue Fontaine," the chapter's 97 year-old co-founder.

After being seated at the beautifully decorated tables and enjoying a varied menu, at the home of Immediate Past President Donna Mau, the Questers wearing hats appropriate for a special occasion, listened as Co-founder Sue Fontaine

began her story. She was born in the small town of Rolfe, Iowa, in the Victorian home of her maternal grandparents. She shared an old photo of the house that she lamented was not restored or preserved.

Sue's childhood and teenage years always included summers at her grandparents' cottage at Lake Okoboji. Despite growing up in Sioux City, Iowa, she considers Okoboji as "home" and told of the early years on the lake sailing and visiting the original Amusement Park and the many entertainment sites that are now long gone.

After graduating from the University of Iowa, with a journalism major, Sue went on to marry, raise two children, get a master's degree in library science from the University of Missouri, and move around the country with her husband, a geologist with Shell Oil. Professionally she became the first female TV producer in New Orleans, LA and later worked in the New York City Public Library system eventually being the Public Relations and Marketing Director for the Queens Library which had the largest circulation numbers in the United States.
