Carbon Monoxide Poisoning

Prevention

Every year, hundreds of people die and thousands are injured from unsuspected exposure to an odorless, colorless gas-carbon monoxide (CO). Studies by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention indicate that, while people recognize CO gas is poisonous, they perceive CO as less dangerous than other household hazards. CO poisoning is most prevalent when furnaces are turned back on to fight cold winter temperatures, but also commonly occur after summer and winter storms and accompanying power outages, when people tend to rely on portable generators for electricity.


Here are some simple steps to protect yourselves and your family:

- ✓ Install battery-operated CO detectors near every sleeping area in your home.
- ✓ Check CO detectors regularly to be sure they are functioning properly.
- ✓ Have gas or oil furnaces inspected by a qualified professional every year.
- ✓ Never use a generator inside the home or garage, even if doors and windows are open.
- ✓ Only use generators and power washers outside, more than 20 feet away from the home, doors, and windows.
- ✓ Never use a charcoal grill inside the home.

SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

This week we will journey back into America's history and study the "History of American Epidemics (Pandemics) and Vaccinations". During the early days of our American Revolution from 1775 to 1782, there was a Smallpox epidemic which was killing more soldiers than the British.

On Monday, January 6, 1777, General George Washington ordered that all Continental soldiers be vaccinated against Smallpox. The last outbreak of Smallpox in America occurred in 1949. Diseases and epidemics of the 19th century included long-standing epidemic threats such as Smallpox, Typhus, Yellow Fever, and Scarlet Fever. There was a Typhus epidemic in 1843 in Concord, New Hampshire, and several Typhus epidemics occurred in Baltimore, Memphis and Washington, D. C., between 1865 and 1873. There is no effective vaccination for Typhus which was almost eliminated through good personal hygiene. A Typhus vaccination was tested in the 1970s which had only limited effectiveness.

The last outbreak of Yellow Fever in America occurred in 1905 in New Orleans and was thought to have been caused by mosquitos. A safe and effective Yellow Fever vaccine has been available for more than 80 years.

Yellow Fever is not currently found in the United States, and thanks to the vaccine, travelers rarely get the disease. The Yellow Fever vaccine is only recommended for people living in or traveling to places where Yellow Fever is a risk or for people who work in labs studying the virus. Yellow Fever is still prevalent in Africa and South America.

For his work on the Yellow Fever vaccine, Max Theiler received the 1951 Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine. Only the 17D Yellow Fever vaccine remains in use today.

Cholera emerged as an epidemic threat and spread worldwide in six epidemics in the nineteenth century. Between 1846 to 1860 there was a worldwide Cholera epidemic which killed over a million people.

Between 1889 and 1890 there was a worldwide influenza epidemic which also killed over one million people. Scarlet Fever, also known as Scarlatina, is less common now than in the past, but outbreaks still occur. The bacteria that cause Strep Throat is also responsible for Scarlet Fever. It can be successfully treated with antibiotics.

The 1918 Spanish Flu, also known as the Great Influenza, was an exceptionally deadly global influenza epidemic caused by the H1N1 Influenza A virus. By the summer of 1919 America reached Herd Immunity as most Americans had either died or developed immunity.

Approximately 675,000 people died from the 1918 Spanish Flu, but on Thursday September 30, 2021, deaths from COVID-19 have surpassed 700,000

There was a worldwide influenza epidemic in 1957 and 1958. For a child to enter a New York State public school, they must be vaccinated for Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (Whooping Cough), Hepatitus B, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Polio and Varicella (Chickenpox).
On Thursday, March 26, 1953, American medical

researcher Dr. Jonas Salk announced that he has successfully tested a vaccine against Poliomyelitis.

In 2021 three vaccines are being offered to Americans for COVID-19. Several of our founding fathers commented that with the blessings of our freedoms goes responsibility and respect for the freedoms and health of others.

I leave you to your own conclusions regarding vaccinations.

· Operation Green Light to Aid Returning Veterans in Livingston County ·

Deployments and training exercises are challenging elements of military service, but for some the most difficult part of their enlistment can be the transition back to civilian life, known among veterans as expiration of term of service (ETS).

Operation Green Light, a partnership between the New York State Association of Counties (NYSAC) and the New York State County Veteran Service Officer Association (NYS CVSOA), is looking to fix that. The campaign aims to ease the ETS transition by encouraging counties statewide to adopt a number of veteran-friendly initiatives, such as removing residency requirements on civil service exams for active duty military personnel, having local businesses commit to hiring veterans prior to their ETS, and the creation of the ETS Mentorship Program, which connects locals with a transitioning military member to offer their support and advice.

Livingston County Veteran Services Director Jason Skinner is working to implement Operation Green Light locally, starting with a resolution naming Livingston County as a Green Light for Military Service County. He's also inviting residents and business owners to display a green light in their window or on porches as a visible sign of support for returning veterans. Skinner said with suicide rates for veterans around 1.5 times more than those of the civilian population, more needs to be done to help returning service members during the uncertainty of their ETS transition.

"In the military, typically your housing and healthcare is paid for, you're given orders on where to be, when to be there, and exactly how to dress," explained Skinner. "To go from that regimented lifestyle to the freedom of civilian life can be very jarring. We hope that by easing this ETS transition, we can encourage more veterans to plant their roots here in Livingston County."
