It looks like over 140 pots of stew will be simmering the bubbly brew known as Hopkins County Stew! And as I write this on Columbus Day, we've had our first early-season cool front come through, bringing some rain and wind last night, and a day dawning cool with wet leaves and light breezes. Fall is indeed in the air, and it's welcome with the scent of baking gingerbread and pumpkin pies (or maybe just scented candles that mimic baking!) This season is definitely well-rounded on it's



own! Fall decor is everywhere shouting "Happy Autumn!" on porches and homes around the county. But, the Harvest season soon gives way to thoughts of Thanksgiving and Christmas, and plans dancing like sugarplums in our heads for anticipated visits by loved ones and outdoor activities associated with the holidays. These delights are not that far away! But before we get too far ahead of ourselves.

here's a time-tested local recipe for Hopkins County Stew from back when The Food Network came to town to televise our event!

Family-size Hopkins County Stew Recipe

Ingredients: Yield: Four and a half quarts, or 12-15 bowls of stew

1 (6- to 6 1/2-pound) baking hen, cut up 1 teaspoon sugar

1/4 cup butter or margarine, melted 1 teaspoon chili powder

4 cups diced potatoes

2 medium onions, chopped

4 cups chicken broth

1 (28-ounce) can whole tomatoes,

undrained and finely chopped

1 teaspoon paprika

1 teaspoon salt

1/2 teaspoon pepper

1 (17-ounce) can cream-style corn

DIRECTIONS: Step 1. Brown chicken in butter in a large skillet; remove chicken, and set aside to cool. Bone chicken, and cut meat into 2- inch pieces. Step 2. Place potatoes and onion in a large Dutch oven. Add broth; stir well. Cover and cook 1 hour or until vegetables are tender. Add tomatoes; continue cooking, covered, 20 minutes. Add chicken, sugar, and seasonings; stir well. Cook, covered, over low heat 3 hours, stirring occasionally. Stir in corn; cook an additional 30 minutes.




