In the early summer of 2004, I decided it was time to adopt a small female cat to be a friend to my Billy cat that I adopted a few years before. When I mentioned that to April, the shelter manager and Lynn, the board president and volunteer, they both suggested I consider a four month-old light calico cat that had come in as a stray. They said she was sweet.

I agreed, applied to adopt her, and went through the adoption process. I named her Becky after friends. Becky was spayed and when I took her home, she and Billy became instant friends.

Billy had always been a naïve little boy who was afraid of moths and all creeping things. A few days after Becky came to live with us, a hapless moth flew in front of her. She immediately tried to catch the moth, as Billy sat and watched. I believe I saw an actual moment of truth happen in his head and I can almost testify that he thought, "I had no idea we could do that." (Actually, I saved the moth from Becky, but the lesson had been taught.) Thankfully, neither Becky nor Billy had any interest in my cockatiels.

My dog, Katey, loved both of her cat friends and we had a peaceful animal kingdom until we all grieved when Katey went to heaven in April of 2005.

Billy and Becky were quite the pair. They shared a water bowl and a dry cat food bowl, but the canned cat food had to be in separate bowls so they could spend a long time playing the game known as "let's switch bowls."

A couple of years after Becky came to live with us, she needed to have surgery for some scar tissue from her spay surgery. My sweet little Becky had a habit of becoming a wild tiger when she had to take pills, so I decided to crush the pain pill and put it in her food before I went to church. I was anxious to get home to see if Becky had fallen for this trick.

As I went into the house, I saw that Becky was in the middle of the floor, licking her surgical wound, the food bowl was empty, and Billy was fast asleep on the couch. He slept for hours.

In 2012 when I brought my Wally dog home from the shelter, Becky and Billy terrorized him to the point that up to the time he died of cancer last year, he was absolutely terrified of any size cat or kitten. Still, they worked out a compromise and allowed Wally to live in their house.

Becky and I grieved together when Billy went to heaven in 2012. Any time I would cry about anything, Becky was so very good about cuddling on my lap and gently touching my eyes. She was also quite judgmental about my singing and expressed her feelings by gently placing a paw on my lips. Oh yes, she did. Life went on, as it always does.

Time began to catch up with Becky and when I blinked, I realized she was 17 years old. Our evenings consisted of Becky watching me until I sat on the couch and then she jumped up in my lap where she stayed for hours. She loved soft napping spots in front of windows, canned cat food, and me. I deeply loved her.

During the summer and early fall of this year, I knew Becky was weakening. She lost weight and limped from arthritis. Medication helped and she was still able to jump onto my lap.

This past Sunday night, I knew something was different. Becky had slept most of the afternoon, but when I got home from church, she chose the bed rather than my lap.

When I went into the bedroom, I knew she was in distress. She had suffered either a stroke or heart attack and all I could do was hold her and pray that her death would be as painless and as quick as possible. I hope it was.

I am grateful for the many years I had with her. I hope so very badly that I provided her a good life. I miss her. It is still hard to believe her heart failed her because it never failed me.

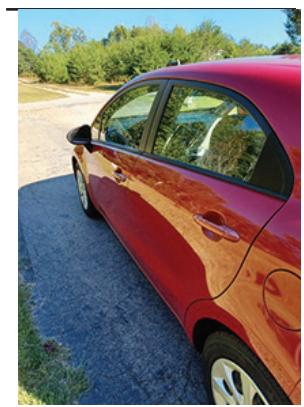

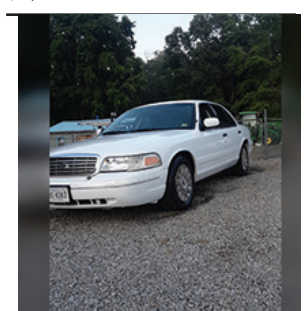

The major studios and streaming platforms are so desperate for tried-and-true material that they've picked the bones of past successes to try to attract movie and TV watchers.

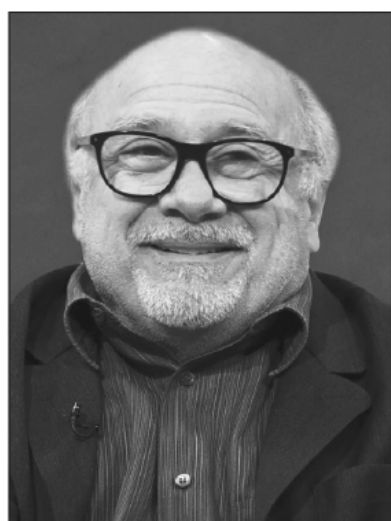

Annual loose-leaf vacuum collection underway

Public Works Department crews have started loose-leaf vacuum collection from residential neighborhoods. City residents can rake or blow leaves to the curb or property line for pickup by the vacuum machines through Jan. 31.

Loose leaves are collected on the same day as scheduled refuse and yard waste collection, as the volume of leaves allows.

The department asks residents to assist in the leaf collection by taking the following steps:

- Rake loose leaves in a pile to the curb or in front of the property line. Make sure the leaf pile is within reach of the vacuum machine from the paved roadway (no more than four feet).

- Rake loose leaves any time before your collection day. Do not rake leaves on the scheduled collection day and expect to have them collected that day. The crew may have already passed through the area.

- Do not mix loose leaves with sticks, limbs, brush, bottles, rocks, or other solid objects.

- Park vehicles away from the leaf pile. The city's vacuum equipment uses truck-and-trailer combinations, requiring ample space to reach the leaf pile.

- Do not block storm gutters or ditches.

- Do not place the leaf pile behind poles, mailboxes, fire hydrants, and guardrails.

- Do not place the leaf pile in ditches below grade level.

- Avoid, if possible, placing loose leaves on top of water meters, gas meters, manholes, or sidewalks.

In addition to raking loose leaves to the curb, residents may bag the leaves. Biodegradable bags are available at no charge from the Public Works Administrative Office at 998 South Boston Road. Bagged leaves should be placed out, no sooner than the evening before your collection day.

Many factors affect the ability of leaf collection crews to stay on a weekly schedule. Those factors include the timing of the first significant frost, duration of leaf fall (gradual or all at once), amount of rainfall during leaf season, early snowfalls, and equipment breakdowns.

If your leaves were missed or you need to know if your area is behind schedule, call the Public Works Department at 799-5245 on Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.

During peak leaf fall, crews from Street Maintenance, Grounds Maintenance, and the Adult Detention Center are utilized. An average of 2,500 tons of leaves is collected and disposed of at the compost/mulch facility during the leaf collection season.

Many of the County's costs – such as EMS, Public Safety, the Pittsylvania County Sheriff, as well as permit fees – were planned costs. However, many billed costs were unplanned and occurred due to insufficient performance from Purpose Driven Events' vendors. Beginning the second morning of the Blue Ridge Rock Festival, Purpose Driven Events requested that Pittsylvania County take over all operations outside of the festival grounds, including transportation services, sanitation, and traffic control. The County remained in control for the remainder of the festival.

Not including meals taxes, the final invoice sent to Purpose Driven Events was \$337,592.29 and included invoices on behalf of several organizations that provided assistance at the County's request, such as FCS Inc., Danville Public Schools, Danville Police Department, Danville Public Works and Pittsylvania County Schools. Some of these payments were directly tied to employee pay, while others paid for services and equipment. Other employees working the event were not personally compensated, but the County did bill for these individuals' efforts that occurred solely to the promoter's benefit. The Sheriff, County Administrator, County Attorney, Deputy County Administrator and Community Development Director all provided services to Purpose Driven Events during the Festival weekend but did not personally benefit from their work. For each of these organizations, the goal was simply to ensure all costs were covered and that our local taxpayers incurred no event-related expense. These payments are due to the county by October 28.

Delays at Convenience Centers Result of Medical Absences Solid Waste Delays - Medical Absences

Pittsylvania County Public Works would like to apologize for delays in emptying the receptacles at our convenience centers. Medical absences continue to plague our already short-staffed fleet of drivers. Fully staffed, we would have 7 drivers, all of whom could run different routes to either empty our compactors or replace full boxes with empty ones. In addition, we have a Fleet Foreman who is capable of driving routes when necessary and assisting with overflow.

Due to a variety of medical absences, we only have 5 drivers available at this time, and as a result of several other open positions within the solid waste department, our Fleet Foreman is handling landfill operational duties. All of our drivers are working overtime to maintain our convenience centers as best we can under the circumstances.

Due to nationwide staffing difficulties, companies that normally provide short-term help when we are short-staffed have been unable to help. We understand the inconvenience that this can cause to our citizens, and we are actively working to remedy the situation. In the interim, we ask for your patience during this time. If you arrive at a convenience center and find that every box and receptacle is full, please consider coming back later or driving to another site.

Slow Cooker Chili



INGREDIENTS

- 1 Tbsp olive oil
- 2 lbs lean ground beef
- 1 large yellow onion, finely chopped
- 3 cloves garlic, finely minced
- 2 (14.5 oz) cans diced tomatoes with green chilies*
- 3 (8 oz) cans tomato sauce
- 1/2 cup beef broth
- 2 Tbsp chili powder
- 2 1/2 tsp ground cumin
- 2 tsp paprika
- 2 tsp unsweetened cocoa powder
- 1 tsp granulated sugar
- 1/2 tsp ground coriander
- Salt and freshly ground black pepper
- 1 (15 oz) can dark red kidney beans, drained and rinsed
- 1 (15 oz) can light red kidney beans, drained and rinsed
- Shredded cheddar cheese, for serving

DIRECTIONS

Heat olive oil in a large and deep non-stick skillet over medium-high heat.

Add onion and saute 3 minutes, then add garlic and saute 30 seconds longer. Pour onions into a 6 or 7 quart slow cooker.

Return skillet to medium-high eat, add beef and cook stirring occasionally until beef has browned.

Drain most of fat from beef, leaving about 2 Tbsp in with beef (this is optional, I think it adds flavor but you can drain it all if you'd prefer). Pour browned beef into slow cooker.

Stir in diced tomatoes, tomato sauce, beef broth, chili powder, cumin, paprika, cocoa powder, sugar, coriander and season mixture with salt and pepper to taste.

Cover with lid and cook on low heat for 5 - 6 hours.

Stir in dark and light red kidney beans and allow to heat through, about 2 minutes. Serve warm with desired toppings.

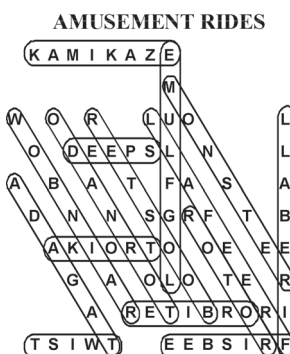
