It is especially harmful to children. If lead gets into a child's body, it can cause a lower IQ, hearing loss, growth problems, behavioral problems and brain & nervous system damage.

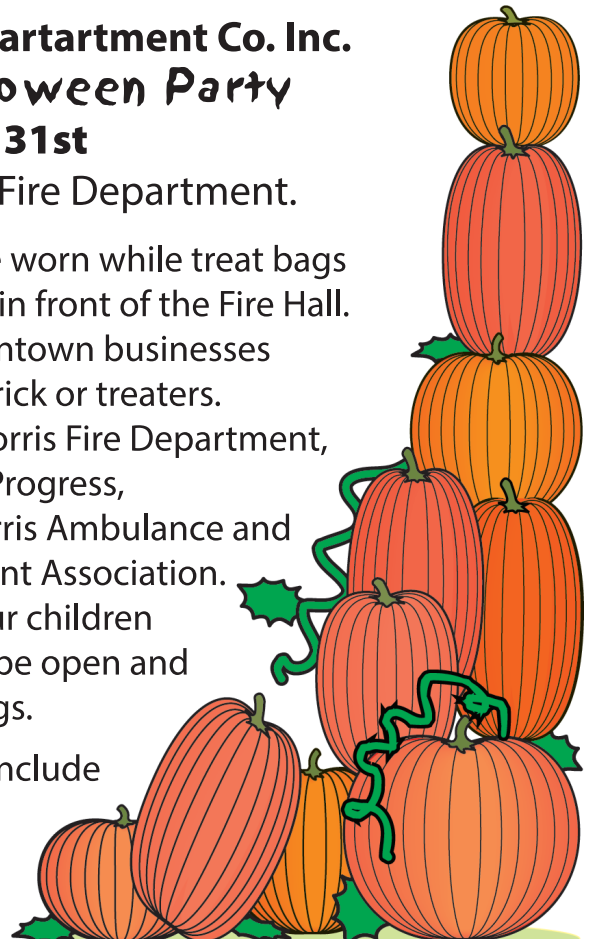
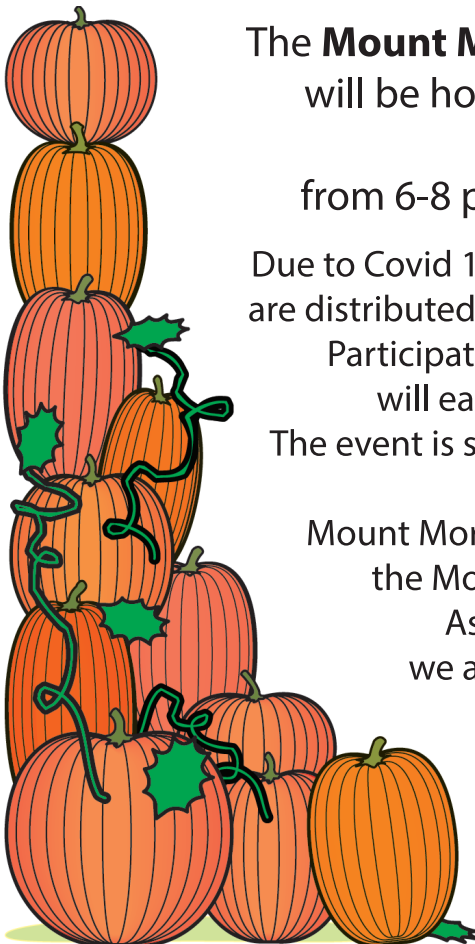
Due to Covid 19, masks and gloves will be worn while treat bags are distributed. We will be set up outside in front of the Fire Hall.

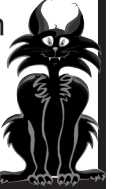

SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

I am amazed with the absence of any articles from the historians in Livingston County in the "Speak Out" section during the year 2021.

This is the 200th Anniversary of our beautiful Livingston County. I wish to congratulate all the hard-working people who have been involved in so many activities during 2021 to commemorate our county's bicentennial.

We have a wonderful platform in the "Speakout" section each week and I believe our county's history should be also shared here. We live in one of the most beautiful areas in the United States of America.

While other parts of our wonderful country are suffering from drought, forest fires, hurricanes, tornados, and massive outbreaks of COVID-19, we have an area with abundant rainfall, beautiful, lush forests and parks, very few severe storms and a COVID-19 which is relatively under control. Every township in our beautiful county has its own unique and colorful history which is just seeking to be discovered.

On Friday, February 23, 1821, Livingston County, New York, was formed from portions of Ontario and Genesee Counties. Our county was named in honor of Chancellor Robert R. Livingston, who helped draft the Declaration of Independence and negotiated the Louisiana Purchase.

The twelve original towns were Avon, Caledonia, Conesus, Geneseo, Groveland, Leicester, Lima, Livonia, Mount Morris, Sparta, Springwater and York. Part of North Dansville was annexed from Steuben County in 1822 and became a separate town when Sparta was divided in 1846. At the same time, the Town of West Sparta was also formed from Sparta. The towns of Nunda and Portage were annexed from Allegany County in 1846, as well as Ossian in 1857, for a total of seventeen townships.

A Board of Supervisors has governed the county since its inception. Several communities competed for the honor of becoming the county seat, but the distinction was bestowed upon Geneseo, the principal village and center of commerce. The Wadsworth family donated a suitable lot for the county buildings, beautifully situated at the north end of the village. The original brick courthouse faced Main Street; the jail of wood construction was built directly to the west, and a one-story cobblestone building for the County Clerk's office was built east of the courthouse.

Until construction was completed in 1823, court was held in the upper story of the district school on Center Street (east of the present-day Livingston County Museum) and prisoners were housed in Canandaigua. In 1829 the county opened a poorhouse farm just outside the village.

The Livingston County Courthouse was expanded in 1886, partially demolished and enhanced with a new facade in 1898. The building underwent another major expansion in 1957. The courthouse was completely renovated in the early 1990s to accommodate the New York State court system. Many county departments were moved to a newly built Livingston County Government Center adjacent to the courthouse.

Several other county departments are located at different locations, including the Livingston County Campus on Murray Hill in Mount Morris, formerly the New York State Tuberculosis Hospital Campus.

Lord willing, I hope to share brief histories of each township over the next few weeks as we conclude the year 2021 and our bicentennial celebration. I would encourage all the county historians to share their input.

Protect Your Children from the Hazards of Lead

• • • *National Lead Poisoning Prevention Week is October 24th-30th* • • •

If you have children, you should know that lead poisoning is the number one preventable environmental health threat in the United States. Although it is true that children living in older homes are at greatest risk, lead can also be found in your children's toys, which makes lead poisoning a danger to every family. Lead poisoning from paint chips is the most talked about threat, but lead can also get in the body by breathing or swallowing dust or soil and can sometimes be found in drinking water.

The only way to know if your child has lead poisoning is to get a blood lead test. In New York State, all children must be tested for lead exposure at or around age one and again at age two.

The Livingston County Department of Health reminds parents that most children with lead poisoning do not look or feel sick. Children with both low and high levels of lead in their bodies can suffer from brain and nervous system damage, behavioral and learning problems, slowed growth, hearing loss and headaches. The first step in preventing lead poisoning is to keep your home in good repair. Consider the following:

- If you live in a house or apartment built before 1978, it's important to properly repair any peeling paint properly. When paint flakes are disturbed, the home can become filled with lead-containing dust.
- Call the local health department before you do any remodeling to find out how to paint and repair safely.
- Frequently wash children's hands, toys, and pacifiers as an effective way to keep lead from accumulating.
- Clean floors often with a damp mop, and use damp cloths to clean windowsills.

For the latest toy recalls from lead contents, please click here to be sure your child does not have these toys. For more information on how to protect children from lead exposure, please call the Livingston County Department of Health at 243-7299.

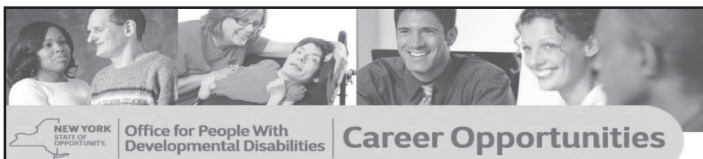
