His stories have won and been nominated for the Shirley Jackson Award and the Bram Stoker Award. You can find his previously published work in venues such as *Nightmare*, *Lightspeed*, *The Magazine of Fantasy & Science Fiction*, *Weird Tales*, *Vastarien*, *Best New Horror*, and *Year's Best Weird Fiction*. He's published three short story collections – *Forever, in Pieces*, *The Dissolution of Small Worlds*, and the forthcoming *We are Happy, We are Doomed* – as well as numerous chapbooks. 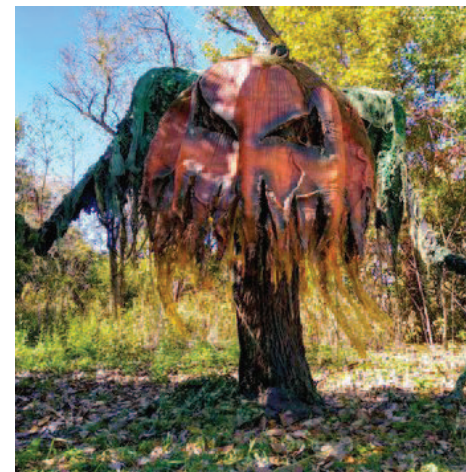
