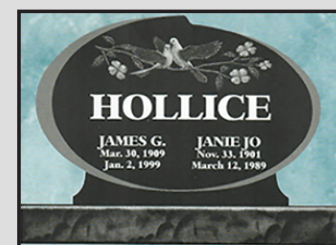

How Cemeteries Work

Here are eight of the most common questions families have about cemetery grounds.

If you've never spent much time around cemeteries, you might not know much about the ins and outs of how they work. Here are some of the most frequently asked questions.

What's the difference between a cemetery and a memorial park? A memorial park is intended to look like a tranquil park, with plenty of trees, gardens, and waterways. Grave markers are typically flat and flush to the ground, and you won't see them from the road. This offers a uniform appearance and takes some emphasis off the somber purpose of the land.

A cemetery is the more traditional burial ground that's been around for centuries. A wide variety of grave markers may be used, in all shapes and sizes. Some will be in the classic headstone shape; some will be larger monuments or statues.

Am I able to choose exactly where in the cemetery the plot I buy will be located? Not always. Of course, you'll be able to see what areas in the cemetery are already occupied by graves, and you'll know they're not available. But even areas that appear unoccupied might be unavailable, because they may have already been reserved by others who have done their own pre-planning. If it's important to you that you be buried in a specific place, ask to see what is available and confirm that if you choose a particular plot, the burial will take place in that exact spot.

Will geographical features make a difference in the stability and accessibility of a gravesite? A hilly cemetery can be very beautiful, but older or disabled family members may find

it hard to visit a loved one's grave on a hillside or in a valley. A grave near a stream or river could be affected by flooding. A grave near a busy road might be more likely to get dirty. You can ask cemetery staff about any geographical concerns regarding the particular gravesite you're looking at.

Can I purchase a large family area where multiple family members will be buried? Some cemeteries have the space to offer this as an option. In fact, it may be a way for you to save money, as a discount is sometimes given when multiple plots are purchased together. That can make a family area a very attractive option, but it's not always the right choice even if it's cost effective. Some family members may get married or remarried and prefer to be buried next to their partner, who may not have a place in the family area. Children may wish to have a parent buried closer to where they live. But if your family has strong ties to your hometown or to a particular cemetery, this might be a good option for you.

Can I plant a tree, bush, or flowers at my loved one's gravesite? The cemetery you choose might have guidelines or restrictions about what, if anything, can be planted at a gravesite, so be sure to check. It's likely that you'll be responsible for maintaining anything you plant. That could mean watering as well as keeping it tidy by pruning, removing dead flowers, and so on. If you can't be at the cemetery frequently to take care of flowers, you might want to choose a hardy variety that won't require much care once it's established. You should also choose something that won't quickly spread or become invasive. If the cemetery's guidelines allow you to plant a tree, think carefully about placement and consider how large the tree will eventually grow. Just as tree roots can crack and buckle a sidewalk, they can disturb a headstone or grave. Some cemeteries that forbid gravesite plantings by families will instead allow you to purchase a shrub or tree in a separate area of the cemetery in remembrance of your loved one.

What is a "perpetual care" fee? At many cemeteries, this is an annual fee or a one-time charge. It pays for the maintenance and upkeep of the cemetery: mowing, litter removal, road maintenance, etc. Note that perpetual care may fund general cemetery maintenance but leave individual gravesite tending up to the family. Be sure you ask exactly what any perpetual care fees will pay for.

Is a "green cemetery" the right choice for me? If you try to live an eco-friendly life, you may want to be buried at a green cemetery, where only natural and biodegradable materials can be buried with a body. This generally means the body can't be embalmed using the standard embalming fluid, and any casket used must be made from entirely biodegradable materials. This sort of casket might not be among the standard choices at some funeral homes, but if not, you should be able to purchase an all-natural casket or shroud from a third party.

Some traditional cemeteries offer a green burial section. It's a good idea to do some advance planning if you're interested in burial in a green cemetery.

Can I be buried on land I own? If you're thinking you might want to be buried in your own backyard, the answer is: Consult your local government. There are a few states in which this is prohibited, and other states have rules and regulations around home burial. If it is allowed, you'll probably need to obtain a permit. ■

How Funeral Directors Help Families

Eight important tasks that the professionals will help you with.

A funeral director can be one of your most important allies in the days and weeks after a loved one's death. Whether the funeral was prepared for years in advance, or the death was unexpected and you're making all the arrangements in a grief-stricken hurry, there's so much you can lean on a funeral director for. Here are some of the primary things a funeral director helps a family with.

Transporting the body. When a death has occurred, the funeral home is one of the first phone calls you'll make. If your loved one died in the hospital, at home, or somewhere else, the funeral director will arrange for their body to be transported to the funeral home, where preparations for services will begin. Even when a death occurs far from home, in another state or country, the funeral director is the one who takes point on getting your loved one's body home.

Making funeral arrangements. When you contact the funeral home right after the death, you can also schedule a time to get together and make the arrangements for services and body disposition (burial, cremation, etc.). You'll talk about when and where services will take place, what type of visitation you want (if any), whether graveside services will be private, whether military honors will be presented, and so on. The funeral home is typically available as a location for services, but the funeral director can also help make arrangements for services at a church or other location.

Managing the services. Once all the arrangements are made, the fu-

neral home also does the work to make sure those services you planned together run smoothly. They'll secure the locations and make sure all the timing works out. They'll find you the right musicians and funeral officiant if you wish. They'll arrange the displays of photo boards and mementos of your loved one that you've chosen to include. They'll have service programs printed and distribute them to guests. They'll manage the many flower arrangements that may be delivered. They can make arrangements for catering if you wish to have that as a part of services.

You've most likely seen funeral directors at funerals you've attended in the past—they may not be front and center, but they're very busy helping people get where they need to be, answering questions, and coordinating every last detail.

Writing and submitting an obituary for publication. You may choose

to write your loved one's obituary—or they may have written their own, prior to their death—but if you prefer to leave that job to someone else, the funeral home can take care of writing the obituary based on information you provide. They can also submit the obituary, regardless of who wrote it, to your local newspapers as well as to papers in other areas where the deceased lived in the past.

Setting up a memorial fund. If you're planning on requesting memorial donations to the family to cover funeral expenses, or you'd like to set up any other sort of memorial fund in your loved one's name, the funeral director can make it happen. They can also collect donations at the funeral home—in person at services as well as those mailed in by friends who couldn't be there—and distribute them as you direct.

Tying up loose ends. You'll probably need multiple copies of the death

certificate in the days and weeks after the death. You'll often use them as proof of the death as you settled your loved one's affairs. The funeral director can do what needs to be done to secure the death certificate for you. The funeral director will also notify the Social Security Administration of your loved one's death.

Helping you pre-plan your own (or a loved one's) funeral. If you've gone through setting up a funeral at the last minute, you may feel strongly about making sure things are better planned for the next one. A funeral director can work with you in advance to plan your own funeral or that of a loved one. Everything from locations to body disposition to fine details can be planned in advance, and you can even pay in advance to spare loved ones from financial headaches after death. If a family member is entering a nursing home and needs to do a spend-down of assets to qualify for aid, a funeral director can also help you with pre-paying for funeral services as part of the spend-down.

Connecting you with advice and support. A funeral director can point you toward local or online grief support resources to help you cope as you move past the funeral. And if there's something else you need in the wake of your loved one's death, and you're not sure where to turn, you might try asking the funeral director. They tend to have great connections and may be able to help you in ways you didn't expect. ■

What Do Different Flowers Symbolize?

Sending flowers to a funeral is a lovely, classic way to express your sympathy to the bereaved. But did you know you can send a very specific message with your choice of flowers? Certain flowers have traditional meanings, and they can communicate feelings like love or strength in addition to your condolences.

Lilies are among the most commonly chosen flowers to express sympathy. They go hand in hand with funerals, because they represent the soul restored to innocence and purity after death. If you send white lilies to a funeral, you're offering your wishes that the deceased is at peaceful rest. Other colors of lilies carry additional meanings. Yellow lilies may not be as appropriate for a funeral, symbolizing happiness and lightheartedness. But pink lilies can be a good alternative to white in some situations, evoking love, compassion, and femininity.

Carnations are also frequently included in sympathy arrangements. Pink carnations are especially appropriate, because they represent remembrance. White carnations symbolize pure love and innocence, while red carnations stand for admiration.

Roses are well known for symbolizing love, especially red roses. But they're just as appropriate in a funeral arrangement as in a Valentine's bouquet. When sent in sympathy, red roses represent respect, love, and courage. Other colors of roses are also beautiful choices in sympathy arrangements. Deep crimson roses stand for grief. A single rose indicates enduring love, while yellow roses, symbolizing friendship, are a perfect choice when remembering a dear friend.

Gladioli are both visually striking and deeply meaningful when used in a sympathy arrangement. The gladiolus represents strength of character

and moral integrity. The tall, slender flower takes its name from the Latin for "sword," and because of that fact and its symbolic meaning, it's an ideal choice when sending flowers in memory of a soldier.

Orchids bring delicate beauty to a grouping of funeral arrangements, and when sent in sympathy, they symbolize everlasting love. They generally are not placed in a bouquet but rather sent as potted plants. Only white and pink orchids are traditionally considered appropriate for funerals.

Chrysanthemums commonly represent truth in U.S. culture, but elsewhere around the world, they're a strong symbol of death and grief. Particularly in parts of Asia and Europe, mums can be almost exclusively associated with death and are common choices for funeral flowers. They're appropriate for funeral flowers in the U.S. too, keeping in mind their international symbolism.

Forget-Me-Nots say it all with their name. This delicate flower, of-

ten found in shades of blue, symbolizes everlasting remembrance. Since they're fairly small and unassuming, they work best as part of a larger sympathy bouquet.

Tulips are cheerful harbingers of spring, so when they're included in a funeral arrangement, they symbolize renewal and rebirth. Red tulips are a particularly good choice, symbolizing perfect love. You may want to take care before choosing other tulip colors for a sympathy arrangement: Purple tulips symbolize royalty, while yellow tulips evoke cheerfulness and white tulips represent forgiveness.

Daffodils stand alongside tulips as early spring bloomers, representing renewal and a fresh start. It's worth keeping in mind that traditionally, a bouquet of daffodils is considered positive, while a single daffodil is said to bring misfortune.

Hyacinth, another spring flower, takes its name from a Greek myth. Hyacinthos, a young boy admired by the gods Zephyr and Apollo, was

accidentally killed by Zephyr while Apollo was teaching him to throw the discus. As his blood spilled on the ground, a flower grew from it, and Apollo named the flower for the boy. Thanks to the myth, the hyacinth now symbolizes deep sorrow over a death.

Violets are associated with youth and innocence. As funeral flowers, this translates to a life taken too soon, so they're a meaningful choice when offering condolences on the death of a young person. Because violets are small with short stems, they might be sent as a potted plant rather than in a bouquet.

Hydrangea is another option that's more likely to be sent as a potted plant. It symbolizes heartfelt sincerity, which is a meaningful emotion to convey alongside sympathy.

Rosemary may sound like an unusual choice in a funeral arrangement, since it's an herb rather than a flower, but it has symbolized remembrance for hundreds of years. In Shakespeare's "Hamlet," Ophelia says, "There's rosemary, that's for remembrance." It can be worked into a sympathy bouquet as part of the greenery, or given as a potted plant.

Statice is a popular garden flower that remains beautiful even after it's been dried. Because of its long-lasting beauty, it has come to represent remembrance. This makes it a meaningful choice to include in a sympathy arrangement.

Peonies have a number of meanings, but two make them especially perfect for a sympathy arrangement: healing and compassion. Along with its showy beauty, this makes it a good choice for funeral flowers. ■

Why Grief Should Be Witnessed

An excerpt from the new book “Finding Meaning” by David Kessler

David Kessler was introduced to death young: As a 13-year-old boy, he witnessed a mass shooting in New Orleans just days before his mother succumbed to a long illness. His grief pointed him toward what would become his life's work.

In the decades that followed his mother's death, Kessler immersed himself in the fields of palliative care, bioethics, and trauma response. He worked with countless grievers to help them through their pain, and he coauthored five bestselling books sharing what he learned along the way, including the landmark On Grief and Grieving with Dr. Elisabeth Kubler-Ross, who formulated the well-known “five stages of grief.”

*Kessler's latest book may be destined to become his best known. **Finding Meaning: The Sixth Stage of Grief** goes beyond the familiar idea of “acceptance” of a death to focus on how finding meaning in a loved one's loss is what most deeply helps people heal. In exploring how this works, Kessler opens up for the first time about the loss of his own son to an overdose, and how even as a grief professional, he feared for a time his suffering might never end.*

In this excerpt from Finding Meaning, Kessler considers the power of funerals to help people process the meaning of a death.

Funerals and memorials are important. Something profound happens when others see and hear and acknowledge our grief. Mourning is the outward expression of our grief. Conversely, something goes wrong when it remains unseen. That's why I believe that when someone decides not to have a funeral, they're missing out. A funeral is the time for people to gather as a family, as a community, to witness grief together. The funeral is the most well-known ritual for death, a ceremony that creates meaning out of our loved one's experience of life, and our own experience of loss.

At a memorial, people talk about what the dead person meant to them. This may be in the form of a somber eulogy or a funny story. It can be accompanied by laughter or by tears—or both. Whatever form it takes, telling the story of the loved one's life helps the mourners to accept the reality of death. It also helps us through the process of grieving. We need to hear the story from others, which helps us see things from a different perspective, and we need to tell it ourselves.

We think we can spare our children pain by not exposing them to the reality of death. But the opposite is true. Our children, just like us, are in pain when they lose someone they love, and it will not help them to have their pain glossed

over. Going to a funeral will help because they, too, need to have their pain witnessed, to feel it reflected in the emotions of those around them.

Ellen was a child of six who was very attached to her great-aunt, Ruth. They were inseparable, and when Ruth contracted brain cancer, she went to a nursing home to be cared for. Ellen missed her terribly and kept asking where her aunt was. Her mother said, “She's away resting.”

Ellen kept asking when she would come back home, and her mother said, “Pretty soon.”

A few weeks later, her mother told her that Ruth had died. Ellen climbed into her mother's lap and cried, but after a few minutes, her mother walked away, went upstairs to her bedroom, and shut the door. On the day of the funeral, Ellen's mother and father left the house to bury Ruth. Ellen begged to go along, but they said that the funeral was for grown-ups.

In my lectures I ask whether Ellen should have been allowed to go to the funeral. Both small and large groups always answer with a resounding yes!

I follow up with, “How many of you have issues or wounds because you were allowed to go to a funeral?” Occasionally I get a hand or two. Then I ask, “How many of you have issues, wounds, or trauma because you weren't allowed

to go to the funeral?” About 15 percent of the hands in the room will go up. We think skipping the pain helps our children, but the opposite is true. Our children, just like us, need their pain witnessed, and a funeral is important to them.

When our loved ones die, it is the moment when grief is most palpable and witnessing is most needed. There is no completion of grief or closure, but that last ceremony is a bookend that acknowledges that the final chapter of life has ended. There seems to be an ever-growing inconclusiveness when the life of a loved one is not marked by an event.

We need a sense of community when we are in mourning because we were not meant to be islands of grief. The reality is that we heal as a tribe. There is no greater gift you can give someone in grief than to ask them about their loved one, and then truly listen. When we see our sorrow in the eyes of another, we know our grief has meaning.

We get a glimpse, maybe for the first time since the loss, that we will survive, and a future is possible.
