Students And Instructors In The Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program At Wallace State Community College

Wallace State Sonography Students Donate Funds **To Support Families Of Preemies**

In their future careers, students in the Diagnostic Medical Sonography program at Wallace State Community College will undoubtedly one day assist an obstetric patient dealing with a premature birth. Through the exams they will give as sonographers, they may discover conditions that put an unborn child at risk of an early delivery. "In a lot cases you'll be the first one to discover a family's need," Katie Bowers, the volunteer chapter coordinator for the Huntsville chapter of Footprints, told the sonography students. "What you'll do is so important," she added. "You'll see parents at the scariest time of their life, the happiest time in their life, the saddest time in their life, but just keep in mind that what you guys do is so important."

After hearing about the work of Footprints, the students donated over \$1600 to the program, which has chapters in Huntsville, Birmingham, Montgomery, Mobile, and Columbia, Tenn. Working with hospitals in those areas, the program provides families with gift bags, which include items they can use while in the hospital with their child. Bowers said her Footprints chapter puts together 75 bags each month for the hospitals in the Huntsville area. The bags "kind of say we're here for you," she said. "We also give families gas cards, food cards, we pay for hotel stays, we pay for burial expenses when that's needed. I've gone with moms to pick out their babies' headstones. We are there for whatever they need us."



Relay For Life Kicking Off 2016 Season

The American Cancer Society's Relay For Life of Cullman County will kick off the 2016 fundraising season on Thursday, Jan. 21, in the Fellowship Hall of First Baptist Church of Cullman. The Kickoff Celebration will be held at 5:30 p.m., and will include award presentations for 2015 teams and sponsors, information about the upcoming year and a special message from an ACS Hero of Hope.


"We just completed our holiday celebrations and many of us celebrated without a loved one who was taken from us too soon by cancer," said Helen Allen, a 22-year volunteer with the event. "But we were also blessed to have with us many who have survived thanks to the efforts of the American Cancer Society in research, prevention, education and early detection.

"That is why support of Relay For Life of Cullman County is so important," she added. "The American Cancer Society has made great strides for more than 65 years in cancer research. Through research we know we can prevent some types of cancer. We know we can reduce our risks by making healthy choices. We know how important early detection is to increase survival rates and to reduce or in some cases eliminate the need for treatment.

"But more research is still needed to find cures and improve treatments," Allen said. "Without that research, more people will be in need for not only medical treatments, but social services since cancer affects more than their body. It affects their home, their jobs, their finances, everything.

"I don't know if I'll live to see the day that cancer is cured, but I have hope that my grandchildren and greatgrandchildren will," Allen said.

The volunteer Relay For Life of Cullman County committee is hoping to have at least 50 teams collect more than \$150,000 for the American Cancer Society in 2016. More than 20 teams have signed up so far and more than \$13,000 has been raised to date. Teams can be organized by anyone and are often made up of family members, coworkers, churches, schools and other groups and organizations. Teams are asked to raise at least \$100 for each person registered on their team. Though groups are encouraged to celebrate their achievements by setting up a tent site at the May 6 event at the Cullman County Fairgrounds, they are not required to do so.







Contrary to prior assertions, cholesterol-lowering statin drugs most likely do not cause short-term memory loss, according to a study of nearly one million patients. Limited previous studies and some statin-drug takers have anecdotally reported memory lapses after taking popular lipid-lowering drugs (LLDs) called statins, and Brian L. Strom, chancellor of Rutgers Biomedical and Health Sciences (RBHS) and lead study author. The result has been that some people have stopped taking their statins, inappropriately. About 610,000 people die of heart disease in the United States every year-that's 1 in every 4 deaths, according to the Centers for Disease Control. One in four Americans over age 45 takes statins, drugs that inhibit a liver enzyme that controls the synthesis of cholesterol and lowers LDL, commonly known as "bad cholesterol." Statins have proven very effective at lowering high cholesterol, one of the major risk factors for heart disease, and preventing heart attacks and deaths. If a statin drug alone is not effectively reducing cholesterol numbers or a patient doesn't tolerate the drug, nonstatins are often prescribed, Strom said. The study, published in The Journal of the American Medical Association-Internal Medicine, compared new users of statins with people not taking statins. New statin users also were compared to a second control group-patients taking nonstatin LLDs - which had not been done before. More patients taking statins indeed reported memory loss in the 30 - day period after first taking the drugs, compared to non-users, the study found. The same, however, was found with the nonstatin LLDs.


