# New Super One Foods store to include CRMC clinic and more



A groundbreaking and progress celebration for Crosby's new Super One Foods, Super One Liquor, and CRMC Clinic was held on Oct 18. The development is at the intersection of Highway 210 and Country Road 31 east of Crosby and is planned for opening the Spring of 2022.

There will be more than groceries at the new Super One Foods store set to open in Crosby next spring.

Cuyuna Regional Medical Center is expanding to improve access to healthcare by opening a clinic, pharmacy, and wellness education center in the new Super One.

The new CRMC services will be located within and adjacent to the 38,000-squarefoot Super One grocery store being constructed at the intersection of Highway 210 and County Road 31. Plans are for the clinic and pharmacy to be open extended hours Monday through Saturday for easy access to services.

The clinic will serve patients with non-emergency medical needs including ailments such as upper respiratory infection, strep, ear complaints, mild asthma, flu, and urinary tract infection as

Out More well as minor injuries such as cuts, burns and sprains. Immunizations and sports physicals will also be available. Care will be provided by a family physician and other health care providers. Patients will be able to schedule an appointment in advance or simply walk-in for care.

"We are extremely excited to partner with Super One in opening this new clinic,"

said Kelly Chase, CRMC's **Executive Director of Primary** care. "Our goal is to deliver high quality health care that is a simpler, more accessible experience for both residents and visitors to the area."

CRMC's providers and other clinicians will be located at the 10,000 square foot space. There will be multiple exam rooms, a procedure room, laboratory for outpatient clinic care, and a waiting room. Other services immediately available at the new space will include a dietitian and health education center offering classes, seminars, and support groups.

The pharmacy will offer fast, friendly service, competitive pricing, vaccinations, and drive-through service. A pharmacist will also be available to answer medication questions. The registered dietitian will provide nutritional counseling for a

variety of health conditions.

"Customers can shop for all of their health and wellness needs under roofwhether that includes dietary needs such as fresh produce and gluten-free items, or over the counter products and prescribed medications," said Chase. "And, prescriptions can be filled while customers shop for their groceries."

The new clinic, like all CRMC satellite locations, will be connected to the MyChart electronic health record system, so all patients' vital medical information is available to any CRMC provider, no matter where they are seen, for better coordinated care.

The Super One grocery store with a full deli, bakery and liquor store is slated to open in spring 2022 and at that time the Crosby Super One building which had

# Rollover accident in downtown Aitkin | Man found dead from gunshot wound

County Sheriff's Office a man died of an apparent self-inflicted gunshot wound Thursday, Oct. 14, in Oak Lawn Township, east of Brainerd.

At approximately 7:09 p.m, Crow Wing County Sheriff's Deputies responded along with other officers to an address in Oak Lawn Township, to a report of a disturbance taking place involving shots fired.

As law enforcement arrived on scene, contact was made with an adult male subject in possession of a handgun. Law enforcement witnessed the male enter the residence and a single gunshot was heard. After

According to the Crow Wing confirming all other parties involved in the incident were safely outside the residence, an unmanned aerial vehicle (drone) was flown inside the residence and the male subject was located deceased of an apparent self-inflicted gunshot

> This incident is currently under active investigation. The de

ceased's body was transported to the Ramsey County Medical Examiner's office for autopsy.

# Minnesota DNR \$13.3 million funding proposal

The Minnesota Depart- funding proposals in response ment of Natural Resources announced \$13.3 million in

to the significant effects of this summer's drought on two of the state's critical natural resources: water and trees.

The DNR proposes \$3 million in funding for municipal, tribal, and other community water suppliers to implement proactive water conservation measures related to the built infrastructure, including finding and repairing leaks in pipes, meters, hydrants, and treatment plants, and installing water-efficient equipment.

These proven strategies can help individual cities across the state to conserve millions of gallons of water a year. The proposal also includes \$300,000 for an individual and small community well interference

Additionally, the drought has stressed well-established shade trees in communities and caused an extremely high mortality rate for tree seedlings planted in 2021. The DNR proposes \$5.5 million in funding to re-plant public and private forest lands where seedlings were irrevocably damaged by the drought and \$4.5 million in community shade tree grants. Combined, this funding will be essential to support tree health, carbon storage, habitat, water quality and other benefits of forests and shade trees.

"This year's drought was challenging on many natural resources fronts. While the DNR took necessary steps to mitigate the drought's impacts, in accordance with the Statewide Drought Plan, more needs to be done," said DNR Commissioner Sarah Strommen. "This proposal includes high-impact resiliency measures in order to conserve water and preserve our precious tree cover. This funding proposal will help protect the resources we all value and depend on for our quality of life in Minnesota."

The entire state entered the drought warning phase in mid-July of 2021. With this designation, the Minnesota DNR took a number of measures laid out in the Statewide Drought Plan, including convening the State Drought Task Force, a panel of state, federal, regional and local experts with water-related responsibilities.
