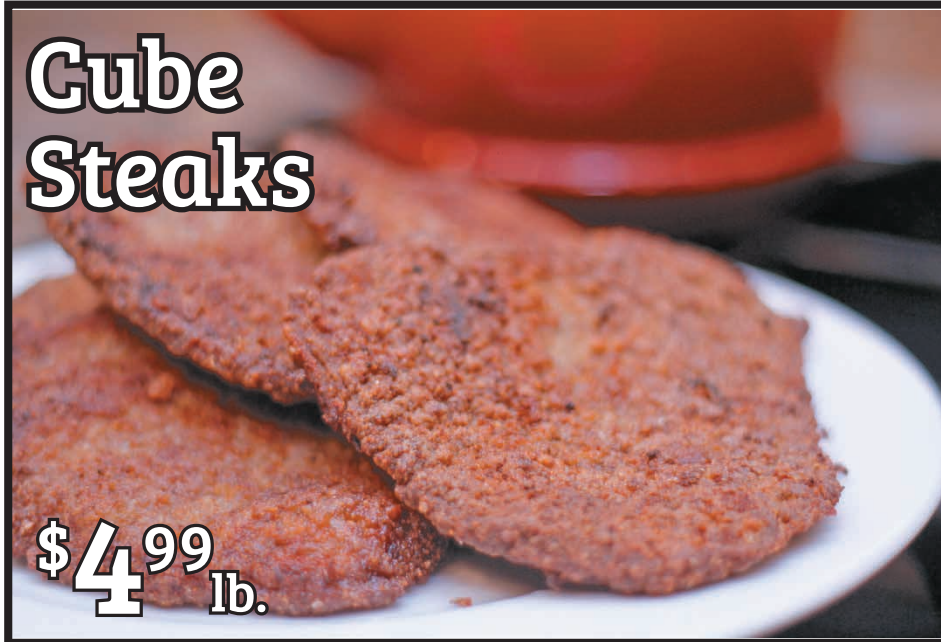

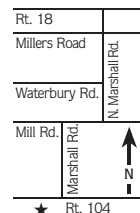

GETTING DOWN TO BUSINESS: LLC OR CORPORATION?

When going into business, deciding to form either a limited liability corporation (LLC) or a corporation depends on the nature of the business the individual is creating, taxation consequences of forming the entity, and other considerations. Both entities have significant legal advantages of protecting assets from creditors and providing an extra layer of protection against legal liability. Generally, creating and managing an LLC is easier and more flexible than creating a corporation. Regardless, there are advantages and disadvantages to each type of business structure as both protect owners from personal business liabilities or debts. One key difference is how they're owned. LLCs have one or more individual members, while corporations have shareholders, requiring more formal record-keeping and reporting requirements.
