





# SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

This week we continue our study of our beautiful Livingston County during its 200th year bicentennial.

The Town of Conesus is located on the county's east border, and is north of Dansville. The name is derived from a native word meaning "berry place". It was settled around 1795.

In 1819, Conesus was formed from parts of the towns of Groveland and Livonia as the "Town of Freeport". The name was changed to "Browersville" in March 1825 and was changed to "Conesus" a month later.

Conesus is home to the former St. Michael's Mission, a school for Catholic priests that operated from the 1930s until the 1970s. The sprawling complex on Mission Road is now owned by an evangelical Christian church from Colorado Springs.

The Conesus Amusement Hall, Kellerman Log Cabin, Payne Cobblestone House, and Sliker Cobblestone House are listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Conesus Lake is on the west border of the town and Hemlock Lake is on its east border. The east town line is the border of Ontario County. Several communities, including Sunny Shores, Excelsior Springs, and Walkleys Landing, are located on the east shore of Conesus Lake in the town. There is no housing along the shore of Hemlock Lake, because it is owned by the city of Rochester for its water supply.

New York State Route 15 is an important north-south highway which intersects the former New York State Route 255 at Conesus village. A notable person from Conesus was Daniel Shays who was an American soldier, revolutionary and farmer famous for being one of the leaders and namesake of Shays' Rebellion, a populist uprising against controversial debt collection and tax policies in Massachusetts in 1786 and 1787.

The Town of Geneseo is at the south end of the fivecounty Rochester Metropolitan Area. The English name "Geneseo" is an anglicization of the Iroquois name for the earlier Iroquois town there "Gen-nis-he-yo" which means "beautiful valley". The village of Geneseo lies within the western portion of the town.

The village and town are known today mainly as the home of the State University of New York at Geneseo. Near Geneseo was the largest Seneca village "Chenussio" which was a center of power for the Iroquois Confederacy. It was also the confederacy's "bread basket", with orchards, vineyards, and fields of maize and vegetables.

The town was established in 1789 before the formation of Livingston County. The settlement of Geneseo by the colonists began shortly after the arrival of James and William Wadsworth in 1790. The brothers came to the Genesee Valley from Connecticut as agents of their uncle, Colonel Jeremiah Wadsworth, to care for and sell the land he had purchased. The Wadsworths were participants in the negotiations of the Treaty of Big Tree between Robert Morris and the Senecas at the site of Geneseo in 1797. Geneseo was the birthplace of Eliza Emily Chappell Porter in 1807, who was a nurse, teacher, school builder, and Underground Railroad operative during the Civil War.

Geneseo was also the birthplace, in 1851, of Ferdinand Ward. The State Normal School, now State University of New York at Geneseo, opened in 1871. Lord willing, we will continue our study of our beautiful Livingston County next week.







#### **Attention Hunters - Extra DMPs**

The Wildlife Management Units (WMUs) that will be available starting November 1st will be:

1C (bowhunting only/Special Firearms with Special Permit), 3M, 3R, 3S (bowhunting only), 4J (bowhunting only) 6P, 7F, 7H, 7J, 7R, 8A, 8C (bowhunting only), 8F, 8G, 8H, 8J, 8N, 8R 9A, 9F & 9G.


Please read the following information from DEC:

- Hunters may apply for and receive up to two additional DMPs in these WMUs.
- Applicants with licenses that are exempt from paying a DMP application fee or hunters who have previously applied for DMPs this license year will not be charged any additional fees during the extended application period. Otherwise, there is a non-refundable \$10 application fee for leftover DMPs.
- Leftover DMPs are issued on a first-come / first-serve basis. DEC will continue to issue permits in these WMUs until sufficient numbers of DMPs are issued to achieve optimum management in each unit. When a unit is open, it will remain open at least until close of business on that day. At the end of the business day, any units that have reached the desired number of permits will be closed.
- Applications for leftover DMPs will not affect any preference points held by the applicant.
- DMPs are only valid for antlerless deer in the WMU for which they are issued.
