



The training will occur at Seasons' Family Support Center in Sioux Center (147 S Main) on Thursday, November 11th, 2021, from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. Parents and children will be separated for a portion of the course. Children will be grouped by age/ developmental level!



Be a Tourist in Your Backyard

Each year thousands of people visit the Iowa Great Lakes to enjoy the activities and attractions our area has to offer. Join me

each week as I become a tourist in our backyard to explore a few of the spots that make the Iowa Great Lakes special!

This week I played Music Bingo at West O Beer in West Okoboji. Every Thursday night West O offers some form of entertainment. Either music bingo or trivia. I wanted to test my skills at the music bingo. Spoiler: I have no skills! Music bingo started



promptly at 7:00pm. Everyone was given a bingo card with music song titles. Then thirty second music clips were played. In thirty seconds I needed to figure out what the song was called and if I had the title on my card. There are 3 rounds on every bingo card. Regular bingo, double bingo (2 bingos on the same card), and then wipeout. The music genre changes each week, but was modern rock when I played. This should have been a great genre for me. It was all the music I heard while in high school and college. It turns out I basically don't know the name to any song I've ever heard, even if I can sing along to every word! I didn't get a bingo. I could blame it on the card, but there's a good chance I missed a song title or two. Oops!

I thought the first round was challenging, until I discovered what the second round was. Oh my! The cards we got in the second round were filled with musician names AND movie or TV show titles. Again, music clips were played for thirty seconds. In that time I needed to figure out who sang the song or if I had heard it on a movie or TV show. I'm even worse at identifying musicians than I am song titles, but when the theme song from The Office started playing, I knew it!

Sad Saturday for Cyclones and Hawks

Iowa and Iowa State entered Saturday with their destiny in their own hands regarding trips to the Big 12 and B1G Championship Games on December 4th; however, the Hawks and Cyclones both left the day with more questions than answers after crushing road losses to mediocre teams who were playing better than their records, with Iowa falling to a 4-3 Wisconsin team 24-7, and Iowa State dropping a 38-31 game to 3-4 West Virginia

Iowa looked to be on top of the world just three weeks ago after knocking off Penn State and climbing to #2 in the rankings, but since then the Hawks have been knocked around by two unranked teams by a combined 51-14. There are two main reasons for this change of fortune, the first, and most glaring is turnover margin, as the Hawks were leading the nation at +15while bolting out to their 6-0 start but are -6 in their two B1G defeats. Iowa's defense was either scoring off turnovers or setting their offense up with great field position in those first six games, and unfortunately for Hawkeye fans, that trend has stopped the last two games. The second reason Iowa is struggling is that their offense, which was not great in the first six games, has been even worse in the two defeats, as they are now not only struggling to score, but are turning the ball over and putting the defense in tough situations. Iowa is getting beaten up at the line of scrimmage, and with a quarterback who doesn't move well, that is a recipe for disaster. Iowa did not get a first down at Wisconsin until the last drive of the first half, and could muster only 156 total yards and nine first downs against the Badgers. Even when it looked like Iowa might get back in the game, trailing 20-7 with the ball on the Wisconsin 42-yard line in the 3rd quarter, the Iowa offense couldn't get out of their own way with their predictable play-calling, handing the ball off on back-to-back plays to fullback Monte Pottebaum against a Badger defense that knew what was coming; Pottebaum was stuffed on both plays as the Hawks turned the ball over on downs and pretty much ended the game. Wisconsin would score on their next drive and put the game completely out of reach. Iowa State's game featured a horrible television crew (not worth our time to write about), some very questionable calls, and a defense that uncharacteristically could not get off the field. The Cyclones got off to a great start with Breece Hall racing 70 yards on the third play of the game, but every time ISU appeared poised to take control of the game, the Mountaineers would answer with a drive for a touchdown. WVU quarterback Jarret Doege looked like a Heisman contender and was comfortable all day, throwing for 370 yards (no QB had thrown over 230 vs ISU entering Saturday) and three touchdowns. The Mountaineers also ran the ball over and through ISU's porous tackling for another 122 yards. Questionable calls went in favor of West Virginia for most of the game, including a touchdown where the receiver didn't appear to get any feet down, a fourth down where they didn't get the play off in time that resulted in another touchdown, and then when Hall fumbled into the endzone when he appeared to cross the goal line or was down with his elbow at the goal line. While ISU fans can be frustrated with these calls, if the team played like they're capable of on defense, these calls wouldn't come into play because they would have been up by multiple scores. The Cyclones did get a very favorable offensive pass interference call in the 3rd quarter that took away a long WVU pass and resulted in a pick-six by ISU linebacker Jake Hummel two plays later. Whether it was because star linebacker Mike Rose was out with an injury or the Mountaineers had the Cyclones off-balance with new plays coming off a bye week, ISU looked lost all game on defense, especially at the cornerback positions. This showed up the most on 3rd and 4th down when WVU converted on 11 of 17 tries, three of those four were on plays where the Mountaineers needed more than 10 yards to keep drives alive, which is where ISU normally thrives. So where do the Hawkeyes and Cyclones go from here? Much of that will depend on the leadership in their locker rooms and how the teams can bounce back from adversity. Iowa is still ranked, and at 6-2 is in good shape to end the season higher than projected. ISU is now 5-3 and all of their preseason goals of heading back to Dallas for a Big 12 Championship and another NY6 Bowl are gone, which can be a huge letdown. I do think that both programs will bounce back and continue to compete, they just aren't going to finish as high as their fans were hoping for just a few short weeks ago. While I'm not even going to try and predict where these two teams finish, one thing I do know for certain Cyclone and Hawkeye fans, we can all agree and be thankful for the fact that at least we're not Husker fans again this year!
