



SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

This week we continue our study of beautiful Livingston County during its 200th year bicentennial.

The Town of Groveland is centrally located in the county south of Geneseo. Groveland was the site of the Boyd and Parker ambush on Monday, September 13, 1779, and was part of the Sullivan Expedition to defeat the Senecas who had sided with the British. The Groveland Ambuscade Park commemorates the ambush.

The town was formed in 1789 before the creation of Livingston County. The first settlement occurred in 1792 and was called "Willamsburgh". Part of Groveland was used to form parts of the Town of Conesus in 1819 and the Town Sparta in 1856.

The Groveland Shaker Village settlement was established in 1836 on a 1,700-acre farm near present-day Sonyea. The Shakers sold the property to the State of New York in 1892 due to declining membership and moved to Watervliet. The property became the Craig Colony for Epileptics at Sonyea.

In the 1980s this property became part of the Groveland Correctional Facility. The Claud No. 1 Archeological Site was added to the National Registry of Historic Places in 1975.

The Town of Leicester is located on the western border of the county and the Village of Leicester is located at the center of the town. The town was named after Leicester Phelps who was an early inhabitant. The area was a major stronghold of the Seneca people until the American Revolution, with three major villages: Little Beard's Town, Big Tree and Squakie Hill. These three settlements were a target of the Sullivan Expedition in 1779 to end raids by the Senecas on American communities.

The town was first settled around 1789 and was formed in 1802. The name, originally spelled "Lester" or "Leister", was changed in 1805 to its current form.

The town was later reduced in size by the creation of the Towns of Mount Morris in 1813 and York in 1819. The Coverdale Cobblestone House was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 2005.

The Genesee River forms the eastern border of the town and the west town line is the border of Wyoming County. The concurrent routes of US 20A and New York State Route 39 form an east-west highway across the town from Pine Tavern to the eastern town line. West of Pine Tavern, US 20A and NY 39 follow separate roadways to the western town line. New York State Route 36 is a north-south highway, intersecting US 20A and NY 39 at Leicester village.

Students who reside in the town of Leicester typically attend York Central School. Students living on the borders of Leicester could also attend the schools of bordering towns including Geneseo, Perry and Mount Morris.

A notable citizen of the town was George W. Patterson who was a United States Congressman.

Communities and locations within the town are Beards Creek, the former Seneca community of Big Tree, the Hamlet of Cuylerville, the former community of Gibsonville, Letchworth State Park located at the south town line, the former Seneca community of Little Beard's Town, the Hamlet of Pine Tavern Corners, the former Seneca community of Squakie Hill and the Hamlet of Teed Corners.

Lord willing, we will continue our study of our beautiful Livingston County next week. I know many citizens of our county have much to share and we look forward to hearing from each of you.
