Five Financial Tips for Stay-at-Home Parents

WILLS FOR WARRIORS

Every year beginning on Veteran's Day and for the month of November we do Wills for Warriors. This includes veterans, fire fighters, police officers, first responders as well as active duty military personnel and their spouses.

This is a Free! service to show our appreciation for those who risk their lives to help others.

Everyone needs a Will and a free one is a good deal. A Will provides for your property to be divided as you wish without payment for a bond and in the manner you choose. A Will is a way to make a difficult

time in life easier for your family. It makes your wishes known and saves your family money.

When you make a Will, you need to know how you want your property divided and who you want to be in charge of carrying out your decisions.

We want a first choice and a second choice for the person to be in charge of your Will. These people are known as an Executor (male) or Executrix (female). This backup plan means that hopefully we are writing a Will that will never need to be changed.

Remember that what you have now is likely not what you'll have at the time of your death. That's why we don't have to make a decision about the property or the car that you own now. We divide it according to what your property is at the time of death.

People leave their estate to the spouse and then to the children. If a husband and wife have Wills that are mirror images, known as reciprocal Wills, they accomplish the goals of leaving everything first to the spouse and then to the children. We recommend that people consider using the phrase "per stirpes". Per stirpes simply means that in the event a child dies before a parent, and if that child had children, then those children would get what their parent would have received.

All Wills should contain a residuary clause that leaves everything, no matter what it is or where it is, to the heirs so that everything owned, inclusively, whether it's a right, an object or a piece of property is included in the Will.

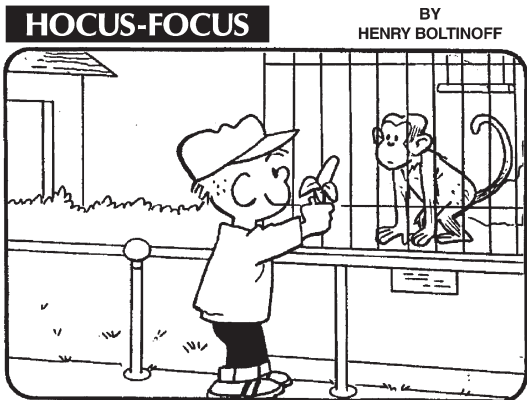

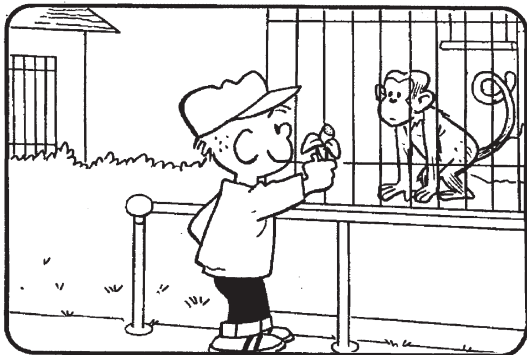

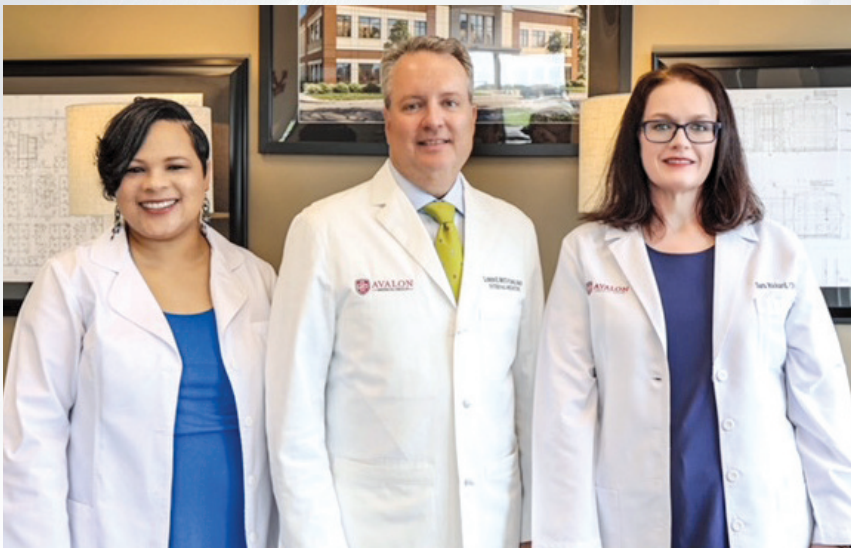

University of London and has recently done further research in the British Archives.

"I've actually lead ten study abroad trips since I started here at UNA," Bibbee said during a Faculty and Alumni Spotlight Series. "The first trip was in May 2019 and it was through a research project that I was involved in called 'The Georgian Papers Programme.' Students had an opportunity to visit various museums to spend some time with the archivist and researchers at Windsor Castle, working through an 18th century collection that's now becoming a database."

"We had a chance to go in the middle of Windsor Castle, to the Round Tower, and to an ancient archive that contains documents that go clear back to the middle ages," Bibbee continued.

"We saw George III's letter where he first confirmed that he was going to lose the American Revolutionary War.

"It's not open to the public; you have to be a researcher, you have to be specially credentialed to enter it. So our student group from UNA was actually the second university group ever to be credentialed to go into the royal archives. It was a phenomenal experience."

Bibbee was named a fellow at King's College London and the Georgian Papers Programme in 2018-19.

Sunday's presentation is a great opportunity to hear a British scholar speak on King George III and his role in the American Revolution. Bibbee made a similar presentation last month at the North American Conference on British Studies in Atlanta.

Greg Gresham, president of the local SAR chapter, extends a cordial invitation to anyone who wishes to learn more about British and American history.

Medicare Minute

"Types of Medicare Advantage Plans"

There are basically two types of Medicare Advantage Plans. One type is a HMO. HMO stands for Health Maintenance Organization. The other type is a PPO or Preferred Provider Organization. Although both are Medicare Advantage Plans there are some distinct differences in the two.

In most HMO plans you generally can only go to doctors, health care facilities or hospitals that are on the provider list of the plan except in emergency. HMO plans require you to name a primary care provider (PCP). Your PCP becomes the quarterback of your health care. This means you may have to have a referral from your PCP if you want to see a specialist or another health care provider. All HMO plans do not require a referral, so this is a question you will want to ask of considering an HMO.

In a PPO plan, you also have a defined network of providers. You will pay less if you use a provider in the plan's network but, unlike a HMO, you may have some coverage if you go to an out-of-network provider. You will pay more for using an out-of-network provider versus an in-network provider. Also a PPO plan may give you the option of getting your health care from a provider outside your immediate geographical area whereas a HMO can be more limited.

HMO and PPO plans are similar in many ways. They both have a defined network of providers, both have a copy on most services you receive and except for a few exceptions will both include prescription drug coverage. Finding a Medicare health plan is about finding the plan that is right for you. It's a good idea to research both HMO and PPO plans if you are considering a Medicare Advantage Plan.

The collision occurred on a busy thoroughfare in a residential area several miles west of the Las Vegas Strip.

Twenty three year-old Tina Tintor died with her dog in the wrecked and burned Toyota RAV4. Records show she lived only a few blocks from where the crash occurred.

Officers at the scene said that Ruggs seemed impaired. After being treated for an apparent leg injury and registering a .16 (twice the legal limit), the second-year NFL star receiver was released from the hospital, booked into a

Las Vegas jail, and released by the Las Vegas Raiders all in a matter of hours after the crash. Ruggs' 22-year old girlfriend was also in his car and underwent surgery for a severe arm injury. At that speed, it is amazing that anyone lived.

The initial charge against Ruggs was DUI causing death. By Nevada law, Ruggs is facing a possible 2-20 years if convicted. Probation is not available unless the charge is pleaded down.

I understand about a young male's need for speed, but of all places? That city never sleeps. You can't negotiate traffic or traffic signals at excessive speed. At 120mph, rearending a car going 40

is like hitting a parked car while driving at 80.

If Ruggs just HAD to get it out of his system, 10 minutes to the north was a 4-lane highway into the desert.

Through no fault of her own, a young woman and her pet are dead. Understandably, her family was inconsolable. A promising NFL career is in shambles because of a moment of carelessness, selfishness, and immaturity.

I am often reminded of a Sunday morning presentation some 30 years ago by a former local minister, David Sain, where he delved into the spiritual ramifications of Don Henley's lyrics in the 1989 song, "New York Minute."

Anything can happen at any time, be it a job loss, a bad health diagnosis, a debilitating accident, terrible family or friend-related news, a natural death at 93 or something completely unforeseen at 23. Death just carries the most finality. Regardless of our age or the circumstances, if that happens now, are we ready? Are we in good graces with family and friends? Will our family be okay financially? Are we spiritually ready?... How do we know? It's not automatic like many think. Do we know how to obtain salvation?

Regardless of a conviction on this death, Ruggs still has a chance to straighten his life out, to repent of any sins and misdeeds, and gain some maturity. Tina doesn't have that opportunity. I'm sure she was not thinking her life would end in that manner only blocks from her house that morning. We can only hope her spiritual affairs were in order. Hebrews 9:27 reads, "And just as each person is destined to die once and after that comes judgment." New Living Translation

You know Tina's family wasn't expecting the call that morning. They will probably have some anger issues for a while. That is understandable and they will need a lot of prayer and emotional support.

It's an extremely sobering thought. In a New York minute, everything can change.

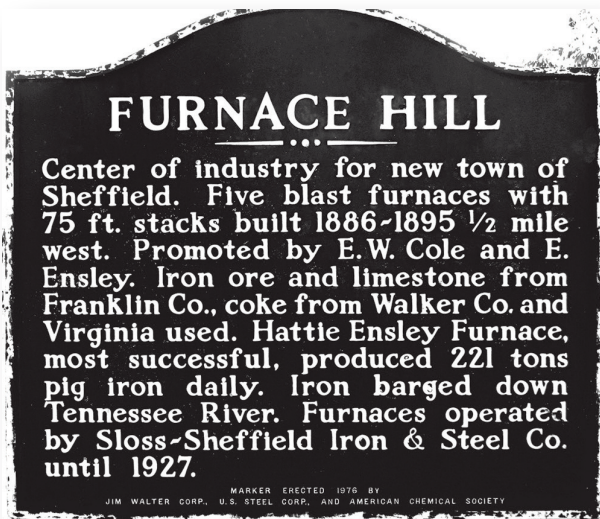

Guard Can Help Unload

Editor:

COVID restrictions and a shortage of dock workers have contributed to a backlog of cargo ships waiting to offload at U.S. ports. As of the end of September dozens of ships are at anchor or are adrift waiting to enter New York City, New Jersey ports, Long Beach and Los Angeles ports. The backlog is causing supply chain shortages of goods across the country and is impacting the upcoming holiday shopping season.

A possible remedy might be the use of National Guard and other military personnel to help unload the ships. There are equipment operators in units within the U.S.

After a Navy enlistment and graduation from college, in June 1963 I was a new Ensign in the Navy aboard the USS Tanner out of the Brooklyn Navy Yard. I was assigned as the officer in charge of a Navy detail designated to offload mail from a ship docked in NYC. The dock workers were on strike so we were temporarily tasked to offload the mail.

With any needed training we should utilize our available military personnel to help alleviate labor shortages in emergency situations whenever it is within the law and feasible to utilize them.

Dear Dave,

My husband is a union member and works at a paint factory near our home. His union's current contract will expire in nine months. We have about \$27,000 of debt left to pay off, and he makes a little over \$80,000 a year. I'm nervous because his slow season is coming up between now and then. During this time, he usually gets about half the hours — and, of course, less money — than he does during the rest of the year. I'm a little scared, even though there hasn't been a strike in the last six years. Do you think we should go ahead and pay off our remaining debt or hold onto every penny in case they walk out?

— Cheyanne

Dear Cheyanne, I'm going to tell you something that might just blow your mind: You two can pay off the debt and have some money set aside to live on in that length of time. If you do that, you'll actually be more ready for a strike than ever before. You'll both have to be on the same page financially and do things with a sense of urgency, but right now, I don't think you've got too much to worry about.

The likelihood of them going on strike is pretty low. Chances are, they're just rattling their sabers and talking big to posture for the negotiations. Most factories are behind right now, and the last thing they want is to get even further behind. Everything has been so screwed up by COVID-19 that unless the union demands some completely ridiculous stuff, things will probably work out fine.

I think you guys are going to be fine, Cheyanne. Should you be intentional and thoughtful about the situation? Absolutely. It's always wise to look ahead and plan for the future. Getting that debt paid off and saving up a bunch of cash will give you real peace of mind.

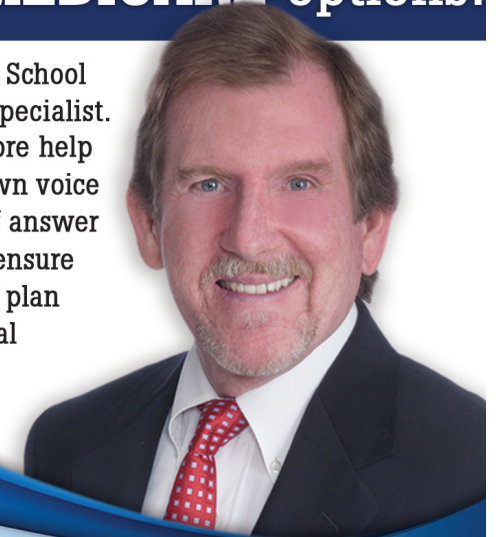
