Walz convenes President Biden's Council of Governors



Governor Walz co-convened the first Council of Governors meeting under the Biden Administration. Governor Walz was appointed by President Joe Biden in July to serve as a co-chair on the Council of Governors along with Ohio Republican Governor Mike DeWine. The Council, which consists of 10 bipartisan governors, is responsible for advising the Secretary of Defense and Secretary of Homeland Security on matters related to the National Guard and civil support missions. After 24 years in the Army National Guard, Governor Walz achieved the rank of Command Sergeant Major and was the highest-ranking enlisted service member ever

to serve in Congress. ; "I'm honored to have convened the first Council of Governors meeting. As a 24-year veteran of the Army National Guard, I am proud to serve as co-chair to lead this bipartisan group of governors in strengthening the state-federal partnership on matters related to the National Guard and civil support missions," said Governor Walz. "I look forward to working closely with the Council and the federal government on these important security issues."; The Council of Governors met with representatives from the Biden Administration to discuss previous Council accomplishments and identify new issues the Council could consider in the coming months. New

priorities will be finalized at an upcoming meeting at the end of January. Governor Walz also served on the Council of Governors during the 2019-20 term, where he led a working group to address National Guard pay and benefits and pursue efforts to support Service Members and increased readiness.; The President's Council of Governors serves as the lead forum to strengthen partnerships between the Federal government and State governments to better protect our nation from threats to our homeland security and all types of hazards. The Council focuses on matters of homeland security; homeland defense; civil support; synchronization and integration of state and Federal military activities in the United States; and other matters of mutual interest. including those involving the National Guard. Federal-state cooperation is critical to protecting communities given the evolving challenges and threats facing our country, which range from extreme weather to domestic and international terrorism to a global pandemic. The Council of Governors will

closely coordinate with the

This week the Minnesota DNR released the winter walleye fishing regulations for Mille Lacs Lake. Winter regs go into effect Dec. 1st, 2021. The limit is one walleye between 21-23 inches in length or one fish longer than 28 inches.

The Mille Lacs Lake fishery also has a number of other special regulations that apply to non-walleye species. For more info, visit the DNR website.

The Biden Administration using federal OSHA issued an emergency edict requiring all companies with 100 or more employees to implement a mandatory COVID-19 vaccination program. Companies must be in full compliance within 60 days of the federal register notice dated November 5, 2021. The 154-page OSHA emergency rule can be found at: https://www.govinfo.gov/ content/pkg/FR-2021-11-05/ pdf/2021-23643.pdf.

masks when indoors and when in a vehicle with another person. The employer must determine vaccination status and keep records on each employee. It is a criminal offense to provide false information about vaccination status. The OSHA emergency standard preempts state and local law.

I disagree with this heavy-handed approach by the federal government. It will only further politicalize the issue of vaccinations. It threatens good people with losing their jobs if they don't buckle under to forced vaccination.

The decision to be vaccinated should rest with the individual. It is not the federal government's role to dictate whether you or I must be vaccinated as a condition to be allowed to work. However, that is exactly what this administration is doing with this latest OSHA regulation.

It remains to be seen if this edict will be stopped in the courts and the federal government will be allowed to begin severely penalizing companies that are not in compliance by the end of 60 days.

People are under enough stress today without the federal government piling on with this latest mandate. It's time the administration in Washington DC started treating US citizens as adults and allow the individual to make an informed decision on what is best with respect to their healthcare.




