Carbon Monoxide Poisoning Prevention

Every year, hundreds of people die and thousands are injured from unsuspected exposure to an odorless, colorless gas-carbon monoxide (CO). Studies by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention indicate that, while people recognize CO gas is poisonous, they perceive CO as less dangerous than other household hazards. CO poisoning is most prevalent when furnaces are turned back on to fight cold winter temperatures, but also commonly occur after summer and winter storms and accompanying power outages, when people tend to rely on portable generators for electricity.

Here are some simple steps to protect yourselves and your family:

Install battery-operated CO detectors near every sleeping area in your home.

Check CO detectors regularly to be sure they are functioning properly.

Have gas or oil furnaces inspected by a gualified professional every year.

Never use a generator inside the home or garage, even if doors and windows are open. Only use generators and power washers outside, more than 20 feet away from the home, doors, and windows. Never use a charcoal grill inside the home.

SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

This week we continue our study of beautiful Livingston County during its 200th year bicentennial.

The Town of Lima is located in the northeast part of the county south of Rochester and the Village of Lima is located within the town.

The Town of Lima was organized as the "Town of Charleston" in 1789 before Livingston County was formed but was renamed "Lima" in 1808 to reflect that many residents had come from Old Lyme, Connecticut, and to avoid confusion with the Town of Charleston in Montgomery County, New York.

The Genesee Wesleyan Seminary (1830) which was later the Genesee College (1849) in Lima village was one of the first co-educational schools in the country when it first opened in 1822. The Ganoung Cobblestone Farmhouse, Godfrey House and Barn Complex, Leech-Lloyd Farmhouse and Barn Complex, Leech-Parker Farmhouse, Markham Cobblestone Farmhouse and Barn Complex, Martin Farm Complex, Ogilvie Moses Farmhouse, Zebulon Moses Farm Complex, and Thomas Peck Farmhouse are listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

The northern town line is the border of Monroe County and the eastern town boundary is the border of Ontario County. Honeoye Creek, a north-flowing tributary of the Genesee River, defines the eastern town line. New York State Route 5 conjoined with U.S. Route 20 is a major east-west highway. New York State Route 15A, a northsouth highway, intersects NY-5/US-20 in Lima village.

Notable citizens are United States Senator Kenneth Keating, Major League baseball player Ken O'Dea, former Archbishop of Chicago James Edward Quigley, politician and founder of the "New York Times" Henry Jarvis Raymond and United States Congressman Andrew Jackson Thayer.

The Town of Livonia is located on the eastern border of our county and contains the Village of Livonia. In the 19th century numerous migrants moved from here to the Midwest. A group settled in Michigan, naming their community Livonia. The region was historically occupied by the Seneca people, one of the Five Nations of the Iroquois confederacy.

The Seneca inhabited the area well into the 19th century, although many were forced out after the British ceded this territory to the United States following the Revolutionary War. The Seneca named the major lake as Ga-ne-a-sos, meaning "Berry Place." It was transliterated into English and is known as Conesus Lake.

The first European-American settler was Solomon Woodruff in 1789. The Town of Livonia was established in 1808 from the Town of Richmond which was then the "Town of Pittstown" in Ontario County. In 1819, part of Livonia was used to form the new Town of Conesus.

The construction of a railway line in the 1850s to Lakeville, now part of Livonia, increased business opportunities and travel throughout the region.

Notable citizens are Gladden Bishop, a leader of the Latter Day Saint movement, health care innovator, John Costik, world champion billiards player, Irving Crane, United States Congressman, Jerediah Horsford, Medal of Honor recipient, Forrest L. Vosler and NASCAR Cup Series crew chief, Rudy Fugle.

Lord willing, we will continue our study of beautiful Livingston County next week.
