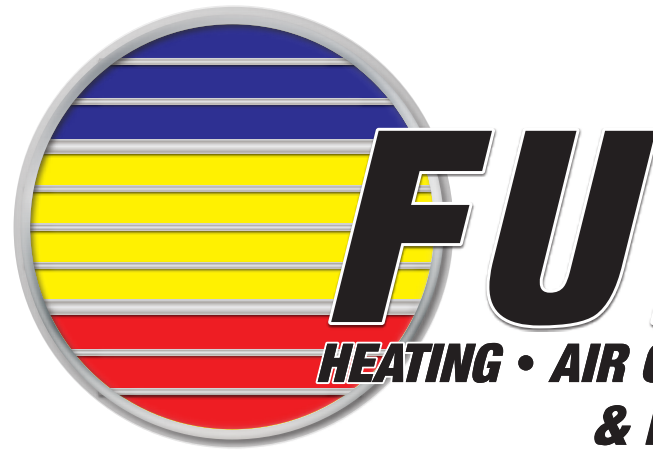

buildings in the State. Utilizing innovative bracing, they were able to have the structure stabilized. Today the beautiful church has been rehabilitated to provide a stunning venue for weddings, concerts and other events.

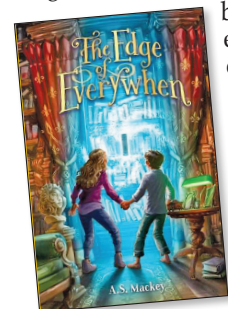

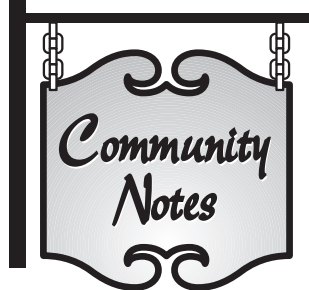

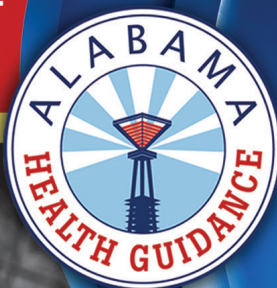

## ON THE JOB INJURIES CAUSED BY THIRD PARTIES

Often clients who are injured on the job have both workers compensation and personal injury claims. Examples include, a truck driver injured in a motor vehicle accident, a factory worker injured by a defective product or construction workers injured by another contractor's employee.

In those cases the injured employee has the absolute right to workers compensation benefits. That includes the right to have their medical bills paid and to have temporary total disability payments while they can't work paid by their employer.

Alabama Code §25-5-11 shifts the burden of compensation to the third party (the person whose fault it was) by requiring that the money received be used to pay back the employer. Even if the employee who is injured does not seek to sue or recover benefits from the party who caused the injury, the worker compensation carrier may sue that third party and is given an additional six months to do so.

If the money recovered exceeds the amount of the workers compensation claim, the employer shall owe no further benefits.

Remember that these are two different types of damages. Workers compensation is very specific in that it pays 2/3 of your average weekly wages while a person can't work and will pay for a permanent injury, but workers compensation does not pay for the loss of enjoyment of life. That means that if you can't go see your children play ball or bowl or golf and because you are injured on the job, you don't get a dime for it. On the other hand, if somebody runs a red light, a jury can and will take into account the things the injured person liked to do before and how the injury affects their ability to enjoy life both in general and the specific things that they no longer can do as a result of their injury.

Remember, the law in Alabama gives the injured worker's employer the right to a credit for the amount of damages that they collect from someone other than their employer.

There are ways to use these principles to benefit the injured person.

# True Success is Unappreciated

**L**istening to Lieutenant Governor-elect, Winsome Sears of Virginia, in the early morning of November 3 after the sweeping Republican upsets in that state the evening before was truly refreshing. She was brief, focused, appreciative, and confident. Sears acknowledged that she was living the American dream and that her victory demolished "all of the narratives about race."

She may be correct, but that just motivates her detractors. Sears had already broken a few barriers. She was previously elected to a majority Black legislative district in Virginia, something no other Republican has accomplished in Virginia since 1865. She was first Black woman to hold statewide office. Sears is also the first and only Black Republican woman, the first female veteran, and the first female legal immigrant (Jamaica) elected to the Virginia House. The former Marine received Presidential appointments to the US Census Bureau, was a hard-charging Vice President of the Virginia State Board of Education, earned a Masters degree, and built

# DAVE Says

## FRIEND WANTS TO BE A TENANT

Dear Dave,  
I own a duplex that has an opening for a tenant, and an old college buddy wants to rent the apartment. He has always been a good friend, but I'm a little worried about the possible effects on our friendship if business is brought into the picture. Do you have any advice?  
Justin

Dear Justin,  
You can make this work, but you'll both need to be careful. It's going to take a lot of honesty and maturity from you both.

Doing business with friends *always* comes with the risk of running into a situation that can damage the relationship. Am I saying never do business with friends?



Of course, not. I do a lot of business with friends. I just make sure all the specific requirements and expectations of the business relationship are laid out in clear detail, in writing, and fully understood by both parties before a deal is struck.

Sometimes friends have unrealistic expectations when it comes to doing business together. The friend who's renting may think the friend who is the landlord will give him a pass if the rent is late, and on a dozen other things. The friend who is the landlord may think the renter will be a perfect tenant, because they're friends, and find out the hard way his buddy's a slob who doesn't respect and take care of the

property. All these things should be ironed out ahead of time and before the agreement is signed.

You might want to make sure, too, he understands the need to come talk to you if a situation arises where he may be late with a payment, or not be able to pay the rent one month. Most issues like this can be worked out, but he needs to understand — and it's your job to tell him ahead of time, in a kind-but-firm manner — you're not running a charity.

Just be friendly, straightforward and businesslike. If you have to enforce the rules, do it consistently and with fairness. Likewise,

if a situation pops up where a little grace and understanding are appropriate, provide those as well.

hand stitched artwork and upholstered furniture, all dyed using locally foraged plant materials. Some of the beautiful plant materials that Aaron uses to dye textiles will be included in the installation.

"These textile works are a testimony to the generous natural beauty of Hale County. They also are a response to the deep, but ever-adaptable roots people have established in the Black Belt for generations," Head stated. "These works contain elements of printmaking, traditional quilt-making, assemblage, hand stitching, and natural dyeing. The materials used for dyeing —indigo, black walnut, sumac, osage wood, marigolds, among others were grown in or foraged around Hale County, where I live and work," he added.

The guild has new rules for their Quilt Challenge each year, and the creative way the rules are followed by each member makes this exhibit an exciting adventure. ## Yes, Traditional Worship is in a Perilous State

To the Editor:

Long before the onset of the Covid-19 virus in the U.S., an alarming decline was evident in traditional worship in this country. Several organizations have engaged in an depth examination as to the possible cause and potential remedies.

Tufts University has published the results of its research and found that an astounding 37% of polled clergy stated that they did not, in fact, believe what they preach to their flocks!\* During the same time frame, pollster George Barna reported that 51% of ministers, preachers and pastors disclosed they did not actually believe

what they preached from the pulpit.\*\* The majority of those examined also indicated that they pursued a life in the clergy simply as a career. Most responding agreed that one must learn to say what their congregation, "...wants to hear" for job security. Those targeted for the study all held graduate degrees and were comprised of an equal number of respondents of stated liberal and conservative backgrounds, Depressing-yet not totally unexpected. A surprising conclusion arrived at in the Tufts study was that Catholics were not included since, "...they were unable to find an adequate number expressing an 'unbelief' in their faith"!

So, what can this trend be attributed to? A broad section of the theological community agree that much of the decline can be blamed on our modern day more advanced liberal educational system. In post-secondary liberal institutions-including some seminaries, students are instilled with a mindset of questioning virtually every value society has embraced previously. Today, it is commonplace to see institutions of higher learning influence students to casts doubt on the Christian faith in general.

The numerous studies have all reached a universal conclusion: there is rampant "unbelief" throughout the Christian community! Yet, as of June 21, 2021, 65% of the Christian community polled professed, "being Christians", but only 24% saying that they are in church every Sunday! \*\*

How diligent are you in your worship? Do you value gathering at a house of worship regularly or do you pursue a "laid back, feel good" approach, preferring to lie on the sofa in your pj's and watch services on the Internet?

Covid-19 has ravaged our organized worship. Nevertheless, responsibility and individual accountability rest with each of us personally and God alone as we face eternity.

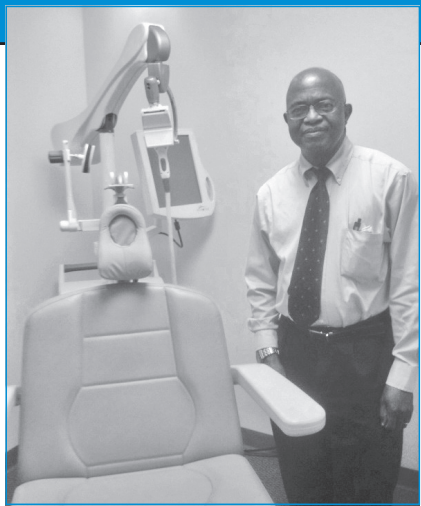

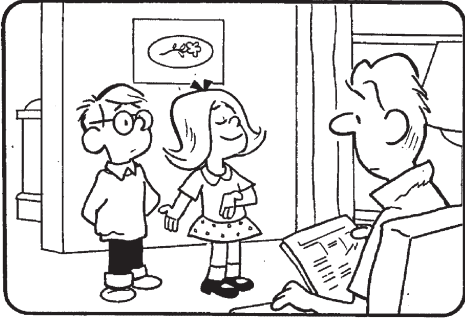

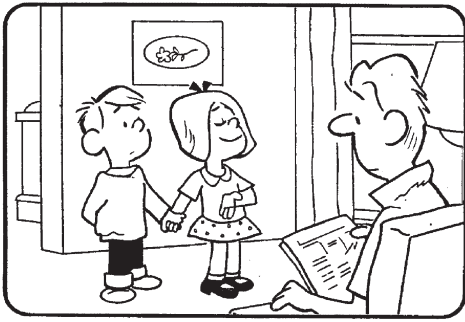

**Medicare Minute**  
**"Prescription Drug Plans"**


October 15th through December 7th is a period of time that Medicare has set aside to make changes to your Prescription Drug Plan (PDP) or Medicare Advantage Plan (MA) if you want. Whether you have a Medicare supplement and a stand-alone drug plan or a Medicare Advantage Plan with prescription drug coverage now is the time to review your drug plan for 2022. Like MA plans, drug plans have certain things you want to look at when considering which PDP is best for you. Those things are premium, deductibles, copays, coinsurance and the plan's provider network.

Although the things listed above are most important so are the tiers that drugs are place into. So before we discuss the cost of the plans let's look at drug plan tiers. Normally there are five tiers to a drug plan. Tier 1 and Tier 2 drugs are usually your most common generic drugs. Tier 3 drugs are preferred brand, Tier 4 drugs are non-preferred brand and Tier 5 drugs are specialty drugs. One of the most misunderstood parts of a drug plan is the tier a person's drug is in.


Many people we meet with think that if their drug is listed in a certain tier under their current PDP it's the same on all plans. This is not always true. Sometimes, for example, a drug may be listed a Tier 2 under one plan but may be a Tier 3 under another plan. Why is this important? Because in most drug plans the copays are higher for Tier 3 than Tier 2.

You can check the tiers of your drugs by looking at the plan's formulary. The formulary is a list of the drugs that are covered by the plan. You can get the formulary of the plan you are considering by going to the plan's website, going online to Medicare.gov or you can visit our office and we can help.

## It is Political Sabotage

Editor:

The *Times Daily* reported that Governor Ivey recently signed legislation countering federal mandates related to Covid vaccination. The Business Council of Alabama opposed the state legislation, as do most people concerned about public health.

Back in July, the Governor had strong and sensible things to say about Covid-19 vaccines, notably, the unvaccinated are "letting us down". Three months later Ivey directed state agencies not to cooperate with federal Covid vaccination mandates.

Nobel economics prize winner Paul Krugman commented that Ivey's swift journey from common sense and respect for science to destructive partisan nonsense - that is killing tens of thousands of Americans — wasn't unique. Rather, it recapitulated the journey the whole Republican Party has taken on issue after issue, from tax cuts to the Big Lie about the 2020 election.

In October, 25 out of every 100,000 residents of heavily Trump counties died from Covid, more than three times higher than the rate in heavily Biden counties. October was the fifth consecutive month that the percentage gap between the death rates in Trump counties and Biden counties widened.

Krugman commented that Republicans who clearly know better reliably swallow their misgivings for the sake of the party line. That includes anti-vaccination, under a smoke screen of freedom, as politically motivated sabotage of the economy.

Schools have long required vaccinations. Organizations should be allowed to protect their workforce through vaccine mandates. We all have a health and economic stake in containing Covid. That will contribute to freedom.

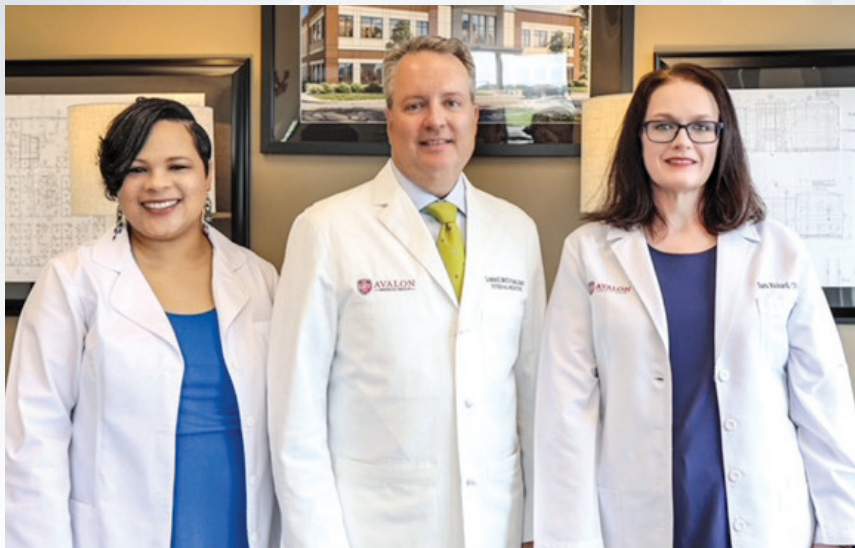

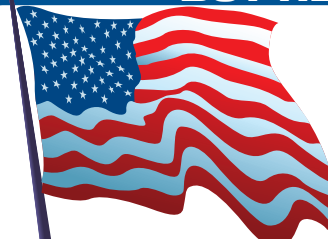

## Insurance Insights

### Use Less Gas With These Fuel Efficiency Tips

Did you know you can save considerably at the gas pump just by modifying your driving habits? Regardless of the type of car you drive, good driving habits contribute to better fuel economy, which saves money and helps the planet, too.

- Perform routine maintenance** - Your car needs the right proportions of air and fuel to run efficiently. A well-maintained vehicle will run at its best.
- Keep tires rotated and inflated to ideal pressure** - To help evenly distribute the wear and tear on your tires, the recommendation is to have your tires rotated every 5,000 to 8,000 miles. Under-inflated tires tend to decrease mileage.
- Glide into your stops** - As you approach a stop sign or light, take your foot off the gas pedal earlier and let your car downshift before applying the brake.
- Combine short trips** - Warm engines run more efficiently than cold ones. Planning your errands so you travel in a sequence instead of backtracking is an efficient way to save time, as well as gas.
- Drive at moderate speeds** - While every vehicle is different, mileage decreases quite rapidly over 50 mph in most cases. To save gas, stay at or under the speed limit, and drive at a consistent rate of speed. Use cruise control on long trips.
- Drive friendly** - Aggressive driving habits such as gunning the engine, speeding, screeching around corners and jamming on the gas pedal are major fuel wasters. Avoid fast acceleration and generally drive in a measured and moderate fashion to achieve top fuel savings.
- Travel light** - Extra weight in the car creates a drag on the engine and consumes extra gas. Don't haul around heavy loads if you don't have to. Check the trunk and back of the vehicle for unnecessary items that may be safely stored elsewhere.
- Keep your car aerodynamic** - Good aerodynamics affect your car's fuel efficiency by reducing drag, especially at high speeds. Keep windows and moon roof closed on the freeway. Even keeping the car's exterior clean can make a difference.
- Use the highest feasible gear** - Driving at high speeds in lower gears burns excessive fuel. On a manual transmission, pay attention to RPMs as you accelerate and shift into high gear as soon as you reasonably can.
- Avoid excessive idling** - Idling uses a surprising amount of fuel — more than restarting the engine. If you need to wait in your parked vehicle for more than a minute or two, switch off the engine and only start up again when you're ready to continue driving. In extreme weather, it's nice getting into a comfortable car but be conscious of how long the vehicle is idling so fuel isn't wasted.
- Ride share** - You'll cut per-person fuel consumption in half when you share a ride. Ask friends and colleagues who live near you or frequent the same places you do to share a ride. You can split gas costs as many ways as there are passengers.
