SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

This week we continue our study of beautiful Livingston County during its 200th year bicentennial.

The Town of Mount Morris is located on the western border of our county and the Village of Mount Morris is located in the town at its northern border. It is home to part of Letchworth State Park.

The town and village were named after Robert Morris, who was a Founding Father of the United States. The region was first settled by Europeans about 1784. It was first known as "Allens Hill" and then as "Richmond Hill".

The town was formed from the Town of Leicester in 1818 and the former Genesee Valley Canal passed through the town. The northwest town line is defined by the Genesee River. The southwestern half of the town line following the Genesee is the border of Wyoming County.

New York State Route 36 and New York State Route 408 intersect in Mount Morris village. Interstate 390 passes near the east town line. In 1952, the Mount Morris Dam was finished on the Genesee River for flood control and is located northwest of the village.

The Hamlet of Brooks Grove is in southwest part of the town on Route 408. Its name is from its founder General Micah Brooks. The native village Deyuitga'oh "Where the Valley Widens" was once located near where the Mount Morris Dam is currently situated.

Letchworth State Park is located on the western border of the town. The Hamlet of the Ridge is located southwest of the village on NY-408. The peaceful little Hamlet of Tuscarora is in the southeast part of the town. The Hamlet of Union Corners is located on the town line east of Tuscarora.

Notable people: Major General William Augustus Mills fought in the War of 1812; Francis Bellamy authored the "Pledge of Allegiance;" George Hastings was a United States Congressman; Sarah Hopkins Bradford was a writer & historian; Mary Seymour Howell was a suffragette; Mary Jemison was called the "White Woman of the Genesee;" Marie Boening Kendall was a painter; James M. Mead was a United States Congressman; and John Wesley Powell who was a geologist and explorer.

The Town of Sparta is located in the southeast part of the county and is located north of Dansville. Its area was first settled about 1794 and the Town of Sparta was established in 1789 before the establishment of Livingston County. Eventually, Sparta was diminished by the removal of land for other towns, including Springwater in 1816, West Sparta in 1846 and Groveland in 1856. Sparta also received territory from the towns of Dansville in 1822 and Groveland in 1856.

A small part of the south town line is the border of Steuben County. New York State Route 255 (now decommissioned) joined New York State Route 256 in Sparta. New York State Route 63 is a north-south highway in the western part of the town.

Conesus Inlet, flowing toward Conesus Lake, is in the northwest part of the town. The hamlets of Reeds Corners and Scottsburg are in the town. Notable people: Alfred Agate was born in Sparta and was a painter. Frederick Styles Agate was a resident of Sparta and was the brother of noted portraitist and painter Alfred Agate.

Lord willing, we will continue our study of our beautiful Livingston County next week. I would really welcome any information or memories of our county's towns.

Sheila has been at her IRA since it was built, 13 years ago. This particular home houses aging individuals, and she is known for going above and beyond in her position supporting aging people with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities.

Residential Director, Deb Tuckerman, commends Sheila for setting the bar for other staff. "She sets that bar very high because of her commitment and dedication to the people she supports. Staff and the people in the home often comment on how they look up to Sheila, and many refer to her as a mother figure. Sheila consistently role model's kindness, a strong work ethic, person centeredness, and empathy. She is the ideal DSP, who reliably puts her heart into her work every day."

Working with aging individuals, she is a crucial part in home life supporting their personal care, and helping them get through end of life situations. Ms. Tuckerman reflects back on a moment in particular earlier in the year; "When Sheila found out a housemate passed away, she came directly to the IRA to talk with an individual who she knew would be especially sad." She goes on further to say "Sheila demonstrates that The Arc is not just a job for her – it's an important part of her life."
