## **CLC Trap Shooting Team wins conference and places third at Nationals**



Central Lakes College's Trap Shooting Team won its conference after competing in the USA College Clay Target League's six-week season. The team also recently finished the season placing third at Nationals.

The 15-member co-ed team is celebrating its most successful season since beginning competition in 2017. This is the first time that CLC has earned the conference championship, and the program looks to build upon this season's success in subsequent

After taking first place at its conference, the CLC team was invited to participate in the national tournament, which took place from November 1 – 6, with team members each shooting 100 clay targets at Lakeshore Conservation Club and then coaches inputting scores online.

Team members Kylie Wolkenhauer and Isaac Malone each scored a 97 out of 100, which earned Wolkenhauer the High Gun for all females at Nationals and tied both her and Malone for the 2nd highest score of the tournament. Team member Grace Caouette wrapped up her first season of competitive trapshooting in spectacular fashion earning first place in the tournament's novice category.

tunity to visit with the senior leadership of Enbridge and received an update on the Enbridge Pipeline #3 replacement project. Construction is complete and the new line now designated Enbridge Pipeline #93 went into operation last

The 1,097 mile pipeline moves crude oil from Edmonton, Canada to Superior, Wis. A total of 330 miles are within Minnesota, including eight new pump stations and two new pipeline maintenance shops. Two of the new pump stations are located in our immediate area near Hill City and Floodwood.

The entire project cost \$9.3 billion, all of which was funded by the private sector. Over \$4 billion was invested in the United States, the bulk of which came to Minnesota. Currently, Enbridge pays about \$43 million annually in Minnesota property taxes. The first year

I recently had the oppor- Line 93 is in full operation that amount will increase by about \$35 million dollars.

> The Minnesota segment took over six years to complete. Actual construction including the new pump stations only took about 12 months. Most of those six years were spent undergoing Minnesota's extensive environmental review and permitting process. That process involved review and permitting activities by the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission, MPCA, DNR, US Army Corps of Engineers, US Bureau of Indian Affairs, and the Fond du Lac Band of Lake Superior Chippewa.

Where tribal governments desired, the new pipeline route avoided reservation lands and where tribal governments desired the old line was replaced with new pipeline on their reservation lands. Tribal members played an important role in completing the project. About 700 indigenous workers were involved in construction representing over 7% of the total work force. In contrast, today Native Americans represent about 1.1% of Minnesota's total population.

This week I was invited to participate in the Minnesota Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) Forestry Association's monthly meeting at McGregor. I learned a lot.
