



## SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out."

This week we continue our study of our beautiful Livingston County during its 200th year bicentennial.

The Town of Springwater is in the southeast part of our county. The first settlers arrived around 1807. The town was established in 1816 from the towns of Sparta and Naples.

Today, Naples is a town in Ontario County. In 1866, a serious conflict between landowners and squatters resulted in the wholesale eviction of many people who were not living on their own land. The south town line is the border of Steuben County and the east town line and part of the north town line is the border of Ontario County. The southernmost part of Hemlock Lake, one of the smaller Finger Lakes, is in the northern part of the town.

The Springwater Valley through the center of the town terminates at the lake, and includes many streams that feed into Hemlock Lake, including Springwater Creek and Lime Kiln Creek. Hemlock Lake is part of the Genesee River watershed.

New York State Route 15 and New York State Route 15A join at Springwater village. From 1854 to 1956 Springwater was served by the "New York – Jersey City to Rochester Main Line" of the Erie Railroad.

That portion through Springwater was removed in 1956 by order of the Interstate Commerce Commission in order to promote highway transportation. The headwaters of the Cohocton River, which flows southward from the town and is part of the Susquehanna River watershed, are located in the eastern side of the town.

Notable people: John Samuel Rowell was an agricultural inventor and manufacturing industrialist; Emily Maria Scott was an artist. The New York Watercolor Club and the Pen and Brush Club were formed in her studio.

The Town of York is in the western part of our county. The Abbey of the Genesee is in the town's Hamlet of Piffard and is locally famous due to the production of Monks' Bread.

In 1722, the Tuscarora people moved north to join other Iroquoian natives, the League of the Iroquois, and settled near modern Piffard. The town was first settled by Europeans around 1800. The town was formed in 1819 from parts of the towns of Leicester and Caledonia before the establishment of Livingston County.

More territory was added from the Town of Covington in 1823. Salt was found in 1883 near modern Retsof, leading to the formation of the New York Rock Salt Company. Further discoveries were made subsequently by the Empire Salt Company and American Rock Salt.

The Linwood Estate was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1997. The west town line borders Genesee and Wyoming counties. New York State Route 36 (north-south) intersects New York State Route 63 (east-west) at Greigsville. U. S. Route 20 passes along the northern town line.

Notable people: Chester A. Arthur was a United States President; Moses Hayden was a Congressman; John Chandler Holloway became a Wisconsin State Assemblyman and State Senator. James Laird was a United States Congressman from Nebraska; Joseph Marron was an optical engineer; Donald Stewart was a Wisconsin State Assemblyman.

We have concluded our study of the original twelve towns of our county and, Lord willing, we will continue our study next week with the other five towns of our Livingston County.





# Protect Yourself from Disease While Hunting

If you hunt, you should be aware that it can put you at risk for two common diseases that can be prevented. These two diseases are Lyme Disease, and Rabies. The Livingston County Department of Health offers information about each disease and tips for you below.

**Lyme Disease** is transmitted to humans by the bite of an infected tick. Typical symptoms include fever, headache, fatigue, and a circular skin rash with a target-like appearance. Tips to keep yourself safe include:

- Wear insect repellant or use odorless permethrin on clothing
- Tuck your pants into socks, and shirt into pants
- Check for ticks daily
- Shower soon after being outdoors

**Rabies** is transmitted through direct contact such as broken skin or mucous membranes in the eyes, nose, or mouth of an infected animal. Symptoms can include general weakness or discomfort, fever, or headache. Tips to keep yourself safe from rabies include:

- Staying clear of animals that have trouble walking, is drooling, or has an appearance of "drunkenness," aggression or even tameness
  - Wear gloves when dressing or butchering game
  - Wash hands thoroughly afterward
