Piedmont Pets

Bringing a new pet into a home is life changing and usually comes with a degree of stress and anxiety for the animals as well as the humans. During the busy holiday season, the level of stress can skyrocket.

In the past, most animal welfare organizations discouraged holiday pet adoptions. Some shelters now encourage adoptions if a family or individual wants a new pet. The general exception is that animals should not be given as surprise gifts. A gift certificate accompanied by wrapped presents of toys, treats, collars, cages, etc. would be a much better option.

When thinking about bringing a new animal into a home, it is urged that people consider the following questions, as well as others that may pertain:

Do I have the time for a pet? It may sound fun to have a cute little dog waiting for you at the door each evening, but busy schedules may not be in the best interest of that dog. There is no such thing as a no-maintenance pet. Even fish in tanks require daily feeding and care to meet their physical needs.

Can I afford this pet? Beyond the initial cost of adopting or purchasing a pet, it is wise to consider the monthly cost of food, routine and/ or emergency veterinary care, and other supplies. All pets come with a financial obligation.

What kind of pet would be the best match for me? If you lead a more sedentary lifestyle, it would not be wise to adopt a young, large, active puppy that needs long walks and romps in a fenced area. If someone in your

household is allergic to cats, do not think that the cat will be happy living in a small room away from people for its entire life. Large birds are beautiful; they are also very social and messy. Even small companion animals like hamsters, guinea pigs, and rabbits have very specific physical and emotional needs.

4. Does everyone in the household want this new pet? Children may want a pet and may make promises about how they will take care of them; however, the care of the pet will ultimately rest on the shoulder of the parents. Are all of the adults in the household in agreement with adding an animal to the family?

If all of the questions are answered positively, then maybe it is a good time to think of adding an animal member to your family!

Toy Tourist Bus

Buses were used for transportation as early as the 1820s, long before the modern motor was invented. They had horse-power — live horses pulled the bus. By the 1830s, buses were powered by steam, and in 1882, the first electric bus was introduced.



This toy tourist bus was made about 1910 by the Kenton Hardware Co. in Ohio. Not all of the passengers are original, but suitable replacements had been found. It is a rare toy, so rare it auctioned for just over \$1,000.

But the toy bus made after 1895 often resembled tourist buses used in a few large cities. It had a motor. The tourist bus had seats inside and out; if the weather was nice, riders could climb the stairs to go up to the top seats where tall buildings could be admired.

There was no cover for the top. The Kenton Hardware Co in Kenton, Ohio, made many small cast iron household items such as bookends, doorstops, small figures, ashtrays, cooking utensils and toys. A double-decker tourist bus was made in about 1900, followed by a second version in 1910. An orange one sold for \$1,020 at a Bertoia auction despite seven replacement figures with old paint. Many old iron toys have been copied; original toys should have a smooth, not bumpy, bottom. The seams between the molded parts must be tight and jointed with slotted screws. And most old toys have the maker's name impressed in the mold.

• Is there any way to test to see if an item is made of resin, bone or plastic?

. Bone and resin are natural A products. Bone has small black or brown pock marks called "marrow flecks." It's heavier than resin or plastic. Resin is an organic material made from plants and trees. It may have some tiny bubbles in it. Plastic is a synthetic material and is harder than resin. Although a resin figurine is heavier than the same figurine in plastic, it is not as durable and is more likely to chip or crack if dropped.



Remembering Pearl Harbor

December 7, 2021, marks the 80th anniversary of the attack on Pearl Harbor. This was a pivotal day in world history, ultimately leading the United States to enter the Second World War.

Prior to the attack on Pearl Harbor, Japan participated in a series of invasions into China, believing the only way to solve its economic and demographic problems was to expand into China and take over its import market. This attitude helped create rising tension with the United States, and American officials ultimately responded with economic sanctions and trade embargoes. Although it seemed war was inevitable, the Japanese preempted the American military with a surprise attack targeting Pearl Harbor, which is 2,000 miles from the U.S. mainland and 4,000 miles from Japan.

Pearl Harbor is a U.S. naval base located near Honolulu, HI. On a Sunday morning on December 7, 1941, just before 8:00 a.m. local time, Japanese fighter planes descended on the base in a surprise attack. Five additional attacks followed throughout the day. The Japanese managed to destroy nearly 20 American naval vessels, which included eight battleships, and more than 300 airplanes. While the military equipment could ultimately be replaced, the more than 2,400 military personnel and civilians who died paid the ultimate price.

It is believed the United States was especially surprised by the attack, as American military leaders felt, if an attack were to take place, it would come from the sea rather than the air. In addition, American intelligence officials were confident that any Japanese attack would take place in one of the European colonies in the South Pacific, such as Singapore or Indochina, which are closer to Japan than Hawaii.

Despite devastating Pearl Harbor, all hopes were not lost that day, and the Japanese could not cripple America's Pacific Fleet. Aircraft carriers were not docked at the base, and the key onshore oil storage, shipyards, repair shops, and docks were left largely intact. From a functional standpoint, the U.S. Navy was able to quickly rebound. However, even 80 years later, the residual emotional effects of the attack continue, particularly among WWII veterans, as well as the family members of those who perished.


