## SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out,"

This week we continue our study of our beautiful Livingston County during its 200th year bicentennial.

Last week we concluded our study of the original twelve towns of our county and this week we continue our study with the five towns which were added later.

The Town of North Dansville is located in the southeast part of the county with the Village of Dansville in the center of the town. It was named after Daniel Faulkner. The first settlers were Armariah Hammond and Cornelius Mc Coy who migrated here from Pennsylvania about 1795.

David and James Mc Curdy, stepsons of Cornelius Mc Coy, arrived at the same time. The first religious services were held by Reverend Andrew Grey in 1798 and the first church was formed in 1800.

The town was organized from the Town of Sparta on February 27, 1846, and another portion was annexed from the Town of Sparta in 1849. The town was at one time on a branch of the Genesee Valley Canal.

The eastern and southern town lines are the border of Steuben County. Interstate 390, New York State Route 36, New York State Route 63 and New York State Route 256 pass through the town. The Canaseraga Creek flows northward within the town toward the Genesee River. Canaseraga Creek's name is of Seneca origin and was recorded in early records as Gamusgago, Kanuskago, and Caniskrauga. Mill Creek flows through the southern part of the town.

The Hamlet of Cumminsville is located on the west town line between Dansville Airport and Interstate 390. Dansville Station is located northeast of the village.

Nicholas H. Noyes Memorial Hospital is located within the village. The yearly balloon festival is held at the airport on Labor Day weekend.

One of the largest libraries in the county is located on Main Street. The Clara Barton House, located at 57 Elizabeth Street is the chapter house of the American Red Cross.

Notable people: Clarissa Harlowe Barton, an American nurse, founded the American Red Cross. She was a hospital nurse in the American Civil War, a teacher, and a patent clerk. She and her supply wagons traveled with the Union army giving aid to soldiers. She was called the "Angel of the Battlefield" and was a staunch fighter for women's rights.

The Town of West Sparta is in the south-central part of the county and is northwest of Dansville. The area was first settled around 1795 and the town was formed from the Town of Sparta on February 27, 1846. The name is derived from the neighboring Town of Sparta. Canaseraga Creek, a tributary of the Genesee River, and Interstate 390 pass through the town.

New York State Route 36 parallels the Interstate. The former Genesee Valley Canal passed through the town.

The Hamlet of Byersville is located in the southern part of the town. The Hamlet of Kysorville is located in the northern part of the town. The Hamlet of Union Corners, once called "Brushville", is located on the western town line. The Hamlet of Woodsville is located within the southeast corner of the town.

The R. P. Kemp No. 1 Site was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1977.

Lord willing, we will continue our study next week of the other four towns which were added after the establishment of our beautiful Livingston County.


