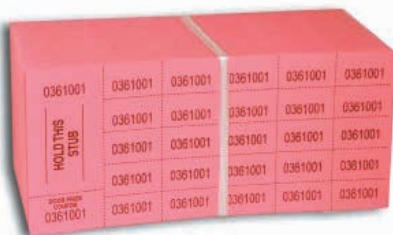

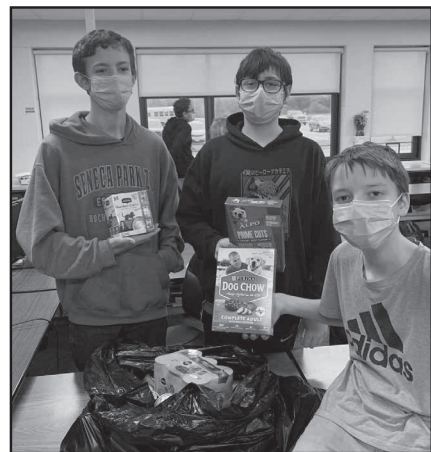

Medina Students Embrace Philanthropy for Class Project



Medina High School teacher Krista Lindke was pleasantly surprised at the response she got from her 8th grade High School and Beyond students for a recent class activity. "The activity that I assigned was a philanthropy project about kindness and the spirit of giving. For six days, the class broke into three groups: People, Animals, and the Environment and they had to complete three tasks each and choose an organization to donate to."

The People team collected numerous winter clothing items and delivered them to the Batavia Salvation Army. They made Thanksgiving cards for the residents at Orchard Rehabilitation and Nursing Center and gifted candy to the nursing staff. They also made "Help a Teacher" tickets for the 8th grade teachers.

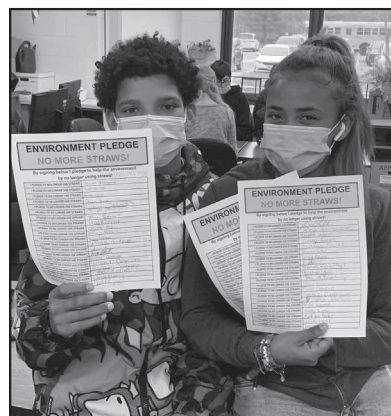
The Animal team collected and donated several cans/boxes of dog and cat food and delivered them to the Niagara County SPCA. They also crafted and delivered dog blankets to the Niagara County SPCA. In addition they constructed a couple feral cat boxes and placed them in the community and dog treats were

distributed to the teachers for their pets or their neighbors'.

The Environment team collected over 1,000 can/bottle returns and donated the proceeds to the Nature Conservancy. Birdseed baggies were put together and distributed to the teachers. They had 100 people sign a "No More Straws" pledge sheet and they picked up litter after school.

"This was such an impactful activity for my class," says Mrs. Lindke. "The students really went above and beyond and their kindness was definitely abundant. I am very proud of them! We also could not have done it without the help of the wonderful teachers and staff at MHS!"

A guide to cooking with kids



The entire family can get in on the action when kids participate in the kitchen.



Children may start their culinary careers crafting mud pies in their backyards, but that creativity and imagination soon may translate into foods they can actually eat. Many kids love cooking because it can be fun and messy, which are two qualities that children find hard to resist.

Parents can foster their children's love of cooking and help them along the way with these tips.

- **Be patient.** Going into the cooking experience knowing there will be a mess, typically when young children are involved, can help you prepare. Toddlers have not yet mastered manual dexterity, so they're bound to spill and drop. Put a plastic tablecloth under the work area and on the floor to help catch what falls. Also, cooking with youngsters likely will take more time than it normally would, so set aside extra preparation and cooking time.

- **Teach kids good hygiene.** Hygiene is important and can prevent foodborne illnesses. Make sure everyone involved in cooking, including children, washes his or her hands before cooking begins and continues to do so after handling foods, particularly raw meat and poultry. Hair should be tied back, and separate prep surfaces should be designated for produce and meats.

- **Assign age-appropriate tasks.** Consider age and maturity levels when assigning tasks in the kitchen. Even children as young as 3-years-old can chop food if they are provided a serrated butter knife with a rounded point and soft vegetables or fruits. This helps teach knife skills that kids can develop more thoroughly in the future. Children can mix and add ingredients as well. As kids get



older, parents can decide the right time to let them use the stove.

- **Experiment with dough.** Kids can have a blast with dough, particularly rolling out pie crusts and pasta. They also can make dumplings and then fill them with vegetables. Many cookware retailers sell small rolling pins that are easy for kids to handle.

- **Practice measuring together.** Let children read the recipes and be in charge of portioning out ingredients. This reinforces classroom lessons about temperature, ratios and fractions.

- **Move on to more sophisticated tasks.** Around age eight or nine, children can take on jobs like opening cans, scooping batter, pounding poultry, proofing yeast, skewering kabobs, and slicing bread, according to cooking educator Julie Negrin. Negrin notes that children between the ages of 10 and 12 can start working independently in the kitchen so long as an adult is in the home. Ultimately, children can cook without close supervision.

Children also can be involved in cooking by helping to draft shopping lists and taking trips to the supermarket. This shows kids the complete process of gathering ingredients for meals, what they cost and how they are made before foods make it to the dinner table.

Let’s go on an adventure together....to North Carolina!

For those who don’t know me well....or at all, personally....here’s a little background info about me. I was born and raised here in Albion, NY, graduated from Albion High School in 1974, and worked at GE in Brockport after high school. In 1985, I got married and moved to North Carolina. I moved back “home” when I retired in 2011 to be close to family.....yes, I’m proof that there ARE people who retire and move north! In my 26 years in NC, I lived and worked in a town called Sanford – about ½ way between Raleigh and Fayetteville in the center of the state. I thought I’d tell you all about some of the cool things I discovered during my 26 year adventure in North Carolina.



The beaches in NC are stunning. This is Atlantic Beach in the off season – quiet and peaceful, but still warm enough for a stroll on the beach or a dip in the ocean. The Outer Banks in NC are the ultimate beach experience.

North Carolina is a really diverse state....you have ocean beaches to the east and mountains to the west and lots of rolling hills and interesting cities and towns in between. There is truly something for everyone to enjoy throughout the state. I liked living in the center of the state – it made quick one or two day trips to either the beaches or the mountains so easy.

Beaches: My family liked Carolina and Wrightsville Beaches in Wilmington – to me, they were too crowded and hot for my liking. I much preferred beaches like Atlantic Beach – especially in the off season – a little quieter and less crowded – more relaxing. Kure Beach has a lovely aquarium at historic Fort Fisher. Topsail and Emerald Isle were usually very nice, as well. But, if you really like beaches, I recommend the Outer Banks. On our second year in NC, we took a trip to the Outer Banks. We started out spending a few days at Kitty Hawk (the Wright Brothers monument is a must see), Nags Head, and Kill Devil Hills – the dunes there are awesome and if you’re adventurous, you can parasail or hang glide over them! Nearby Manteo is home of “The Lost Colony” – an outdoor theater production of an 84-year old musical telling of a British colony established in 1587 that mysteriously disappeared without a trace three years later – I wish I had seen it – maybe I’ll return, someday. Then, we drove the length of the Outer Banks. The route takes you on ferries that are quite busy during peak season, so find

out about possible need for reservations, etc. before you head out. The drive is stunning! Most of the route is a narrow road with the sound on one side and the ocean on the other, lots of lighthouses, wild horses, quaint beaches, and so much more. At the end, there is Hatteras with the famous black and white striped lighthouse and beautiful Ocracoke. We ended our trip in Wilmington and then drove back to Sanford from that point. I highly recommend taking the time to enjoy the entire Outer Banks from top to bottom.

Mountains: The Blue Ridge Mountains are so beautiful. I used to love to take my birthday (late October) off work and drive out to the NC/VA border to get on the Blue Ridge Parkway and drive it down to I40 to cut back towards Sanford. It made for an amazingly relaxing day full of great places to stop and enjoy the beauty. Asheville has the Biltmore Estate – definitely worth the time to tour it, especially when it is all decorated for Christmas. I love the Boone area, too. I spent a nice long weekend in a cabin with a bunch of girl friends from work in Seven Devils, near Boone. We rode horseback along the edge of the mountain, shopped, hiked, and had the most amazing breakfast at the Daniel Boone Inn in Boone – they serve family style and you don’t leave without taking at least an extra 5-10 pounds with you on your hips! Some other great attractions out that way are Linville Caverns, Tweetsie Railroad, and Blowing Rock – dubbed by Ripley’s Believe It or Not as the “only place in the world where snow falls upside down”. Down a bit further is Cherokee, NC – Mingo Falls and several wonderful museums and heritage sites of the Cherokee Indians.

North Carolina also has an amazing zoo in Asheboro. With 500 developed acres, it is the world’s largest natural habitat zoo. Take the trolley and visit all the animals for an awesome day at the zoo.



Biltmore Estates – the home of George Vanderbilt – is a must see in Asheville, NC. It took six years to build – 1889-1895 – and the finished home contains over four acres of floor space, including 35 bedrooms, 43 bathrooms, and 65 fireplaces.

Of course, you can’t talk about NC without mentioning sports.....I lived on the edge of the Research Triangle that included the University of NC in Chapel Hill – the Tar Heels, North Carolina State in Raleigh – the Wolfpack, Duke in Durham – the Blue Devils, and Wake Forest in Winston-Salem – the Demon Deacons. There are the Panthers football and Hornets basketball based in Charlotte and the Hurricanes hockey based in Raleigh. And...of course, Nascar! I’m not really a sports fan, but, I did take in a Durham Bulls minor league baseball game now and then...I do like baseball!

Yep – North Carolina has a lot to offer. I loved living there and call Sanford my “other home town”. But, I’m so very happy to be back in my “real” home town of Albion, NY – there’s no place like home and I love it here.
