




WREATHS ACROSS AMERICA **OBSERVED SATURDAY, DECEMBER 18, 2021** NATIONALLY AND LOCALLY

Zilker Holiday Tree

The Zilker Holiday Tree is a 155 foot Christmas tree made from lights draped from a moonlight tower located in Zilker Park (Austin, Texas). During the Christmas season the tree is lit by 3000 colored lights. The lighting of the tree has been an annual tradition in Austin since 1967. On December 26, 2010, a five-kilometer run named after the tree took place.

37th Street, Austin, Texas

37th Street Lights Annually since 2006. West 37th Street between Guadalupe Street and Home Lane Austin, Texas 37th Street is a street in Austin, Texas, known for its many houses that are decorated with Christmas lights. The tradition attracts tens of thousands of visitors each year, though neighbor participation has decreased the past few years due to the original residents having moved away and more students renting homes in the neighborhood.

In the mid-1980s, a couple of neighbors began bridging the street with Christmas lights left by other neighbors and found at fraternity and sorority houses near the University of Texas. Soon, other neighbors followed suit. Early participant Bob Godbout recalled, "It didn't start out as Christmas lights. It started out as a wild art form and stayed that way."

In 1993, city workers removed lights strung from city poles due to fire hazard concerns. In response, street residents turned off all lights, resulting in numerous complaints directed at the city from visitors expecting light displays. City workers returned the following day to reinstall the lights.

Merry Christmas, Y'all

Merry Texas Christmas, Y'all is the 14th studio album and first Christmas album by American western swing band Asleep at the Wheel. Recorded at Bismeaux Studio in Austin, Texas, it was produced by the band's frontman Ray Benson and released on September 30, 1997 by High Street Records. The album includes a mix of traditional and original songs, which feature guests including Willie Nelson, fiddler Johnny Gimble and former Asleep at the Wheel pianist Floyd Domino.

Asleep at the Wheel's first Christmas album received positive reviews from a wide range of critics, who praised the band's "fun" renditions of traditional holiday songs, as well as its original compositions. The album registered at number 75 on the US Billboard Top Country Albums chart in Christmas week 1997. The band issued a second Christmas album, Santa Loves to Boogie, in 2007, followed by a third, Lone Star Christmas Night, in 2016, featuring some of the same songs. Asleep at the Wheel recorded its first Christmas album at Bismeaux Studios in the summer of 1997. Merry Texas Christmas, Y'all features recordings of traditional Christmas songs such as "Feliz Navidad", "Let It Snow! Let It Snow! Let It

Snow!" and "Here Comes Santa Claus", in addition to several original songs written primarily by the band's frontman Ray Benson. Willie Nelson features as a guest vocalist on his own composition "Pretty Paper" and the recording of "Silent Night", the latter of which also features Don Walser. The other featured vocalist is Tish Hinojosa, who performed on

opening track "Feliz Navidad".

Merry Texas Christmas, Y'all was issued on September 30, 1997 as Asleep at the Wheel's only release on High Street Records, a subsidiary of Windham Hill. No singles were releasMedia response to Merry Texas Christmas, Y'all was largely positive. AllMusic's Ross Boissoneau wrote that "Ray Benson and company have outdone themselves, with nods to traditional country ... as well as the band's stock in trade, Western swing.

Okrapalooza Celebrates The Strange Veggie **Tumbleweed Smith**



Gumbo is not the only use for okra, a vegetable brought to the US by slaves in the 1660s. Dallas has an event called Okrapalooza every year about the time okra is harvested. Elizabeth Dry turned

Tumbleweed Smith a trashy vacant lot into a community garden 12 years ago and named it The Promise of Peace Garden. To raise money for the rent on the property she went to her computer and googled okra festivals in Texas," "And there were none," says Elizabeth. "So I started one. The first year there were just 3 chefs who prepared okra dishes on picnic tables and attendees paid 5 dollars to come in."

The fund raising event has grown considerably and now attracts hundreds of people. It is an upscale event with an admission charge of 85 dollars. Guests get to sample gourmet okra dishes and custom made wines and beers while listening to live music. They also get to hear about okra recipes and ways to eat

"We have several musical groups that play 45 minute sets. During that time guests will be tasting the okra dishes, going from chef's table to chef's table and they learn about stuff. There are two prizes. One is a people's choice ward and the other is a choice of 6 judges. The winner will be judged on presentation, complexity, flavor and all that,"

This year's event was at the Cotton Mill in McKinney. Twelve chefs were on hand producing everything from pickled okra seeds to okra ice cream.

"We've got a very diverse group of cooks. There's personal chefs, there's chefs from 4-star restaurants, there;s chefs that actually farm their own food."

Elizabeth says there are no big corporate sponsors. This is for the community.

"The chefs love it. It's one of the most down to earth." fun, love-filled events I've ever been to. And these chefs create masterpieces that have never been replicated. People told me that I need to ask the chefs what they'll be cooking.so nobody will be cooking the same thing. Well they never have in 12 years. And we've had an average of 15 chefs per festival since it started. And that's a lot of different dishes."

This year because of Covid the number of guests was limited to 150. Everyone seemed to like the Cotton Mill and it will probably take place there next year.

"We received so many compliments from guests, chefs, musicians and nearly everyone was pleased with the winners. The judges' favorite was Olivia Lopez who is cultivating heirloom red, yellow and blue corn from Mexico to preserve her culture. For Okrapalooza she did an okra enchilada that was unbelievable. She used two different colors of corn, blue and red. The people's choice award went to Adam West who owns Local Yokel Restaurant in McKinney. He did a churro that was incredible. He folded okra into the flour and somehow made it sweet with a dipping
