Transfer Station News


There will be no changes in the Transfer Station fees at this time. Tickets for bagged trash (blue) are still \$3 each, and bulk item tickets (red) are \$1 each. Permit prices are \$45 for Mt. Morris residents/owners, \$55 for non-residents, \$40 for Mt. Morris Senior Citizens aged 65+, and \$10 for a one-day permit. Proof of residency and age may be required when appropriate. ALL refuse tickets and permits are available at the Town Clerk's office.

The Transfer Station will be **CLOSED** for the Saturday holidays. The Town Clerk will be at the Transfer Station selling permits and tickets on **Wednesday, January 5th** and **Saturday, January 8th**. Payment by cash or check only. After these dates, no payments will be accepted at the Transfer Station. All refuse disposal fees must be paid via the Town Clerk's office.

PLEASE NOTE:



West Sparta resident Elsie Hartmann will be celebrating her 100th Birthday on January 9, 2022. Elsie is a kind and gentle hearted woman who always introduces herself with a warm smile. She has consistently been willing to help a neighbor in need and has volunteered at a multitude of community, social, and church events throughout the years.

Elsie enjoys the simple things of life, bird watching and flower gardening, and is happiest when her house is filled with family. She adores her grand and great-grandchildren and attends as many of their events as possible, including high school and military graduations, school performances and sports events. Elsie enjoys spending time in the kitchen and is known throughout West Sparta for her famous carrot cakes. She still lives at the Hartmann Homestead, which has been in the family for over 170 years.

Elsie is the oldest and longest serving member and choir member of the Dansville Presbyterian Church. She is also a long time member of the West Sparta Historical Society.

Elsie was born in Dansville on January 9, 1922 to Ray and Ruth Finch. She enjoyed being a Girl Scout and still

remembers many of the songs that were sung at Girl Scout camp. Elsie has always loved the outdoors and was quite an adventurous young lady in her youth. On one adventure, Elsie and her friends decided it might be fun to run across the 800-foot-long train bridge that spans the Upper Falls at Letchworth State Park! Elsie attended Dansville High School, Class of 1939, and was the Senior Class Treasurer.

She met her future husband Austin "Mush" Hartmann at school; he was President of the 1939 Senior Class. After high school, Elsie attended Cortland Normal School for one year as a Physical Education major. Unfortunately, she was not able to continue with her studies there because of a previous leg injury that had not healed properly. Elsie then enrolled at Rochester Business Institute and graduated with a certificate in Secretarial Science. After graduating, Elsie accepted a job as a clerk in the Methods and Tool Design department at Gleason Works, a machine shop in Rochester, New York.

In 1943, Elsie left Gleason Works and enlisted with the United States Marines. She was one of only the second group of women to do so. Elsie joined the Marines to become a mechanic but Uncle Sam had other plans. Because of Elsie's secretarial background, she was sent to Arlington, Virginia to work at Marine Headquarters.

Elsie was discharged with the rank of Sergeant at the end of WWII, and in 1946 married her high school sweetheart, Mush Hartmann. In addition to raising six children on the family farm, Elsie and Mush were members of a social group called the "Soup Club" which met once a month for over 25 years.

In 2004, Elsie and Mush were chosen as Livingston County Senior Citizens of the Year. Elsie has 6 children, 13 grandchildren and 8 great-great grandchildren. She is very talented both artistically and musically. She still sings in her church choir and plays the hand bells. At various times in her life Elsie played the violin, piano, flute, tap-danced, was involved in various singing groups, and participated in community theatre.

Elsie was part of a small singing group called the Mountain Williams. She and the other band members would play their fiddles while dressed as hillbillies. Elsie's calligraphy work can be seen throughout Dansville and West Sparta, including on the wall of the Clara Barton Chapter 1 Museum, and at the Dansville Presbyterian church in their Memorial Book and on the inside front cover of every hymnal that is used today.

In 2012, a flag-size banner that Elsie hand-lettered, was taken up to the top of Mt. Kilimanjaro by a Dansville native.

In 2014, Elsie had the honor of participating in Rochester Honor Flight mission #35 and that same year, was chosen as the honorary Grand Marshall of West Sparta's Old-Fashioned Day celebration.

For her community involvement, military service, and strong sense of family, the Town of West Sparta is proud to proclaim January 2022 as **"Elsie Hartmann Month"**.







Mental Health Resources Available from Livingston County Mental Health Services

Recent surveys show a major increase in the number of American adults who report symptoms of anxiety, stress, depression and insomnia since the pandemic began. In addition, the United States surgeon general recently warned of the “devastating” mental health effects also facing young people, in part, as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

During this challenging and often stressful time, the Livingston County Department of Health is urging residents in need to take advantage of the County’s mental health resources. Livingston County Mental Health Services (LCMHS) is a County-operated clinic licensed by the New York State Office of Mental Health, which provides services to children and adults with mental health needs. The staff there includes psychiatrists, therapists (social workers and counselors), nurses, nurse practitioners and care managers, said Livingston County Public Health Director Jennifer Rodriguez.

“We firmly believe that, now more than ever, good health must include good mental health, and we remain dedicated to providing outstanding mental health services here in Livingston County,” said Rodriguez. “We urge all those in need of mental health support to contact us immediately. Typically, we’ll begin with an assessment of the individual, followed by therapy or medication consultations, if necessary. We can also refer patients to other services or agencies, depending on needs. Some individuals may qualify for care management through LCMHS, which assists with connecting patients to more services, such as housing, medical assistance, budgeting, and other support services.”
