

The Great Resignation and the hourly wage

A young adult lady in Johnson county, Kentucky was recently faithfully working her convenient store register job. She had a line of patrons buying drinks and paying for gasoline. Someone asked her how much money she made? "Nine dollars an hour," she said. "I've worked here over two years and the pay has been \$9 an hour. I've asked for a raise. I work hard. I'm here almost all the time. A manager from the chain of stores always says, "We are looking into it." She said, "I have to find another job because I can't take care of myself and my children on \$9 an hour."

A patron in line who was only buying a cup of coffee with a \$20 bill took the cash she had just handed him in change and said to her, "Please take this and buy some lunch today." The lady said, "Uh, no, I don't want that," but the man insisted and she accepted it with tears coming from her eyes. "Thank you, thank you so much she said to the man. I've never had anybody to do anything like this for me in my life."

It was good to see a random act of kindness but the episode was a real case scenario of how hard life is for many Americans just like this lady, working for low hourly wages.

On January 5th, the US Department of Labor released its Job Openings and Labor Turnover Summary (JOLTS), revealing that the number of resignations reached 4.5 million in November. The number increased by 370,000, matching September's quit rate record high of 3% — indicating that the Great Resignation isn't showing signs of stopping.

Will the Johnson County lady quit her Job? She will, if she can find a better paying one. Unfortunately, in this area of the country that's not easy to do. She may have to move in order to make more money. Many employers across the country have had to raise what they are offering in order to find and keep good employees. Thus, many of the Americans who did quit their jobs in November did so because of the lure of better pay in other places.

In Kentucky the federal minimum wage is \$7.25. It's the same wage for many other states but some are doing much better. However, you can't go by the state minimum. You have to find the right employer who is paying what will make you happy and determine what it will require of you to be an employee.

The second applicant was an engineer. He pulled out a slide rule and showed the answer to be between 3.999 and 4.001.



When my grandparents and then parents talked about how time seems to go by quicker the older you are, I probably rolled my eyes. I would not roll them now. Have we really said good-bye to 2021 (or rather, kicked it out of the door)? It is already the middle of January! In the place of resolutions for the New Year, I choose a favorite scripture or quote to have as my theme for the year. The mission statement of the Danville

Area Humane Society is the theme of

our work, and it has been in place since

the 1980s. Our goals for each year may

vary in scope, but they always support

our stated mission.

Our 2022 goals include. We will maintain our 1. vigorous spay/neuter program. Recent studies indicate that in order to decrease the number of unwanted animals, at least 70 percent of the animals in the area must be sterilized. Since the 1970s, we have had a spay/neuter assistance program, but through the courtesy of the E. Stuart Grant Charitable Trust, we have been able to significantly expand the program since 1993.

Our 2022 funding from that Trust has already been received and we have sent grants to local veterinary clinics to help and encourage their clients to have all of their dogs and cats sterilized. Our popular rebate program will remain in place and we encourage you to visit our Facebook page and website to be informed of any new programs to help reduce the overpopulation.

2 We resolve to continue our work in sheltering animals. When we negotiated with the City of Danville in the early 1980s to operate and maintain the shelter, the shelter consisted of a nine dog runs. We built 28 dog runs and a small cat area. In 1989, the City built a larger cat room and two isolation areas, in addition to a treatment room. In 2007, we built an additional 28 dog runs, and in 2012, we opened the adoption center. In 2018, we remodeled the oldest

part of the shelter and have a new, larger cat room.

We resolve to continue our work with our adoption partners. These groups must be 501 (c) 3 organizations, must submit copies of their adoption policies and procedures, must be willing to sign the statements required by Virginia law, and must be pre-approved. We are grateful for these partnerships, even while recognizing that they only take animals they believe they can find homes for.

We resolve to never turn away an animal, no matter the circumstance, need, or chance of finding them a home. We will not place animals on a waiting list, nor will we charge an acceptance fee. We will also never turn away a grieving owner who cannot afford veterinary care for their beloved pet, even when that includes the recommendation of euthanasia. Our doors can never be closed to the weakest members of society.

Finally, we are grateful for the privilege we have had this year of working on behalf of the animals. As always, we hope the next year will be a kinder one for the animals. We are grateful to every person in this community who respects the critters. Without you, our work would be a heavy burden.

Bell Toys

Bell toys, a type of pull toy that had moving parts that rang a bell, were made in America just after the Civil War. The Gong Bell Co. of Connecticut made the first one. It was an iron four-wheel platform, holding a bell and an animal. The animal kicked or hit the bell when the platform moved. A popular bell toy featured an elephant that stepped on the bell to make it ring. The 9-1/2-inch-long toy is made of decorated metal. It was estimated to be worth \$800 to \$1,200.

Later bell toys used wood, tin or other metals and added realistic hair or animal hide. The toys were all painted. The 1880s and 1890s were the golden age for bell toys, and in the 1900s copies were made of metal and eventually plastic. Today, bell toys are wood or plastic made by Fisher Price or Playskool.

*** • I have dishes with bowls that look like heads of lettuce and plates that are a single lettuce leaf. They are marked with the signature "Dodie Thayer." Can you tell me anything about them?

A. Large leaves probably were one of the first "plates" used at a feast. So it's not surprising that plates were shaped like cabbage or lettuce leaves by the 1600s. Leaf-shaped European majolica plates were made by Delft, and by the 18th century they also were crafted by English potteries Wedgwood, Longton Hall, Chelsea and Minton, and French potteries Jacob Petit and Palissy. There was Etruscan Majolica from Pennsylvania, and modern giftware items like Cali-

fornia Dodie Thayer ceramics. This Palm Beach dishware was made during the 1960s and '70s. Dishes were made from molds of actual cabbage or lettuce leaves, or full heads of the vegetable. Pink, red, yellow and green sets were made. They are signed with the artist's name. Recently, the Lettuce Ware dishes were reproduced for the Tory Burch shops in green or white. Full sets are made with cups, plates,

tureens and more. A new salad plate costs \$40. Leaf-shaped dishes of all ages are popular with collectors, but only those made of porcelain or after 1900 should be used to serve food.

HOLLYWOOD - Are great movie musicals a thing of the past? When Steven Spielberg decided to remake "West Side Story," he purported to reimagine what the American Film Institute chose as the second greatest movie musical of all time. Spielberg's "West Side Story" received 93% positive notices from 306 reviews, which critics called "a knockout," "brash effervescence" and "a poignant Amer-ican fairytale." But The New Yorker magazine disagreed, saying "Spielberg's 'West Side Story' remake is worse than the original. Spielberg makes misguided additions and removed much of the best.'

The film cost \$100 million, and was originally due Dec. 18, 2020, but was delayed by COVID-19. In its 45-day theatrical release, it needed to gross \$300 million to break even. They're looking down a long road for that. It's unfortunate that the film was banned in four major Middle East countries due to objections to the transgender character "Anybody's," played by nonbinary actor Iris Menas.

Forbes magazine has announced there will be a stage musical sequel, "Maria," by Steven Sapp and his wife, which focuses on what happened to Maria after Tony's death. Maria was alive at the end of "West Side Story," but Juliet died in "Romeo and Juliet." Shakespeare never wrote a sequel.

AFI's list of the 20 greatest movie musicals ranks "Singing in the Rain" at No. 1, followed by the original "West Side Story," "The Wizard of Oz," "The Sound of Music" and "Cabaret." Rounding out the top 10 are "Mary Poppins," "A Star Is Born" (with Judy Garland), "My Fair Lady," "An American in Paris" and "Meet Me in St. Louis." "The King and I" comes in at No. 11, followed by "Chicago," "42nd Street," "All That Jazz," "Top Hat," "Funny Girl," "The Band Wag-on," "Yankee Doodle Dandy," "On the Town" and "Grease."

But where are the great musicals such

as "Gigi" and "Oliver" (Oscar-winners for best picture and director)? And perennial holiday favorites like "White Christmas" and "Easter Parade," or classics such as "Oklahoma," "Carousel," "Camelot," "Lili," "The Great Ziegfeld,"
"Silk Stockings" (great Cole Porter score), "High Society" (Sinatra/Crosby, Grace Kelly, Louis Armstrong) and the Oscar-winning "True Love."

Then there's "Hello Dolly" (Barbra Streisand and Louis Armstrong singing the title song is electrifying), "The Dolly Sisters" (Betty Grable and June Haver at their best), "No Business Like Show Business" (Marilvn Monroe at her hottest singing "Heat Wave") or "Bye Bye Birdie" (Ann-Margret's breakout role? And how could Irving Berlin's "Annie Get Your Gun," with the showbiz national anthem, "There's No Business Like Show Business," be left off?

The American Film Institute rated "Citizen Cane" the best film of all time over "Gone with the Wind." Frankly, my dears ...

Healthy Soup Makes Eating Vegetables Easy

Like most folks, I've resolved to eat more vegetables in the new year. Here's an inexpensive and appetizing idea that's been making my goal much easier. Each weekend, make one big pot of Very Versatile Vegetable Soup to enjoy for lunch the entire week.



Use variations to change up basic vegetable soup

This soup is delicious, but to avoid the "soup again?" syndrome, simple additions to the basic vegetable soup totally change up the flavors so we don't get bored. Some variation ideas follow the recipe.

What makes this recipe unique is that the veggies are sauteed for a little caramelization, maximizing their natural sweetness. This adds tremendous depth of umami flavor you don't usually find in vegetable soup. Of course, you can add any veggies you like to this soup, but I concentrated on lower-carb veggies. However, strong tasting vegetables like broccoli or asparagus tend to overpower the other flavors.

This delectable recipe can be made on the stovetop or a crock pot, makes about 10 servings, is easily doubled and freezes beautifully in single or family-size portions.

VERY VERSATILE VEGETABLE SOUP

Yield: 10 servings Time: 1 hour (stovetop)

- 3 tablespoons olive oil, divided
- 1 large onion, chopped4 large carrots, chopped
- 4 celery stalks, chopped 4 celoves garlic, minced (more if
- you love garlic!)
 1 medium head green cabbage,
- I medium head green cabbage, chopped
- (28 ounce) can Italian-style diced tomatoes, undrained
- 2 cups green beans, fresh or frozen, chopped
- 2 small russet potatoes (optional) peeled and chopped 8 cups (five 14.5 ounce cans)
- low-sodium chicken, beef or vegetable broth One big pinch red pepper flakes (optional) Salt and pepper to taste

1. The secret to this soup is the saute. Put 1 tablespoon oil in a large soup pot on medium-high heat. Add onion and cook until nearly translucent. Add carrot and saute for 3 minutes. Add celery and continue to cook for another 3 minutes, adding more oil as needed. (Remember that you're not cooking the veggies, just sauteing for the scrumptious flavor it imparts. If you get a little golden color, that's fantastic!)

2. Add the garlic and mix it together for 1 minute. Add cabbage and stir. I

add a little salt and pepper now. Cook until the cabbage begins to wilt. Add the tomatoes, green beans, potatoes, if using, broth and pepper flakes, and mix it all together.

3. If you're putting this in a crock pot to finish; dump it in now, set to LOW for 6 to 8 hours. To finish on the stovetop; let it come to a boil then turn heat to low. Let it gently simmer away until the veggies are tender, and the soup smells divine, roughly 30 minutes.

4. Add salt and pepper to taste at

the end because as the soup reduces, it concentrates the flavors, including salt. You can replace half the broth with water to reduce the sodium.

VARIATIONS

Change the flavor by adding these ingredients to the hot soup by the bowl. *Mock Minestrone* — White beans, big handful of spinach, cooked ditalini or small shell pasta, and Parmesan cheese. *Cabbage Roll* — Cooked hamburger, rice and a splash of Worcestershire. Finish with a dollop of sour cream.

Southwest — Add shredded cooked chicken, black beans, corn and a dash of cumin and chili powder. Top with shredded cheese.

Greek Lemon Chicken — Cooked shredded chicken, orzo or rice, dried or fresh oregano and a big squeeze of lemon.







Mail Delays Prompt VA to Extend Deadlines

The Department of Veterans Affairs ran into a big snag with a printing vendor and a lot of notification letters to veterans were delayed. But fear not -- the VA is extending your response time.

The Government Printing Office, which provides printing services via contracted vendors, couldn't get out the notification letters dated from July 13, 2021 and Dec. 31, 2021. Some of those letters, which required a response from veterans, could have dealt with required exams for compensation and pension, or for making an election about services or benefits, or more.


Typically, there are problems if you don't respond in time. However, at this point, because of the delayed mailings, the VA isn't going to terminate, reduce or deny services and benefits unless you've been contacted and there's documentation about your right to respond; or the information it asked you for has been received; or the response period has ended.

If you haven't received an expected communication from the VA, call 800-827-1000 to ask about the status of any letters you should have received. Be certain they have current cellphone, home phone, email and address info for you.

If you've filed an appeal, the Board of Veterans' Appeals also is experiencing significant delays in getting information to you about hearings and decisions. As of last month, the board is figuring up a workaround to get information to you and your representatives. If you're waiting on a notice about a hearing, they'll try any number of methods to reach you. If you have to postpone, call them ASAP. If you're waiting on a decision, ask your rep to access Caseflow to see if your decision information has been included yet.
